Our History.
















Discover our Rich Past & Why We Are Uniquely Nectar.

its **Equipment** (from concept through to design, maintenance, logistics and long-term aftercare) and


its **Customers and Partners** (who have supported the business throughout the last 50 years).






Our Global Reach & Coverage.

Located in the largest natural harbour on the African continent, Nectar Sierra Leone Bulk Terminal (NSBT) is a subsidiary of Nectar Group Ltd. The Company has had a presence in Freetown since October 1988, when they first assisted in bagging imported rice from bulk vessels.

In 2015, Nectar took over the Bulk Terminal in Freetown, Sierra Leone, employing 80% of Sierra Leone nationals. In 2016, the port was recognised by the 'Best Dry Bulk Port' award at the IBJ industry awards.

NSBT is currently expanding its operations with a 3rd deepwater berth project, due for completion later this year. The new berth will facilitate the arrival of vessels of up to 225 metres in length with a 13-metre draft, improving the economies of scale in shipping cargo.

NECTAR SIERRA LEONE TERMINAL

The expansion of the bulk terminal in Freetown is one of the largest and complex projects undertaken by the Group. The project comprises of the design and construction of a new deep-water berth of 190m and enhanced quay space of 1.2 hectares (12,000 sq m) to facilitate a larger-class of vessel size to call at QEII terminal at Freetown (the largest natural harbour on the African Continent) as well as incorporating refurbishment of the existing berths.

New berth will enhance cargo handling capabilities & vessel discharging speeds.







NSBT will reclaim 1.2 hectares (2.96 acres) of land. Enabling further shoreside storage and new warehousing facilities.



NSBT Developments. 3rd Berth Expansion Project Update.

Nectar Group has partnered with Marine Consulting Engineers, Beckett Rankine and Civil Engineering firm, Eiffage Génie Civil to deliver the berth expansion. The collaboration is part of steps being taken to meet international standards of the terminal in every operational aspect, with NSBT significantly investing in equipment and infrastructure at Sierra Leone's primary multi-user bulk and break-bulk port.

The project is currently well underway and as of February of this year, the installation of tie rods has been completed. Demobilization of the marine spread commenced at the beginning of March, including dredging and reclamation works. Ongoing works for the east revetment, flood-wall, existing drainage, and mooring blocks continues.






