HOLIDAY IN HOGSBACK

Advice for visitors

Welcome to this beautiful and unique little village. Here are a few important things you will need to be aware of during your stay on the mountain.

Firstly the roads are a bit heavy to navigate, with potholes and the like, it is best to just drive slowly and take it easy. Low clearance cars may have to drive even slower. Be extra careful of the roads when they are wet. Along with the dodgy roads, you will find free roaming livestock as well dogs and wildlife moving around, which will also pose a challenge when walking with your own dogs, it is important to keep them on leash the entire time to avoid incidents.

There are no street lights, and it gets quite dark here to navigate, you may spot a bunny or a bushbuck as well. It is also important to pack a few strong flashlights. The mountain does get loadshedding.

The weather here changes and fast, it is best to bring along enough warm clothing, waterproof jackets, gumboots and good footwear, umbrellas are also very useful as it can rain for days on end here.

NB. Bring along a well-stocked first aid kit as well as fill up on your chronic medication.
Bug repellent is also most needed as there are horse flies and mozzies that will hinder.

When out enjoying the beauty of Hogsback, please be sure to not leave litter behind.

More information

Hogsback has Samango monkeys, the country's only exclusively forest-dwelling guenon, as well as baboons. Please close up homes properly when leaving and do not leave food out as the baboons will cause issues. Also please do not feed the Monkeys or Baboons.

There are no dentists or doctor's offices on the mountain, however, there is a nurse able to assist where needed and has a few basic medicines available.

Down in the village of Alice, several doctors are available and there are pharmacies. Please take a look at the important contact info below.

For casualties and serious matters, there is the Victoria Hospital in Alice.

It is fire season, and there will be a lot of controlled burns around. It is not permitted for visitors to make fires in the forests or anywhere apart from at your accommodation.

There is chapel which has various worship service, located on Main Road in Upper Hogsback.

The SPAR has an ATM, but does not always have cash, thus it is very important to bring cash with you.

At the end of this paper, there are the opening and closing times for the main shops as well as the local ads and info. At the back of the paper is the up to date Hogsback Map.

If in need of information when in Hogsback, you can make a stop at Woltree or Redclay Cafe, both right on the main road.

Butchery Update

I recently visited The Butchery to check on their progress and was thrilled to hear that they have been doing extremely well since opening earlier this year. They are constantly upgrading the butchery to improve the customer experience and workflow. Despite a few minor and not-so-minor glitches in the beginning, everything is now happily sorted and running smoothly. It's great to report that load shedding has no effect on the butchery or its meat. All the necessary measures are in place for load shedding and have served them well.

Local establishments have been a significant source of support, purchasing a considerable amount of meat from The Butchery and helping it thrive. Owners Wean and Bellina are delighted with their success so far, and the community's support has been astronomical, fueling a steady growth spurt. The cuts of meat are well enjoyed by the community, with pork sausages and pork rashers being the favorites, followed by chicken. Biltong and dry wors fly off the shelves, and it's hard for the butchery to keep up with demand. Who knew there were so many meat lovers on the mountain?



I spoke to Wean about the quality of the chicken and was assured that it is free range well looked after chickens, that are handled humanely and healthily. It is not done commercially; they are fed organic and the environment is clean and wellkept. So in other words, the chickens are organic, happy, clean, healthy, and fat, and that is why they are so tasty.

In the new year, the Deli side of the butchery will also be opened and will stock local goodies from the community. New meat products will also be introduced in the new year along with a few other tasty editions.

Customers can also place custom orders and the meat can be cut and processed according to the specific needs. You are also welcome to get in touch with them for any special items you would like such as the pet mince or precise cuts. The butchery also offers a special service whereby you Can bring your carcasses to be hung and processed according to your needs. A cutting and holding fee is charged.

On the side of stocking venison, the need for it is there, and Wean mentioned that if anyone does go hunting, he will be happy to also buy venison carcasses if anyone has in excess. Or if anyone nearby can offer quality venison, you can contact the Butchery to arrange with Wean.

Wean and Bellina are extremely grateful for the huge support from the community and would like to thank everyone for really being excellent, especially Rory from the SPAR who also helped out a great deal.

The Butchery now also has a Facebook page, and Instagram as well as a WhatsApp group where specials are announced.

There will be great specials available over the festive time but will have limited stock, so it is best to get your orders in as soon as possible. As promised, the butchery offers beautiful meat products that are packaged very well and done professionally.

Please note that the butchery will be closed on the following days:

15, 16, 17 and 18 December 24, 25 and 26 December. 31st December till the 3rd of January.

One can tell that Candy is very passionate about her craft and loves what she does, which is reflected in the delicious chocolates that she creates. She makes around 1500 chocolates per week, which is a lot of hard work and dedication. The Chocolate shop also offers warm beverages and gelato ice cream to complement their sweet treats.







