Virector's Note

Holidays can be celebrated in so many different ways; we truly appreciate you taking some time out of the hustle and bustle of the season to join us.

I'm beyond thrilled that the cast wholeheartedly embraced this idea – their willingness to experiment with me – bringing their unique personalities to these familiar characters – is what gives this production its heart.

Our stage manager, Dave, and our set designer, Vince, were ready and willing to help me create this world; I'll be forever grateful to them for the support through the various iterations of set requirements, and also for the way ALL the other production team members quickly and completely jumped on board with this concept!

The message is clear to me: the spirit of Santa must live on... Not in department stores, or how much we give or get, but in our hope, and in our desire to believe in the power of community. Those who have given their time and talent and creative energy to bring this version of Miracle on 34th Street to life are perfect examples of that. They have my most sincere thanks and admiration.

As the year comes to a close and we begin looking forward, let's all endeavor to be like Kris Kringle – bringing love, kindness, and joy to the world around us.

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
