03 matures them in christ 04 and empowers them to impact families, villages, and nations for christ.




OUR "Credo"

*In contexts hostile to the Gospel, we refrain from mentioning "His Son" until the club is well-established, there are children believers in the club, and it is safe for the children and mentors.




CIC'S HISTORY: A STORY OF THE LORD'S FAITHFULNESS










THE IMPORTANCE OF CHILDREN IN THE GREAT COMMISSION






THE OPPORTUNITY AND URGENCY IN AFRICA

Children are about 50% of the 500 million in Africa who are considered unreached or minimally reached with the Gospel

Violence, political instability across Africa has increased +100% in past 10 years. (source: WSJ)

Today Africa has more victims of violence with a tremendous growing number of in-country and overborder refugees. Children and youth are the biggest victims in all of this - millions experiencing brokenness, trauma, hopelessness, and looking for meaningful solutions to the challenging world around them.



But even so, children and youth are eager for the truth and are hungry to know that they have a Heavenly Father who made them, loves them, and has a hope for them!

REACHING THE UNREACHED




"All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations. . . ." Matthew 28:18-19

In the Great Commission, the local church has a unique role since they are the ones whom God has placed in their contexts - they know the language and culture and can even more effectively reach the unreached in their countries.

CIC's vision is to inspire and equip the local indigenous churches, who are near unreached people groups, to go outside their church walls and start weekly outreach & discipleship clubs that minister God's love and truth deeply with children who have never heard the Gospel.

Children encounter Jesus through God's living, active Word, the power of the Holy Spirit, and the joy and love that overflows from all aspects of their CIC Club experience and relationships. Our gentle "come and see who Jesus is" approach has been much more effective in reaching Muslim and Animist children than many other traditional missions approaches.

"I came from an Animist family. . . . The joy I saw in the children pushed me to go to the CIC children's club. Once I started I saw the greatness of God through what he created and I understood that God loved me and he cried out to me so that I could love and serve him. . . . Today I became a Christian and I go to the Baptist church which is in our neighborhood and every day I pray that my parents also become Christians like me. Every time we are told a Bible story at the club I share it with my parents hoping that they will go to church one day. I really say thank you to CIC who allowed me to be a Christian today."

I WAS MUSLIM GOING TO KORAN SCHOOL BUT NOW BELIEVE IN JESUS

Before meeting the CIC club, I came from a Muslim family. My father was a devout worshiper of Islam he enrolled me in the Koranic school to learn the Koran. And this education in this school was cruel. Because the teacher of this school beat us like animals without any mercy. Not a feeling of love from this master towards us who are his students. And I have a friend named Simon who goes to the CIC club, and he invited me one day to come and watch the club's activities. From the first day, I was impressed by the welcome from the club instructor. And as God did things well for me, the meetings took place every Wednesday and Saturday evening. Since I discovered this place of hospitality, I gave up going to Koranic school. No corporal punishment in the club. Considering this aspect, the lessons and advice that we received in the club with this instructor began to change the way I behaved in the family. The first moments my father knew that I was no longer going to Koranic school, he got angry with me and hit me as if he was going to kill me. But despite that I didn't go there anymore. And one day my father wanted to know where I was going. He followed me when I left the house without me knowing. Before he arrived, club activities had already started. And he saw the instructor who supervised us with exciting love and all the children were happy to participate in the club's activities. And at the end of the activities that evening, my father did what many parents of Muslim children never do. He approached the instructor to encourage him about

the education he was giving although he knew that we were receiving an education different from that of his religion. It was from that same evening that he stopped threatening me and encouraged me to continue going to the club. And the school year that followed, he sent me to public school so that I could also learn French like other children my age. Through the CIC club and the teachings, there was a very big change in my life because I had already started smoking cigarettes and even started sleeping around. And my father, although he was fervent in Islam, could not prevent these destructive things from my life. My father really liked my change and I believe that after all he will abandon Islam to continue in Christianity. As for me, I am already with Jesus Christ.



THE LAM TRAINING HELPED ME TEACH CHILDREN GOD'S WORD WITHOUT MATERIALS

"The LAM training has impacted me positively. This training has made me learn that I can teach children in a more effective way even without using materials. I used to think that you can only teach using visual aids but I have learnt with LAM the people can be the people, the places and the things in acting the story. I have seen that the six sweet discussion questions are very important and it is the backbone of the LAM to help the children understand the story and dig deeper for revelations. [And we can know if the children] have understood the story by how they retell the story in Sweet Discussion question number one."

I AM A FORMER MUSLIM AND NOW SHARE THE LOVE OF JESUS WITH THE VILLAGE CHILDREN

"My name is Hawa, I am of Muslim background, I am the only Christian coming from our family. I thank the CIC training team for their work, the Lord passed through them to help me put my gift into practice. I met Maman Sira during training and she shared the vision of CIC with me. I then decided to start the club with the children in my neighborhood. Most of my community abandoned me because of my faith, I was alone and pushed aside. But when I started the club, the children surrounded me every day. They are my friends and give me joy. I share with them the love of the Lord Jesus Christ and teach them the right voice to follow. . . .

Our neighborhood is now awakened and blessed through the club. The children meet every Thursday to listen to Bible lessons that are good for their life in this world and their eternal life. This also strengthened. . . the children and allowed them to change their bad behavior to now be model children in the neighborhood:

Every time there is a dispute between them, they say to each other, what were we told at the club? They correct each other and ask each other for forgiveness.

Let's persevere in work, and we will bring change in our communities."

THE LOCAL MUSLIM SCHOOL ALLOWED US TO START A CIC CLUB!

"I want to share about God's faithfulness. In our area there is a Muslim school. In the past, both Christian and Muslim children were being forced to join the Muslim Koran devotionals. Time by time I was requesting to go and start a Bible club, especially for Christian children in the school. With time the school management accepted that I do this and that was a praise to God! I started teaching them Bible stories from Genesis and amazingly even Muslim children joined. The class attendance is always Muslim and Christian children and that is a praise to God."

DEEPLY DISCIPLING CHILDREN & YOUTH

DISCIPLING THE CHILDREN

We had many challenges in 2024, including: floods in 2 countries; significant conflicts, political instability and terrorism in 13 of our 27 country programs; and leadership transitions in 2 of our countries. But God! By His grace, we were still able to see almost 200,000 children deeply discipled in the pure Word of God!

Using our Living Active Method, children and youth engage with God's pure Word in profound ways, applying time-tested inductive Bible study techniques, multi-sensory learning, broad participation, and deeply reflective discussion questions that lead to personal application and transformation.

THROUGH THE CLUB I LEARNED GOD'S WORD AND UNDERSTOOD WHO JESUS IS

I was born in a Muslim family and since I started coming to the club, I learned to memorize the word of God and I understood who Jesus is.. I decided to give my life to Jesus. My parents don't want me to go to Church but I am praying.

Your partnership in 2024 helped us not just disciple children but also equip and empower youth as multiplying disciplers who:

- share Jesus' love and truth with others now and for future generations
- · launch new clubs and serve as club ministry leaders
- co-lead LAM trainings for churches, and share the vision with pastors and mission networks too.

We held 137 Youth Leadership Development events in 2024 like Child & Youth Leadership Retreats (CYLT), Spiritual Stewardship & Integrity Retreats (SSIR), and LAM Trainings specifically to develop young leaders with a Biblical worldview, based on Christ's example of servant leadership.

But one day something pushed me to go to the club once, twice and eventually every time there was a club I went and my life started to change and I started bringing my friends, my brothers and sisters at the CIC club and teaching them about the passage from Matthew chapter 18 verse 10 to 14 - God does not want any one of these littles ones to perish, but all to have eternal life."

CIC CHILDREN AND YOUTH JOYFULLY SERVE AS CLUB LEADERS AND FACILITATORS

"This training has helped me as a child leader in many ways to understand why LAM [works] to help children . ..understand a bible story and that is by seeing, doing and acting out the story. Now I understand that I can fully lead the club when the adult mentor is not around. I will collaborate with our mentor to always facilitate or be the accountability partner and help other children to do the same."

YOUTH AS MULTIPLYING DISCIPLERS

About 23 years ago, Siye, a university student in Guinea, West Africa, attended a CIC training. He was inspired to go back home and start CIC Clubs in his own Animist village. All the village children and youth received Jesus as Lord and Savior and began attending the club. Siye chose a few of them as leaders and discipled them to lead the clubs even when he returned to university. Despite much persecution the children's faith prevailed, and miraculously, after several years, even most of the elders accepted Christ! Siye continued to coach and disciple youth as co-leaders; together they launched many clubs around the Forest region of Guinea.

A few years later, two of these youth leaders, 18 year-old Francis and James, were inspired to cross over the border into Liberia (with only \$7 in their pockets) and do the same thing there. Though local churches would not host them, a Muslim man of peace graciously allowed them to sleep in his car.

Every day, Francis and James would wake up in that hot car, work for their breakfast, and then walk 20 or more kilometers daily to launch and run children's clubs in neighboring areas. As the months passed, they would identify young believers who had leadership potential and mentor them the same way they had been coached by Siye on club leadership. After several months, these new Liberian youth leaders were then able to run the clubs on their own with ongoing coaching two of these youths included the Muslim man's own sons, Lousine and Lassana. This Muslim father accepted their new faith because he saw the change Jesus had brought to their lives. By 2007 they were running clubs on their own, with Francis and James providing mentorship.

In 2012 the boys became regional coordinators - overseeing many clubs that in total were discipling over 500 children - and were able to train more youth leaders, as Francis and James had done for them. In several years Lousine and Lassana were able to carry on much of the ministry as Francis, and later James, took on West African regional leadership and senior coaching roles.

In 2019 Francis and James empowered Lousine and Lassana to lead the Liberia CIC ministry - with over 40,000 children in clubs across the country. Together with their national team they are developing younger generation teams that can replace them - just as Francis and James did. Lousine is also serving as an international CIC coach, helping other countries with best practices coaching as well. Today Liberia remains one of our many thriving country programs - full of youth and children sharing the love and truth of Jesus with others - and developing more Multiplying Youth Disciplers by God's grace!




HOW YOUR US DONATIONS WERE USED
