

When describing movement or progression, use clear temporal indicators like "first," "then," or "gradually" to help the Al understand the sequence of events. For example: "A seed sprouts from soil, then gradually grows into a seedling, finally blooming into a vibrant red flower that sways gently in a spring breeze."

Image-to-Video Conversion
