

Important info

Common questions

- What do the listed grades for each session mean?
 - To be eligible for a session your camper should be entering one of the listed grades in fall 2025.
- How is cost listed?
 - Each price is per camper, including prices listed for troop and family camps.
- How do I register for a camp?
 - For overnight and statewide day camps, please register using CampInTouch. You will need to make an account to register. Full instructions can be found on our camp website.
 - For Tomahawk Ranch and Sky High Ranch day camps, and troop and family camps, you will register on the myGS events calendar found on the main GSCO website.
 - For volunteer run camps, please see the full session listing on our camp website for instructions.
- When are camp forms and payment due?
 - Full payment for your each camp session is due four weeks prior to the start of camp. The deadline is the same for all required forms. You can see the deadline date specified beside each required form listed in your CampInTouch account.
- What is the cancellation policy?
 - Cancellations for most reasons will be refunded, minus the registration processing fee, if the cancellation is made with a written request four weeks before the session begins. After that, the balance is refunded only if the camper moves out of the state, has been certified to be ill by a physician, or there is a family emergency. Camp grant information

To apply for a camp grant for Tomahawk Ranch, Sky High Ranch, or day camp, follow the steps below.

- 1. Register and pay the 10% deposit for your desired camp CampInTouch.
- 2. Submit the Camp Grant Application.
- 3. The camp grant administrator will review the application and communicate the amount granted to the family within two to three weeks.
- 4. If the family decides the grant doesn't work for their finances, they must email a reply to decline the grant and we will cancel their camper and refund their deposit in full.





Backpacking

Campers should be comfortable living and sleeping in a rustic "survival" setting and able to carry approximately 20-25 percent of their body weight. While offsite backpacking, campers will spend multiple nights at a primitive campsite, carrying gear, setting up tents, and cooking meals. There will be plenty of time for other fun, on-site and off-site camp activities, including a trip to a local adventure park complete with ziplines and a high ropes course.

Barnyard Buddies

Each day is filled with hands-on activities, animal care, and barnyard games, all while making new friends who love animals as much as you do! This is an intro animal camp.

Giddy Up

Get your boots and your giddy up attitude and join us for a week of horseback riding at Sky High Ranch. This camp includes time with the horses every day and three - four rides and an overnight at the barn. This is Level 1/Beginners and is for campers who have little to no experience with horses.






