STOP-OFF: READ IN YOUR BIBLE - LUKE 5:1-11

For **Simon Peter**, catching fish was the way to make money. He was just like so many other ordinary people at that time who fished for a living.

Catching fish meant he could buy things, he could look after his family, he could go home and rest which is just what he did on so many other ordinary days.

But this was no ordinary day!

Jesus asked him to do something that would turn this into an extraordinary day and would change his life forever. They caught so many fish in such a short time that he and his friends couldn't even lift them into their boat. **Wow!** IMAGINE you're an ordinary person, living an ordinary life in an ordinary way, with ordinary people, having an ordinary day! Suddenly things go unusually, unexpectedly, and unbelievably fishy! That's because you've just met someone who is NOT ordinary. He is extraordinary!

"Hi, I'm Peter." My fishing partners and I were so amazed by what Jesus did.

Right then we left the Fishy Fishing Business - all the fish, the nets, the boats, everything! and went with Jesus.



James and John were brothers, and their father was Zebedee. Jesus called them 'Boanerges' which means "sons of thunder" (Mark 3:17). They must have been very bold and energetic as disciples of Jesus. They were also Peter's fishing partners and they all were quite young!

Jesus was busy teaching about God. People were excited to see him and to hear what he had to say. He had also been healing people and doing other miraculous things. Jesus' disciples were with him and had seen him do amazing things. It had been a busy day and Jesus was very tired. Not long after Jesus and the disciples set off in the boat, Jesus was sound asleep.

Suddenly, their boat trip became very dangerous as they found themselves in the middle of a fierce storm. The disciples were terrified and believed they were going to drown. They felt totally helpless! Their shouts, not the noise of the wind and the waves, woke Jesus from his sleep. He showed his incredible power by speaking to the wind and waves and the storm stopped immediately! Now they were really amazed!

- 2. The disciples were amazed and asked, "Who is this man?" How would you answer that question?






Jesus' power both amazed and confused his disciples. Write here what amazes you and what confuses you about Jesus and his power.



Sometimes there are storms so strong on the Sea of Galilee that the waves are 10 feet tall. That's over 3 metres!






Trip 3: A Bird's Eye View Location: A hillside in Galilee



The story today is part of what's called "The Sermon on the Mount". It fills Matthew chapters 5, 6, and 7 in the Bible! Jesus talked about the importance of being humble, forgiving others (even enemies) and caring for our neighbours. This is what people who have Jesus as their King should be like.

Did you know that there are over 11,000 species of birds? They are important to our ecosystem because they control pests and spread seeds. If that were not enough, there are over 350,000 species of flowering plants. That is a lot to take care of!

Who we meet: Cleopas and another follower of Jesus

STOP-OFF: READ IN YOUR BIBLE - LUKE 24:13-35

I could get to Emmaus in no time. I would just fly from tree to tree.



"Hi! I'm Cleopas."
The only way to get
to Emmaus is to
walk. Its seven miles
away, but my friend
and I had a lot to
talk about.

Have you ever hoped for something that, then, didn't happen? That's the way two people travelling to Emmaus felt. Only they had hoped for something really big—someone who would save them and set them free! They thought that person would be Jesus. But he had been sentenced to death on a cross by the Roman governor and had died that Friday. As they travelled toward Emmaus the Sunday after, along came another traveller. What he said on the road and at supper opened their eyes to what really happened. It made these two men do a rapid U—turn in their journey and in their hope.

A lot has happened to Jesus and his disciples since our last trip! Even though he did so much good, and many people loved him, many religious leaders hated him and asked the Roman governor to sentence him to death. Jesus died in Jerusalem. He had told his disciples that this would happen. He even said he would come alive again! But they didn't understand.

That is why Cleopas and another follower of Jesus were so sad and confused as they walked to Emmaus the Sunday after Jesus died. But that evening, they got a big surprise at supper time. They suddenly realised that it was Jesus sitting at the table with them. They immediately got up and ran all the way back to Jerusalem. They couldn't wait to tell the disciples that Jesus was alive!

Walking was the most common form of getting from one town to another. The roads were normally very dusty. Jesus and his disciples travelled many miles this way. It would have taken Cleopas and his friend 2-3 hours to walk from Jerusalem to Emmaus.

We only know the name of one of the followers of Jesus in this story-Cleopas. We don't know a lot about Cleopas, his friend, or even about the town, Emmaus. Even though this is the only time even about the town, Emmass. Even though they are mentioned, we know this experience changed their lives. 11


