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Quick Fire Safety Self Audit

1. Fire Alarm System Installed?

- Regulatory Guideline: Fire alarm systems should comply with AS 1670 series standards.
- The Fire Alarm Control Panel should be located in a readily accessible and visible location, preferably near the main entrance or lobby area of the building. It should be easily accessible to authorized personnel and emergency responders.

2. Smoke Detectors Installed?

- Regulatory Guideline: Smoke detectors should be installed in accordance with AS 1670.1.
- Smoke Detectors should be located in all areas where smoke detection is required, including corridors, stairwells, common areas, and rooms where occupants sleep or gather. Specific placement and coverage requirements may vary depending on the occupancy type and building layout.

3. Fire Sprinkler System Installed?

- Regulatory Guideline: Fire sprinkler systems should comply with AS 2118 series standards.
- Fire Sprinkler Control Valves should be located in a designated fire sprinkler room or fire control room. They should be easily accessible to authorized personnel and located in an area protected from potential damage or tampering. The exact location may vary depending on the building's layout and design.

4. Fire Extinguishers Available?

- Regulatory Guideline: Fire extinguishers should comply with AS 1851 and be installed in accordance with AS 2444.
- Fire Extinguishers should be easily accessible and visible, mounted on brackets or stands at a height of approximately 1.2 meters above the floor. Common locations include corridors, exit routes, kitchens, mechanical rooms, and areas with potential fire hazards. The specific types and quantities of fire extinguishers required will depend on the building's classification and fire risk assessment.

5. Emergency Lighting Installed?

- Regulatory Guideline: Emergency lighting systems should comply with AS/NZS 2293 series standards.
- Emergency Lighting should be installed along exit routes, stairwells, corridors, and other areas where illumination is necessary during a power outage or emergency evacuation. The location of emergency lighting fixtures should ensure adequate coverage and visibility. Emergency lighting should also be provided at emergency exits and areas with changes in level.

6. Is there an Emergency Evacuation Plan available?

- Regulatory Guideline: An emergency evacuation plan is a legal requirement for spaces available to public, employees and strata under Australian standards (AS 3745-2010).

7. Are Exit Routes Clear and Unobstructed?

- Regulatory Guideline: Exit routes should be clear and unobstructed as per BCA requirements.

8. Is The Emergency Exit Signage Clearly Visible? (If Available)

- Regulatory Guideline: Emergency exit signage should comply with AS 2293.1.
- Emergency Exit Signage should be installed above or adjacent to all exit doors, stairwells, and other means of egress. The location of exit signage should ensure clear visibility from any vantage point within the building. Exit signs should be illuminated and maintained in working condition at all times.

9. Are All Fire Doors Functioning Properly? (If Available)

- Regulatory Guideline: Fire doors should comply with AS 1905 series standards.

10. Are Fire Safety Instructions Available?

- Fire Safety Instructions, including evacuation procedures, should be posted in prominent locations throughout the building, such as near exit doors, in common areas, and at designated assembly points. The location of fire safety instruction postings should ensure that occupants can easily access and review the information in the event of an emergency.

11. Are All Combustible Materials Stored Properly? (If Any)

- Regulatory Guideline: Storage of combustible materials should comply with BCA requirements.

12. Smoking Policy Enforced? (If Required)

- Regulatory Guideline: Smoking policies should comply with relevant state legislation and workplace health and safety regulations.

13. Are There Electrical Safety Measures (e.g., RCDs, circuit breakers)?

- Regulatory Guideline: Electrical safety measures should comply with AS/NZS 3000 Wiring Rules.
- Electrical panels and safety switches should be located in designated electrical rooms or enclosures, typically near the building's main entrance or utility entrance. They should be easily accessible to authorized personnel and located in areas free from obstruction. Electrical panels should be clearly labelled and identified, and safety switches should be easily operable in case of an emergency.

14. Emergency Evacuation Drills Conducted Regularly? (If Applicable)

- Regulatory Guideline: Regular evacuation drills are required as per AS 3745-2010.

15. Is Emergency Contact Information Made Available For All?

- Regulatory Guideline: Posting of emergency contact information is recommended as per AS 3745-2010.

16. Are First Aid Kits Complete, Un-Obstructed, Fully Stocked and Available?

- Regulatory Guideline: First aid kits should comply with AS 2675.
- First aid kits should be readily accessible and located in easily identifiable and well-marked cabinets or containers. They should be placed in areas where they can be quickly accessed in case of injury or medical emergency, such as near common areas, kitchens, workshops, or high-risk areas. The specific number and placement of first aid kits should comply with AS 2675 and be based on the size and occupancy of the building.

Delivery of Services and Products

- Shipping cost varies based on location and product order dimensions. We work with reputable delivery companies to ensure the best freight and logistics we can.

- **AW (Air Water):** Class A (Flammable Materials).
- **BE (Dry Chemical):** Use for Class B (Flammable Liquids) and E (Electrical Equipment), Limitation on Class F (Cooking Fats & Oils).
- **CO2 (Carbon Dioxide):** Use for Class E (Electrical Equipment), Limitations on Class A (Flammable Materials) and Class B (Flammable Liquids).
- **Eco Foam (Flourine Free):** Class A (Flammable Materials), Class B (Flammable Liquids), Limitation on Class F (Cooking Fats & Oils).
- **Wet (Water Extinguisher):** Use for Class A (Flammable Materials) and Class F (Cooking Fats & Oils).

Whilst our extinguishers are available to order, please notify our sales team if you are requiring palette quantities as discounts will apply to large quantity orders.

As extinguishers are considered a dangerous good, different freight rules do apply for delivery. Please contact us for a quote on shipping or pick up.

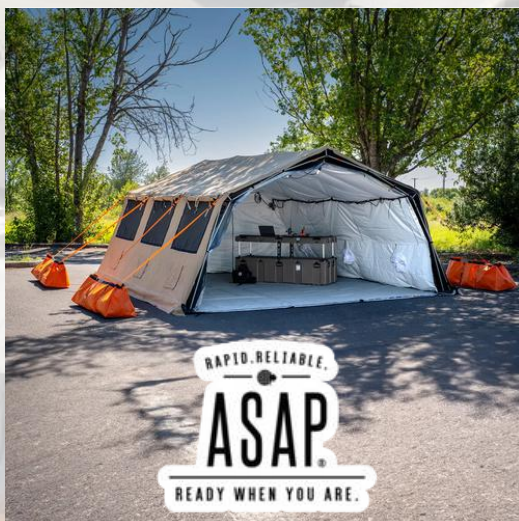
