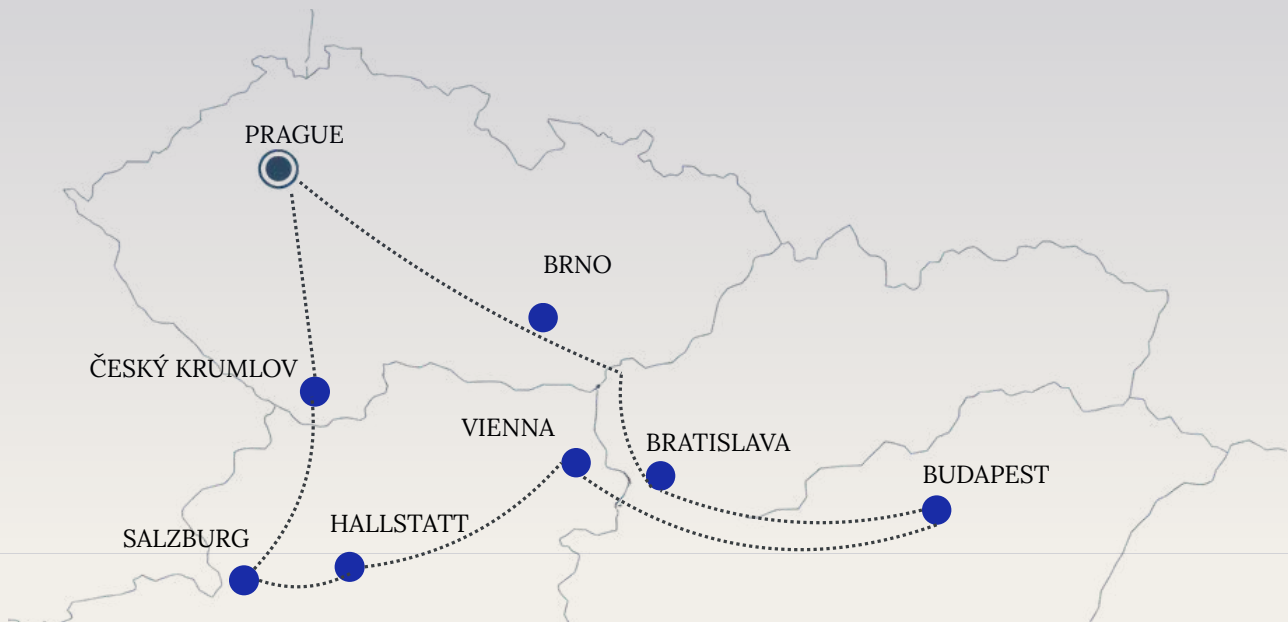

PRAGUE & CENTRAL EUROPE 10 DAYS ITINERARY

Day 1 - Arrival in Prague

Private arrival, transfer to hotel, and time to settle in. Optional welcome dinner.

Day 2 - Old Town & Literary Prague

Guided exploration of Prague's historic center and literary heritage. Afternoon at leisure.

Day 3 - Prague - Bratislava

Morning departure heading southeast. Scenic drive through Moravia to Bratislava.

Day 4 - Bratislava to Budapest

Morning departure from Bratislava. Arrival in Budapest followed by a guided introduction to the city, including Buda Castle, Fisherman's Bastion, and Matthias Church.

Day 5 - Budapest

Full day exploring Budapest, with time to enjoy its historic landmarks, café culture, and optional visit to a traditional thermal bath.

Day 6 - Budapest to Vienna

Morning departure to Vienna. Afternoon introduction to imperial Vienna, including the Ringstrasse, Hofburg Palace, and St. Stephen's Cathedral.

Day 7 - Vienna

A relaxed day in Vienna to explore its imperial landmarks, cafés, and cultural atmosphere at your own pace.

Day 8 - Vienna to Hallstatt to Salzburg

Scenic drive to Hallstatt for a short visit and lunch by the lake. Continue to Salzburg in the afternoon.

Day 9 - Salzburg to Český Krumlov to Prague

Morning departure from Salzburg with a stop in Český Krumlov for a short visit. Continue to Prague in the afternoon.

Day 10 - Departure from Prague

Private transfer to the airport and farewell.

DAY 1

The City of a Hundred Spires

From the majesty of Prague Castle to the charm of Old Town Square, the city invites you to wander at your own pace. Stroll through narrow lanes, pause in hidden courtyards, and enjoy a quiet moment in a local café as the sound of trams passes by.

Beyond the famous landmarks, Prague reveals a creative soul — art galleries, music, and a culinary scene that bridges Czech tradition and modern inspiration. It's a city that welcomes you warmly and stays in your memory long after you've gone.

Day 1 Arriving in **PRAGUE**

Private airport pickup and transfer to your boutique hotel in the heart of Prague.

Depending on arrival time: welcome drink featuring Bohemian sparkling wine at a local café or hotel lounge. Time to relax after the journey and settle into your surroundings.

In the early evening, an orientation drive through illuminated Prague, passing Wenceslas Square, the Dancing House, the National Theatre, and the Vltava riverbanks, offering a first glimpse of the city's atmosphere.

Optional dinner at a carefully selected local restaurant serving traditional Czech cuisine such as goulash, roast duck, or Svíčková.

DAY 2- Old Town & Literary Prague

Walking tour through Prague's Old Town, exploring Old Town Square and the Astronomical Clock, Old Town Hall, hidden courtyards and medieval passages, Franz Kafka's birthplace and memorial near the Jewish Quarter.

The medieval charm of Charles Bridge with views of Prague Castle, including stories of legends, saints, and daily life along the river.

Local stops to try Trdelník (chimney cake) and artisanal coffee in a historic café associated with Prague's writers and intellectuals.

Optional visit to:

- Maisel and Pinkas Synagogues
- the Old Jewish Cemetery, one of the oldest active Jewish cemeteries in Europe

Afternoon at leisure. Evening free with optional classical music concert.

Overnight in Prague.



DAY 3 Prague to Bratislava

Morning departure from Prague heading southeast through the landscapes of Moravia.

Late morning arrival in Brno, the cultural heart of Moravia. Short guided walk through the historic center including Freedom Square and views of Špilberk Castle. Optional visit to the modernist masterpiece Villa Tugendhat (subject to availability).

Lunch at a carefully selected Moravian restaurant, offering seasonal cuisine and regional wines.

In the early afternoon, continue toward Slovakia. Arrival in Bratislava with time to settle into your hotel.

Late afternoon walking tour of the Old Town, including:

- Michael's Gate
- Main Square
- views from Bratislava Castle overlooking the Danube

Evening dinner in a traditional Slovak restaurant featuring regional specialties and local wines.

Bratislava is a compact and welcoming capital set along the banks of the Danube, where Central European history unfolds on a human scale. Its charming Old Town, crowned by a hilltop castle, reflects centuries shaped by the Kingdom of Hungary, the Habsburg Empire, and modern Slovak identity. Narrow streets, pastel façades, and quiet squares create an atmosphere that feels both intimate and historically rich.

Bratislava is best experienced slowly – through short walks, riverside views, and moments spent in local cafés. As a natural link between Vienna and Budapest, the city offers a gentle pause in the journey, revealing a softer, more personal perspective on Central Europe and its layered past.

DAY 4

Bratislava to Budapest

The day begins in Bratislava with a relaxed morning and time to enjoy the quiet atmosphere of its Old Town. A short walk through its pastel streets or views from Bratislava Castle offer a final glimpse of this intimate capital before continuing the journey.

Late morning departure follows the Danube south toward Hungary, passing through gentle countryside and small towns shaped by the river. The route itself becomes part of the experience, offering a gradual transition between cultures and landscapes.

Arrival in Budapest in the early afternoon introduces a striking contrast – a city defined by grandeur, scale, and architectural elegance. An orientation drive reveals both sides of the city: the historic hills of Buda and the vibrant avenues of Pest, connected by iconic bridges across the Danube.

The afternoon allows time to settle in or begin exploring at your own pace. In the evening, you may choose to experience Budapest from the water on an optional Danube river cruise, where the illuminated Parliament and riverfront create one of Central Europe's most memorable views.

Whether soaking in warm waters, strolling along the riverbanks, or enjoying the atmosphere after sunset, Budapest offers a unique balance of relaxation and energy – a city that feels both deeply historic and vividly alive.



DAY 5 Budapest

Full day exploring the highlights of Budapest. Begin on the Buda side with a visit to Buda Castle, followed by panoramic views from Fisherman's Bastion overlooking the Danube and the Parliament building. Continue to Matthias Church, whose colorful roof tiles and layered history reflect centuries of Hungarian royal tradition.

In the afternoon, enjoy time at leisure for individual exploration, cafés, or an optional visit to one of Budapest's renowned thermal baths such as Széchenyi Thermal Bath or Gellért Baths, where mineral-rich waters have been part of the city's culture for generations.

Evening free, or optional dinner featuring traditional Hungarian cuisine accompanied by live folk music.

Budapest is a city defined by the Danube, whose broad curve separates the historic hills of Buda from the grand boulevards of Pest. From panoramic viewpoints above the river, the city reveals a striking sense of scale, elegance, and historical depth shaped by centuries of cultural exchange.

DAY 6 Budapest to Vienna

Continue to the Hofburg Palace, once the seat of the Habsburg dynasty, and walk to St. Stephen's Cathedral, the symbolic heart of the city.

Evening at leisure, or optional classical concert in one of Vienna's historic music venues.

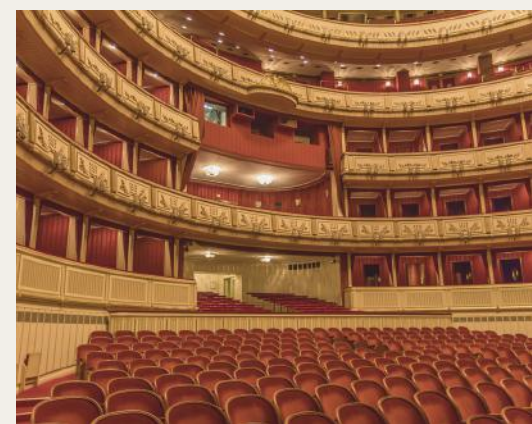
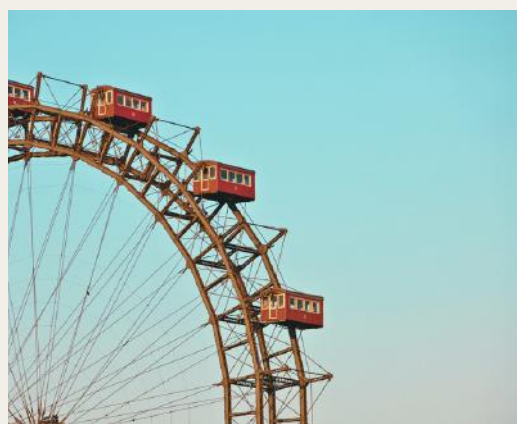
