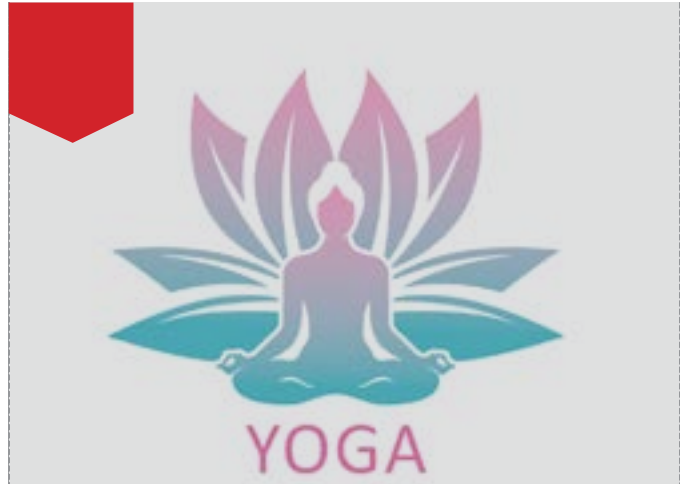

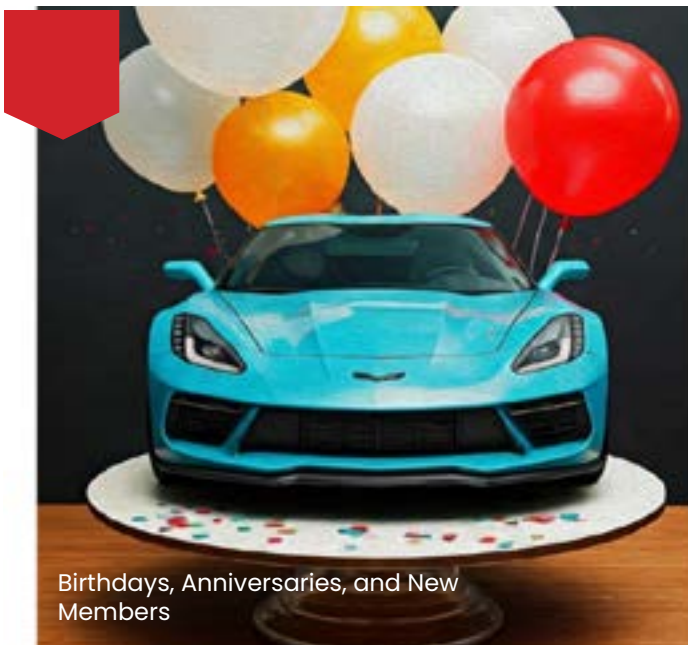

Specifically, in GTD PRO the Pratt and Miller # 3 and # 4 Corvettes finished 7th and 9th. In the GTD class, our Corvette AWA and DXDT teams while both had their strong early race moments, certainly were not in podium contention at the end. Unfortunately, such is racing. Corvette Racing's next event, the IMSA WeatherTech SportsCar Championship Long Beach Grand Prix is on that street circuit on April 11-12.

Also, his being a behind-the-scenes and hired by GM engineering consultant to the development and testing of several recent new generation Corvettes. With his Corvette accomplishments being so much more than those listed notables, his appointment to the NCM Board will further enhance the Museum's future growth and importance. Congratulations to you, Ken! We are very fortunate to have you on NCM's Board of Directors.

2026 C8 Grand Sport To Be Or Not To Be?

It is getting late and we still not heard of any announced reveal for the possible upcoming Grand Sport. Yes, it is coming, for we remember that during the last three years of the C7 generation that Grand Sports sales were better than 1 in 3 of total C7 sales. The capper was the last year the C7 generation in 2019, when even though the ZR1 was a one year only 2019 model, Grand Sports were still more than 50% of total new Corvette sales that year. Moreover, there is a massive, needing to be filled, price gap between the \$69,995 Stingray and the \$108,595 E-Ray's entry MSRP.

The two opposing strong rumors are that the Grand Sport will appear in mid/late 2026 and will be a 2027 model. Take your pick for no matter how many "reach outs" have been made by Corvette sleuths, there is still not one credible source definitively saying there will be a Grand Sport. One insider whispered with a tongue-in-check expression on his face, "maybe even the ZORA model might jump ahead of the Grand Sport," but even he said, "please take that with a grain of salt..."

Glimpse of 2026 Interior Rumors and "Maybe" Its Initial Sighting

Sometimes reporting new Corvette information leads to gold, sometimes to a gopher hole, and sometimes neither. In the case of the upcoming new Corvette interior, there were two videos showing leaked shots of the new-for-2026 interior. But it turns out that they were never approved for release by GM. In fact, quite the contrary. While pictures and more were shown on every part of Corvette social media coverage for just un-

der a week, it turned out that those non-authorized shots were all taken down from most every known internet sight-all at GM's request. Interestingly this was one of this year's most viewed teasings. While those unapproved videos and screenprints were circulating for a limited time, the number of posts and comments about them were highly significant. The posts about the possible new interior fell into three distinct camps: First, from the current interior fanboys and girls that, "we like the current 'wall of buttons' fan club". Then a bunch of others posted that the supposed new interior "having a passenger grab handle (a la the C7) would be a nice improvement." Then there was the third large group of posters whose comments about the supposed new interior could best be summarized by this saying, "let me say I am so far underwhelmed by what I have seen. But it could work well once fully shared." Our hope is that there will be actual 2026 Corvettes at the NCM Michelin BASH on April 24th – 26th, where the full interior would be revealed. We already know there will be a major 2026 C8 changes seminar and many of us will be fortunate to meet the new Executive Chief Engineer Tony Roma there.

sues on your 2025 Corvette, it is believed that somewhere in the manufacturing process or in the Plant's install of the lift, some debris contamination got into the system. Corvette's New Program Brand Manager:

Austin Fisher has been appointed to the new Corvette Brand Manager. He has a Mechanical Engineering degree from Purdue in 2017, has been at GM for two years. We have no confirmation but expect to meet him at the BASH.

ZR1 Ordering Breakthrough:

We remember that way back on Feb 20th GM is-

sued a limited number of ZR1 allocations, none of them having the option “TOM” full aero, with wing package but then days later took even those who had gone to status 3000 and forced them back to 2000 statutes (eliminating GM’s commitment to make that specific customer order). GM committed at that time to do an assessment of how many incoming winged aero package they could get in the near future and to notify all affected parties. Here is the just announced breakthrough.

Of note while this is excellent news, those who turned down an allocation on Feb 20th because there were no aero packages are not getting a solution at this time, and second, we do not know, for while we all noticed the word “CONSTRAINT” in the above GM communication, whether GM has located for the 2025 ZR1’s, 5 total packages, 13, 34, or a significantly larger number than that. Of course we will all continue to stay on top of further developments starting with March 26th GM directions to every dealership getting a ZR1 allocation exactly how many of them could be submitted with the full aero package.”
