DAY 3

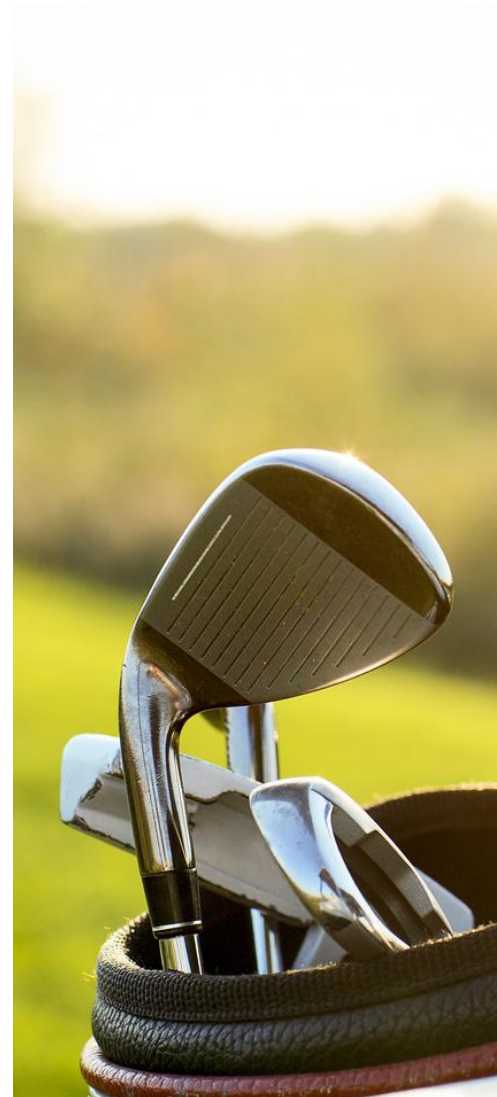
St. Leon-Rot Near
Heidelberg

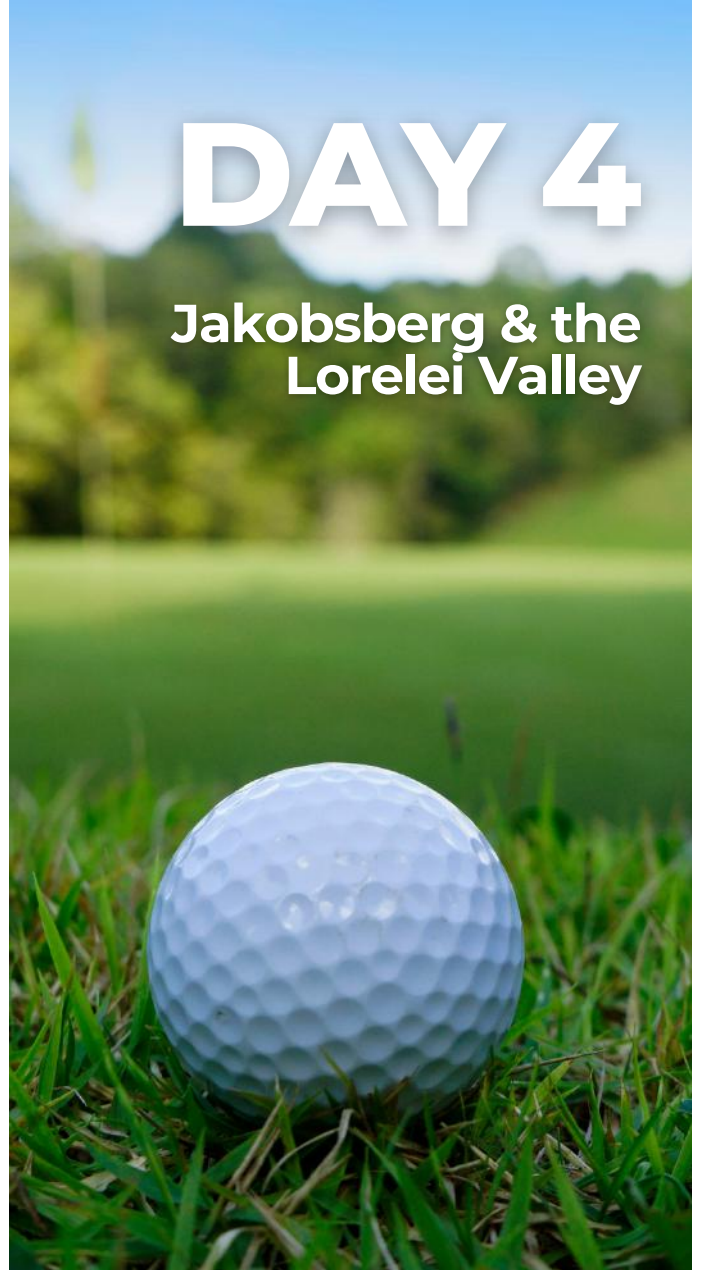
German Golf Excellence

DAY 4

Jakobsberg & the Lorelei Valley

SELECTED GOLF CLUBS

1 Le Kempferhof Golf et Château-Hôtel

Located 15 minutes from Strasbourg, this 18-hole course, designed by Robert von Hagge, spans 85 hectares of peaceful Alsace woodland. Ranked among France's top five courses, it features century-old trees, 13 water hazards, and breathtaking views of the 1865 Château-Hôtel and historic clubhouse.

2 Golf Club St. Leon-Rot

Near Heidelberg, St. Leon-Rot offers two 18-hole championship courses, a 9-hole executive course, and a children's course. Designed by Dave Thomas and Hannes Schreiner, the club is known for its links-style features and signature island greens. It's a "Leading Golf Course in Germany" and an "European Tour Destination."

3 Jakobsberg Golf Resort

Set atop the Lorelei Valley between Koblenz and Mainz, this 18-hole course, designed by Robert Trent Jones Jr., offers stunning views of the UNESCO-listed Rhine Valley. It features challenging fairways, bunkers, and water hazards, blending natural beauty with a dynamic golf experience.

4 Golf & Country Club Gut Velderhof

Situated 30 minutes from Cologne, Gut Velderhof features a championship course with 27 holes spread over three layouts. Designed by Dieter R. Sziedat, the course combines modern elements with historic charm, offering fast greens, fairway bunkers, and scenic water hazards.
