This sacred land is not only where Grandmother Flordemayo calls home, it is where The Path exists, a sanctuary for prayer, ceremony, and the Temples of Humanity, including the Temple of the Golden Child. Santa Fe and the surrounding land carry a deep spiritual resonance, making it the perfect place for our circle to root, expand, and blossom. This gathering is a call to remember, a call to heal, and a call to protect the sacred.

Why This Matters - The Golden Child Vision

In 2010, during sacred prayer, Grandmother Flordemayo received a vision. She was shown an egg of Earth, which as she sang prayers of love, transformed into crystalline snowflakes. From within, a golden newborn child emerged, a symbol of humanity's highest potential. Her words remind us: "We all have the capacity to become that Golden Being, whether we are male or female. When we reach that place of spirituality, we transform into this Golden Being."

Grandmother Abby Arquero Cochita/Kewa Tribal Nation Cochiti Pueblo Elder

A grandmother, mother, educator, and cultural mentor, she retired in 2020 after 40 years in education, serving in public, private, and Bureau of Indian Education schools. Her work has always centered on ensuring Indigenous students see their identity, culture, traditions, and history reflected in the classroom. She now serves as a Teacher Mentor for the University of Idaho's Indigenous Knowledge for Effective Education (IKEEP) Program and works with the Keres Children's Learning Center to revitalize the Keres language and mentor young mothers in cultural traditions.



Grandmother Flordemayo Mayan Elder Founder of The Path

Born the youngest of 15 children in the highlands of Central America, Grandmother Flordemayo was recognized early for her gift of Sight. Trained from the age of four in the art of curanderismo, passed down through generations from mother to daughter, she learned the healing traditions of herbs, women's medicine, and honoring Mother Earth. Grandmother Heather (Grandmother Feather or MeeMaw)

Heather Hall-Dudney is the oldest child, only daughter, and personal assistant and travel companion to Mayan Elder and Seed Keeper, Grandmother Flordemayo. A disabled Navy veteran with a bachelor's degree in sociology and economics, Heather serves as program director and leads donor outreach for The Path, Inc., a nonprofit dedicated to preserving sacred heirloom seeds and Indigenous wisdom. She has co-produced We Are All Related, the 20th Anniversary of the International Council of Thirteen Indigenous Grandmothers, and The Sacred Reciprocity Gathering for Mother Earth. Born under the sacred Mayan Nawal 9 Iq', symbolizing divine inspiration and the breath of life, Heather is a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, and passionate advocate for the environment, survivors of sexual abuse, and veterans, carrying her Mayan and Finnish ancestry with pride.



Grandmother Taiha-Moetu of the Tūhoe Nation Ngā Tamariki o Te Kohu (Children of the Mist) Elder & Healer Empowerment Guide Māori


A spiritual and holistic guidance counselor, clairvoyant, clairsentient healer, and empowerment workshop leader. Descended from tribal leaders and healers, she was raised immersed in daily karakia, ritual, and ancestral teachings of her people. For more than 40 years, she has traveled the world sharing Māori spirituality, body-work, and ancestral wisdom, with a special focus on empowering women to embody their purpose and stand in their power. Her name in light language, Taiha-Moetu, means "I stand in my Power and for My Dreams."



Puma Fredy Quispe Singona Andean Medicine Carrier Keeper of Ancestral Wisdom Guide to Sacred Portals

A wisdom keeper and medicine carrier from the Andean village of Chinchero, Peru. Struck by lightning at the age of six, he began his apprenticeship with his grandfather, the late Don Maximo, and was trained in the Rainbow Lineage traditions of the Inca. Puma has also studied the sacred plant medicines of the coastal Huachuma lineage and the Amazonian Shipibo Ayahuasca traditions. Founder of the Noqan Kani Global Community Center, and co-creator of Pumadventures, Puma leads retreats and pilgrimages to sacred sites worldwide, sharing ancestral Andean teachings, rituals, and

ceremonies that guide people toward healing, transformation, and self-realization. His life's mission is to continue his grandfather's legacy by bringing forward the timeless wisdom of the Andes for the global awakening of humanity.


Founder of the Eagle and Condor Native

Emigdio Ballón - Quechua Seed Steward Guardian of Quinoa & Amaranth Seeds of Spirit & Science Ancestral Wisdom in Seeds

Emigdio Ballón, a Quechua seed keeper and agricultural scientist from Cochabamba, Bolivia, has dedicated his life to the preservation of traditional crops and sustainable farming practices. With degrees in agriculture and plant genetics, his research has specialized in quinoa and amaranth, alongside extensive work in organic and biodynamic farming. Emigdio is the retired Director of the Farm Program at the Pueblo of Tesuque in New Mexico, where he combined scientific knowledge with traditional Quechua techniques to strengthen seed sovereignty. He continues to inspire global communities through his lifelong devotion to seeds, sustainability, and ancestral wisdom.



Grandmother Hato Māori Healer & Wisdom Keeper Child of the Mist (Tūhoe) Māori Elder & Teacher

Grandmother Hato-Lee Siaki, of the Tūhoe and Ngāti Kahungungu tribes of Aotearoa, is a healer, cultural advisor, and spiritual counselor. The youngest daughter of Pomare Heemi and Rarauhe Rakuraku, she was raised immersed in the Tuhoe language, prayers, and daily rituals of her people. As Ngā Tamariki o Te Kohu — "The Children of the Mist" — she and her sister, Grandmother Taiha-Moetu, carry forward the ancestral teachings of healing, spirituality, and cultural wisdom. Hato serves as a Spiritual Counselor and Trainer in holistic Māori social services and travels nationally and internationally with her sister to share their people's sacred knowledge and empower communities.



Jyoti Ma, Founder of the Center for Sacred Studies Spiritual Teacher & Grandmother Vision Keeper

Jyoti Ma is an internationally renowned spiritual teacher, Grandmother Vision Keeper of the Center for Sacred Studies, and founder of The Fountain, a global initiative to restore an economic model based on reciprocity and the Sacred. She co-founded the International Council of Thirteen Indigenous Grandmothers, the Unity Concert, and Kayumari spiritual communities in America and Europe. Jyoti works with the Mother Earth Delegation of United Indigenous Nations to protect Sacred Territories and support the Original Peoples of the Earth.

Joseph Lofthouse, known as the "father of landrace gardening," lives in the high mountain desert of Utah where he stewards seeds, soil, and stories. 

She is the author of the classic Jambalaya: The Natural Woman's Book of Personal Charms and Practical Rituals and the bestselling A Calabash of Cowries: Ancient Wisdom for Modern Times. YeYe Teish has collaborated with Indigenous Elders worldwide and is the recipient of the 2023 Lifetime Achievement Award from the International Black Women's Congress and the 2025 Demeter Award for her visionary contributions to feminist art, culture, and spirituality. Remembering

WHAT'S

OURS TO

CARRY

For much of my life, I've lived at the intersection of two worlds, one that celebrates spiritual awakening, healing, and intuitive power, and another that wrestles with where those gifts come from and who they belong to.

As a white woman with deep psychic and healing abilities, I have spent years learning to walk with humility and integrity. There was a time when I was unsure what in my practice was truly mine...the natural gifts of my soul...and what I had unconsciously and intentionally adopted from others.

We live in a culture that often says, "If you can, you are." But that never felt right to me. I could do many things... see energy, speak with spirit, move healing through my hands, feel what others have endured...yet something inside still felt incomplete. I could do it, but I didn't fully belong.

What I was missing was something fundamental, my own cultural and ancestral grounding. My own lineage. Without that, my spiritual gifts floated unanchored. Over time, I've come to live by a different phrase: "If you know, you are."

To know is about remembrance... feeling the pulse of your ancestry in your bones and allowing that to inform the way you move through the world.

Finding the Missing Ground

When I began learning about my ancestors, the lands they walked, the languages they spoke, the ways they prayed, the healing modalities and witchcraft they used...something profound shifted. I started to feel a sense of belonging that no external teacher had ever given me. It was like a thread reattaching me to something ancient and solid. My intuition, my healing gifts, my ability to guide others...none of them were random. They were continuations of ancestral patterns.

With deep gratitude, I honor
Grandmother Taiha- Moetu, Māori
Elder and Wisdom Keeper, whose
generosity helped me understand how
to walk this path with respect.
Through her guidance, I learned that
acknowledgment is not an apology...it
is an act of relationship. She reminded
me that when we stand firmly in our
own lineage, we can honor others
without taking from them.

Now that I've found this connection, I can call on it anytime. My ancestors' stories show up in how I write, lead, and care for people. They shape the ethics of my work and remind me that my power doesn't need to mimic anyone else's...it needs to be rooted in truth.

The Convage to Examine What we Carry

Connecting to our lineage isn't always comfortable. It requires us to look honestly at both trauma and triumph, to acknowledge privilege and imbalance with humility, not shame. We are being called to take responsibility for what we've inherited...both the gifts and the harm...and to choose differently going forward. All of us lose something when cultures are erased or appropriated, yet we all gain when we reconnect with our authentic roots. That connection gives clarity. It teaches ethical power. It reminds us that wisdom isn't something we take it's something we cultivate and honor.

Reaching Further Back

When I say it's time to go "Back to basics," I mean the original basics, the foundation of who we are as human beings, before titles and hierarchies. We need to reach further back to the stories that live in our DNA, to the memories of when we understood that everything is connected.

It's time to remember the original agreements of being human... to live in right relationship, to act with respect, and to pass forward the wisdom that sustains life.



One of our most transformative initiatives is The Sun Project, born from spiritual consultations with the Kággaba Mámas (Kogi) the ancestral spiritual leaders of the Sierra Nevada de Santa Marta in Colombia.

Through their guidance, we are helping them secure nine sacred parcels of land that together form a unified spiritual entity known as

The Golden Body

(Kaginiuba).

The Mámas have shared that these nine lands must be understood as one living golden body, and each parcel serves a unique spiritual function. Each site corresponds to a body part and a spiritual function, and together they maintain the balance and regeneration of the Sierra Nevada region, physically and spiritually. These sites are not just symbolic; they are living systems that uphold the Law of Origin, a sacred law of harmony, interconnectedness, and cosmic order. This is not just for the Kággaba people, but for the well-being of the wider world.

Securing these lands is essential to upholding the spiritual integrity of the region. The sites are interconnected with high mountain sacred lands known as Ezuamas, accessible only to the Kággaba. The Golden Body acts as a bridge between these spiritual realms and the physical world, ensuring those decisions around health, governance, and climates are made in alignment with ancestral law.

We are honored to share that three of the nine land trusts are already secured, with the fourth to be completed in 2025, thanks to the generosity and commitment of our global community. Each acquisition is a step toward restoring sacred balance and protecting the spiritual architecture of the Sierra.



On my return home, I woke and I breathed in a new day and celebrated within the fulfillment of my intentions.

Karakia is the opening up and the closing, the beginning and the ending of everything in my world.

Through my parents I was blessed with a strong foundation, my grounding. My parents instilled in me a deep sense of pride in my cultural heritage and the spiritual realm.

From my ngakau, my Heart Soul, l greet you,
From my Star-Beings to You and all your Star-Beings
Greetings, greetings, greetings to all that you Are.



If this was a presentation then I would introduce my genealogy on my Mothers and my Fathers side and the lands they come from plus our ancestral houses and which ancestors they come from as well as how and what parts of our physical body are being represented, such as my Mountain Maungapohatu is my spine, he stands strong behind me...and from Maungapohatu flows my rivers, Tauranga and Whakatane down through my Heartland of Te Urewera and out to sea. My physical body represents my ancestors, my tribes, my heartland, and the rivers represent the blood that flows through my body.

I wanted to give you a brief of this because it will explain the story I have to share with you. I also share a little bit of what I do below. In my culture, I am known as a "Matekite", a person who talks with the Ancestors or has visions, clairvoyant, clairsentient. It's something I have always been able to do my whole life, but I don't get stuck on it or what it means; I just prefer to call it doing the Mahi.

Anyway, this is the story I want to share...

From the time I can remember, we had a photo of our Dad and an uncle taken in Egypt. It's a headshot of them between the pyramids and with camels and the Egyptian theme below them. This photo has always been there, like the wallpaper, I never took much notice, and my Dad didn't elaborate too much on it, but he told 'good stories' about his time there, but not so much about the fighting, all I knew was that he was in Egypt with the Maori Battalion during World War 2 fighting the Germans. Every year, I would support my Dad on Anzac Day as he marched with the rest of his comrades, even after I got married, he asked if I was coming home to be with him or accompany him if he went to another memorial site to pay tribute, we did this right up until he passed and his medals were passed to his oldest great-grandson.

My Dad and my Mum were what we called pukumahi, hard workers; they were contractors who worked for themselves. My Dad was also a very Spiritual man, as was our Mum. Both my parents were healers in their own right, but healing was against the law during their time, as well as most of my childhood, so they did the Mahi just with us and our extended family, who knew what my parents did.



My Dad was also Matakite and he did a lot of Mahi removing spirits and sending them on and doing "stuff" with people who were spiritually challenged, and of course I'm right there being an observer, (as I call it) but my Dad told me years later, I was his Pau, I was the one holding the space, even as a child I could do this but I never could explain how I did it, my Dad knew it too. He didn't like to talk or even acknowledge the Mahi, as you could get put in jail or pay a big fine for doing it.

My Mum did bodywork and Rongoa-Nature medicine. She taught me how to do bodywork from the time my younger siblings came along (I am the oldest daughter), every bath time the bathtub would be placed before the fire, and the oils and whatever Rongoa-herb-medicine she needed would come out as well, and my Mum or Dad would start with a karakiaprayer for the Mahi. I always remember my Mum singing or talking Maori under her breath during these times. It was a special time, almost Sacred, when she was in her flow with the Mahi on whichever of my siblings she was doing at the time. Her specialty was bone manipulation, and I remember others coming to her to do this Mahi. My parents were my first teachers in the Healing and Spiritual Mahi, even though I didn't know it at the time, as far as I was concerned, I just had to do it because....

In September 2018, I was gifted a journey to Egypt from an Egyptian woman who I had never met and didn't know. This was not a country I'd ever planned to visit, and I'd already booked to go to Machu Picchu. She invited me 3 times, she'd just lost her Dad, and she felt that he was connecting us somehow (I'm also a Daddy's girl). I talked with my Loved Ones, my Ancestors, and so I cancelled Peru, and with my friend Heather by my side, we were off to Egypt for 2 weeks.



I was totally exhausted as both Heather and I had just finished Mahi in Michigan, I flew back to Germany to drop off my luggage, pack another bag go straight to the airport to fly out. ,To be honest I was wide open energetically from the time we landed. I had no idea what I was there for or why but the Loved Ones had just said "Go," and so I experienced and I totally enjoyed the whole journey, but always with the underlying issue niggling at me...

It wasn't until I got home to Germany, where I was living at the time, that My Loved Ones came through and explained that my trip was to access Ancestral trauma. My Dad and many of my uncles had gone to Egypt during World War 2 and spilled blood with my, at the time, German partners people on their soil; they desecrated their land, and the Egyptian Ancestors wanted their lands cleared of my people's trauma.

It took 7 years... on the 7th September 2025 my brother Leon and his wife Sharon both ex-army, our baby sister Hato who is also a Healer, and I flew to Egypt. We also had Heather and her husband Caleb both marines as well as a beautiful group of people who were with us for their own purpose, to do their own Mahi.

My siblings and I did our Mahi for our collective Ancestors, asking for forgiveness and clearing and releasing from our own DNA this part of our history. We each did our Mahi in our own time and our own space as our Loved Ones directed us too, we just trusted their guidance and respected our hosts as we quietly did what we needed to do.

During this time, my Mum, who is in spirit, came through to also remind me that she was a recipient of my Dad's trauma and suffered during their time together, and that she, who is also Me and Hato, has the memories in our DNA, and so my sister Hato did this part of our healing for us and our descendants.


On our last day, I was asked if we could do a prayer circle, and I said yes... but I got the feeling, No, very strong and very definite... No!

I wasn't really clear why, but I asked the beautiful woman to come with me so I could explain. Once we sat, my Koroua-my great-grandfather, who is my main guide, came

through and explained.

"The Elder gentleman who was entrusted with our care during this whole time we were there is a Holy man who prays 5 times a day religiously as well as the crew who were with us on the Nile have been sending prayers up for us. If we had of done our circle for our prayers, then we would have just disrespected them and what they had been doing for us."

We were in their land and we are the visitors... all the Mahi we had just done to clear my Ancestors karma would have been for nothing... we would have trampled our Egyptian family's Mana Power...Again," This was my test...







But the prophecy of the Golden Child reminds us that within every challenge lies the seed of transformation. Through Guardians of the Sacred: **Ancestral Teachings for Global** Awakening, we are creating spaces for this light to grow, spaces where people can come together across cultures and generations to listen, to heal, and to remember.

The gathering this November in Santa Fe is part of that living vision. It is an answer to Spirit's call, to come together as one circle, to plant new seeds of hope, and to prepare the way for the Golden Child to be born through our collective consciousness.

"When we come together in prayer," I was told by Spirit, "we weave the light of the Golden Child into the fabric of the world." Every drumbeat, every song, every tear shed in sincerity helps to anchor this light upon the Earth.

The Role of the Mothers and Grandmothers

The mothers and grandmothers of the world carry a sacred responsibility: to hold the womb of creation, to protect the waters, and to nurture life. In the vision of the Golden Child, the elders gather around the newborn light, offering prayers from every lineage and nation. They form a protective circle of love and wisdom, ensuring that this light may grow strong and pure.

We, as Grandmothers, have been called to carry this prophecy forward, not as a story to be remembered, but as a living reality. Through ceremony, through community, and through daily acts of kindness, we are all midwives for this new consciousness. To each of you reading these words: you are part of this birthing. Your prayers, your art, your truth, your voice, all are threads in the great golden web being woven across the Earth.

When we close our eyes and breathe, when we silence the noise of fear and listen deeply to the voice of the heart, there we find the Golden Child, waiting patiently to be remembered. This is not a vision for the future; it is an invitation for now. To live with integrity. To act with love. To remember that every breath is sacred.

A Message for the Next Seven Generations

To the children and the youth: you are the Golden Ones. You are the bridge between worlds. You carry the wisdom of the ancestors in your bones and the light of the future in your eyes. Protect that light. Trust it. Let it guide you to build a world that honors all beings.

To the elders: your prayers are the medicine that keeps this vision alive. Every story, every song, every blessing you share feeds the roots of this golden tree of life. And to all of us, no matter our age or origin, remember: the prophecy is alive because we are alive. The Golden Child is not coming from outside; it is awakening from within.



The Living Prayer In every gathering, in every ceremony, we call upon this light. We ask that it shine through our words, our actions, and our dreams. As we prepare to gather again at Guardians of the Sacred this November, let us each hold this vision close: that the time of awakening is now. The Golden Child is being born through our collective love, through the way we walk, the way we speak, the way we honor all that is sacred. May we each remember that we are the guardians of this light. May we walk gently, love fiercely, and tend the seeds of peace wherever we go.



Among the sacred objects that carry the wisdom of ages, crystal skulls hold a unique place as resonant vessels of memory, consciousness, and ancestral knowledge.
