AccuWeather Lightning Myths & Facts

It's that time of year again. While thunderstorms bring that flash of white-hot, splintered bolts that illuminate blackened skies and creating a spectacular light show... they also bring the looming threat of electrocution. Let's talk about some common myths and facts about lightning.

- A lightning bolt can generate nearly 300 million volts and 30,000 amps. This can power a 100watt light bulb for three months or a fluorescent bulb for a year. Average voltage in a household is 120 volts I 15 amps.
- Lightning CAN strike twice! 25 million lightning flashes in the U.S. per year. The Empire State Building is struck an average 25 times each year. During one storm, it was hit eight times in 24 minutes.
- The electrical charge of each flash can heat the air it travels through up to 50,000 F which is 5x hotter than the sun's surface.
- You should get out of the shower because lightning can flow through pipes. Avoid sinks, bathtubs and other forms of household plumbing during a storm.
- Lightning usually doesn't kill fish. A charge builds up on the surface of a water body before lightning strikes. Fish swim under the surface and are usually unaffected. However, humans cannot swim in a thunderstorm. Unlike fish, humans swimming in a body of water are in contact with the surface, which poses a serious danger of death during a thunderstorm.
- Lightning can often strike three miles outside the center of a thunderstorm, but a ranging thunderbolt can hit from up to 10-15 miles away, without warning. If you hear thunder, you are within range.
- The body can sense if lightning is about to strike. Your hair will often stand on end.
- Car tires don't necessarily keep you safe. Rubber tires are not enough to save you from a lightning bolt. However, the outer metal shell of a car is usually enough to protect you.
- Types of lightning: Intra-cloud (most common), cloud to cloud, cloud to ground, cloud to air, anvil, bolt from the blue, sprite. Fun fact: heat lightning is not a real phenomenon. It's just a storm that is far away.
- Proximity to metal structures or wearing metal jewelry does not increase your risk of getting struck by lightning, but it does conduct electricity.
- Yes, airplanes are struck by lightning. Commercial airliners, some of which are designed to conduct electricity, are struck an average of two times each year. It has been decades since a commercial aircraft has been downed due to lightning, but the same is not true of other aircraft types.
- A house is one of the safest locations during a storm. However, it is important to avoid corded electronic devices and plumbing, which provide a path for the electric current.
- Under a tree is not a safe place to seek shelter. Standing under a tree is the second leading cause of lightning fatalities. Lying on the ground is also not a safe alternative because deadly ground currents still pose a threat.
- There is no threat of electrocution from touching a victim of a lightning strike. If a person is struck, it is safe to perform first aid.
- From 2007 to 2016, Illinois averaged 763,705 cloud-to-ground lightning flashes per year. Indiana averaged 425,478. Number one in the U.S. was Florida with 1,193,735!!!

How to Display the American Flag


In honor of Flag Day, Thursday, June 14th



AGAINST A WALL OR IN A WINDOW When displayed either horizontally or vertically, the union or blue field should be to the observer's left, as shown.



ON A POLE WITH ANOTHER



IN A GROUP OF FLAGS In a group of flags displayed from staffs, the U.S. flag should be at the center and the highest point.



CROSSED STAFFS WITH ANOTHER FLAG When it is displayed with another flag against a wall from crossed staffs, the flag should be on the right, the flag's own right (viewer's left), and its staff should be in front of the staff of the other flag.

FROM A STAFF ADJACENT TO OTHERS The U.S. flag should be placed in a position of honor, which is the extreme left from the most common viewing point.

SUSPENDED OR HANGING OVER STREET

When not on a staff, the U.S. flag should be displayed flat, or suspended so that its folds fall free. When flag is displayed over a street, place the union side facing north on an east and west street or east on a north and south street.

WITH THE FLAGS OF OTHER NATIONS Each flag should be the same size and displayed at the same height. It is inappropriate to display one country's flag above another.

AT HALF-STAFF OR HALF-MAST "Half-staff" is half the distance from the top to the bottom of a flagpole. If flying a single flag, the center-point of the U.S. flag should be aligned with the center-point of the flagpole. IN AN AUDITORIUM OR CHURCH SETTING When the U.S. flag is displayed on a staff situated on a platform or stage with a speaker, the flag should be to the speaker's right. Additional flag sets should be displayed to the right of the American flag from the most common viewing point. If it is displayed flat or hung vertically, it should be positioned above and behind the speaker with additional flags to the right from the most common viewing point.
