Norfolk Island is a small island in the South Pacific Ocean. It uniquely blends natural beauty, rich history, and a distinct culture. Norfolk Island has a fascinating history. It was first settled by Polynesians, but it gained more prominence when the British claimed it in the late 18th century.

It was established as a penal colony in 1788, primarily for convicts who had committed serious crimes. In the 1850s, the penal settlement was closed, and the island became home to descendants of the Bounty mutineers, known as the Pitcairn Islanders. The culture of Norfolk Island is influenced by its Polynesian heritage, British colonization, and the unique history of the Pitcairn Islanders. The island has its dialect, known as Norf'k, which is derived from 18th-century English and Tahitian. The local community is known for its friendliness and hospitality.

We begin with a delicious dinner in a beautiful Georgian building, then grab a lantern and wander through the historic Kingston Ruins, hearing eerie stories and legends from the island's dark past.

The **Breakfast Bushwalk & Clifftop BBQ** offers two routes to suit everyone. For a gentle stroll, explore the tranquil Palm Glen Reserve. Bates—the island's highest point—to the historic Captain Cook Monument, marking Captain James Cook's landing in 1774 and providing stunning coastal views. We'll finish our walk with a delicious clifftop BBQ breakfast at Anson Bay.

In the afternoon, we will visit the **Pitcairn Settlers Village**, where Charles and Kim Christian-Bailey will welcome you to their remarkable 13-acre homestead, which has been continuously owned by their family since its settlement by Charles' great-greatgrandparents. We'll gain an in-depth knowledge of the Pitcairn Settlers and the Bailey family while touring the 1879 family homestead. Learn about farming innovations, visit the oldest working forge in the Pacific, and explore stunning gardens—all while travelling on the island's first tour bus, a 1928 Model A Ford truck.
