

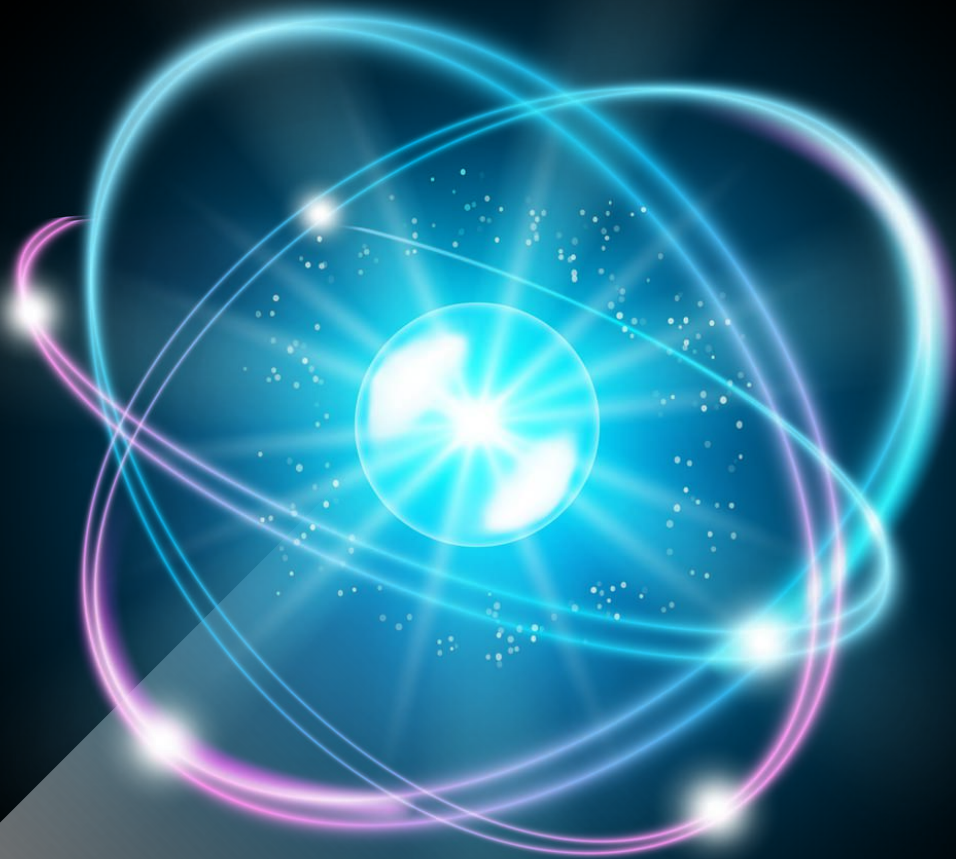

It reminded us that true giving goes beyond material help—it’s about being present and kind.

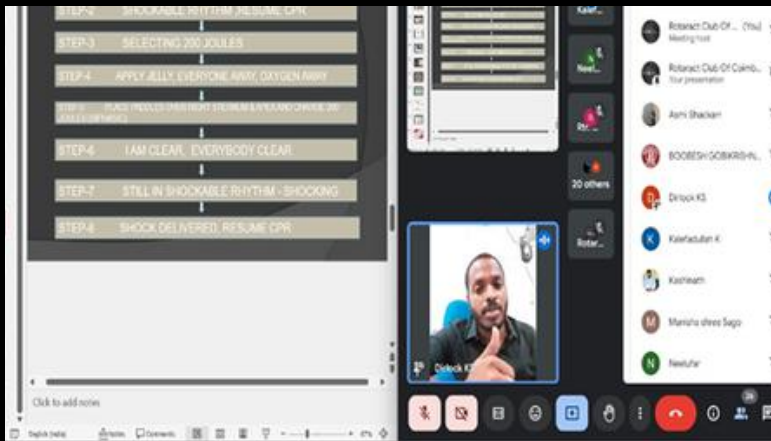
The experience inspired a sense of social responsibility among volunteers and planted the seeds for future efforts.
