



IN FOCUS: CRAFTING THE JOY OF NOVEMBER

November is a season for slowing down, savoring the beauty of autumn, and reflecting on gratitude. Whether you're documenting the build-up to Thanksgiving or quiet moments of joy throughout the month, this guide will help you tell the story of your November in a way that feels heartfelt and meaningful.





WHY THIS STORY MATTERS (THE FOCUS)

November invites us to pause and reflect on what we're grateful for—moments big and small, people who matter, and the beauty of change. Starting with why ensures your story captures the heart of this season.



PROMPTS:

What does gratitude look like for you this month?

How does November feel in your life right now?

Is there a tradition, ritual, or simple pleasure that defines this season for you?

How does this month prepare you for the upcoming holidays?

DESIGN TIP: USE WARM, NEUTRAL TONES OR EARTHY COLORS THAT REFLECT THE PEACEFUL, REFLECTIVE ENERGY OF NOVEMBER. CONSIDER INCORPORATING LEAVES, TEXTURES, OR HANDWRITTEN ELEMENTS TO EMPHASIZE PERSONAL CONNECTIONS.





THE BIG PICTURE (THE WIDE SHOT)

The wide shot provides the backdrop for your November story. It's about capturing the rhythm of this season—falling leaves, cozy evenings, and the gatherings that bring us together.



PROMPTS:

What does November look like for you this year?

How are you preparing for Thanksgiving throughout the month?

Who are the people and places that shape your season of gratitude?

What seasonal activities, sights, or routines define this time of year?

DESIGN TIP: USE PHOTOS OF FALL FOLIAGE, BUSTLING KITCHENS, OR EVEN A QUIET MORNING COFFEE AS VISUAL ANCHORS FOR YOUR STORY. MIX THESE WITH JOURNALING TO GIVE A SENSE OF PLACE AND TIME.





ZOOMING IN (THE CLOSE-UP)

The close-up highlights the little details that make November memorable. These are the moments of connection, comfort, and gratitude that often go unnoticed but carry the deepest meaning.



PROMPTS:

What small, everyday moments brought you joy this month? (e.g., a favorite candle, a cozy sweater, or a spontaneous hug.)

Are there specific foods, recipes, or traditions that stand out?

What sensory details capture November for you—crisp air, the sound of leaves crunching, or the scent of baking pies?

DESIGN TIP: PAIR PHOTOS OF THESE DETAILS WITH JOURNALING THAT DESCRIBES WHY THEY MATTER. USE EMBELLISHMENTS LIKE STITCHING OR LAYERED PATTERNS TO DRAW ATTENTION TO THESE INTIMATE MOMENTS.





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THE LAYERS (COMPOSITION)

The composition blends photos, journaling, and design to tell the complete story of November. It's where gratitude, memories, and creativity come together to document the story of your joy this season.



PROMPTS:

What colors, textures, or design elements remind you of the coziness of November?

How can you use journaling to reflect on the lessons or themes of gratitude in your life?

Like a quilt, weave multiple stories together in one layout- from the quiet moments to the big celebrations to capture the vibe of the month.






