
Introducing Our New Chamber Staff



Celebrating the History of Barn Quilts

Barn quilts have a long tradition dating back almost 300 years to the time when immigrants from Austria, Germany and the Netherlands in particular came to America. Many of these immigrants were Amish or Lutherans and Mennonites who were seeking religious freedom, and settled primarily in Pennsylvania where barn quilts in this country originated, before spreading throughout New England and other parts of the country. Barn quilts were used to adorn their barns with distinctive patterns, both to identify farms and to protect them from evil spirits, and bring good fortune to their land. In some cases the patterns and symbolism became an important part of the Underground Railroad.

In the late 1700's paint was very expensive and so painting a barn quilt on a barn became a way for farmers to adorn and identify their barn with a distinctive pattern, rather than painting the whole barn. A typical barn quilt measured four feet by four feet and was designed using geometric shapes, and unique symbols that identified an individual farm. These designs were able to be spotted from a distance so enabling travelers to identify farms and distinguish them from others.

In the early 1800's up to the Civil War, the Underground Railroad developed as a network of routes and safe houses for enslaved people to escape to freedom in the north. The use of quilts, whether fabric quilts hung on fences, or barn quilts, acted as clandestine maps for these refugees, with the patterns and symbols becoming part of a secret language. The Monkey Wrench Quilt symbolized the need to collect tools which would be necessary on the long journey north, a Bear's Paw directed refugees to follow the trails of bears through the mountains of Appalachia, and the North Star indicated they were on the right track. These symbols, among others, were part of this secret language, and are very much used by quilters today.

This year, for the first time, barn quilts will be an exhibitor category at the Guilford Fair. Kelley Hanke, Chair of the Arts and Crafts Department, will be creating a barn quilt which will symbolize welcome and safety. The design will incorporate the image of a log cabin and will be primarily painted in the black and gold colors of the Guilford Agricultural Society. The Underground Railroad Log Cabin quilt often had a black center indicating a "safe" house, and a yellow central square indicating a beacon in the wilderness, so informing enslaved people that farms were safe for them to stay. It will be mounted on one of the barns at the Fairgrounds.

Come to the Fair in September and see these new exhibits.

As in the past, one gate admission covers all shows, the Guilford Fair Circus, competitions, displays and exhibits inside, with special appearances this year from the **Cortes Family Flying Trapeze Troupe**, and the return of the famous **Flying Wallendas, and Rosaire's Royal Racing Pigs.** Only rides and refreshments are extra. The annual Guilford Fair Parade will start at 10am Saturday Sept 20th with the theme this year being "Experiencing the Sounds of Guilford." See details at Guilford Fair Parade

The Guilford Fair, and its producers, The Guilford Agricultural Society, have been a mainstay of Guilford life since 1859. Town historian Joel Helander wrote about the Fair as "part of the spirit of old New England."

John Hammarlund, President of the Agricultural Society says, "I have been involved with the Fair since I was a teenager, and the sounds of Guilford include all the noises which brings the Fair to life. The tractor pulls, the horse pulls, the sounds of cattle and sheep and chickens, but also the sounds of the circus, of musical entertainment, of children and adults alike laughing and enjoying the exhibits and amusement rides, and of course the sounds of deep fried everything. And we also recognize the sounds of the traditional Guilford Fair Parade around the Guilford Green on the Saturday of Fair weekend. The local school bands, the farm tractors, trucks pulling floats, fife and drum corps, Fire Department, Police Department, cheerleaders, and the clip clop of the horses and donkeys. All sounds of Guilford to experience and celebrate. Come to the Fair and enjoy all that it has to offer, and make happy memories."

EXHIBITOR RULES AND ENTRY FORMS: Entry Forms are available NOW and – for most departments – entries are open through Saturday September 13th. Prospective entrants will find everything they need on the website under Exhibitors. A printed Exhibitor's Guide will also be available at the Guilford Town Hall, Guilford Community Center and other area locations. While the general deadline to submit entry forms is Saturday September 13th, some deadlines with special requirements – such as for some animals – are earlier. Entry delivery dates range from September 13th – 18th depending on class entered.

All exhibits are to be in place on Thursday September 18th, according to specific department acceptance times.

ENTERTAINMENT ANNOUNCED: This year, the Guilford Fair hosts three bands performing four concerts on all three days, all free with a general Fair admission.

- The PLR Stage welcomes **Seven Wonders**, a **Tribute to Fleetwood Mac and Stevie Nicks**, Friday, September 19th at 8:30pm. These seven world class musicians recreate all the great hits of Fleetwood Mac, and since their inception in 2017 have garnered national attention for their high energy performances.
- **Night Train** hits the stage Saturday, September 20th at 8:30pm. The band has been rocking stages across the U.S. for 14 years, from House of Blues to MTV's Club LaVela. They are one of the hottest Guns n'Roses tribute shows on the circuit.

• **Houston Bernard** will perform on Sunday September 21st at 11am and 2pm. Houston, an Army veteran, has transitioned into a successful country music artist nominated for seven awards at the 2024 Josie Music Awards. A true country music maverick who has captured audiences nationwide.

All ages will delight in the free Guilford Fair Circus featuring the popular Flying Wallendas, joined this year by Tino's daughter Alida and the Cortes Family Flying Trapeze Troupe. **Guilford Fair Circus Acts**

Other entertainment abounds throughout the fairgrounds – most with multiple shows daily. They include Rosaire's Royal Racers, a family owned and operated company, featuring three different breeds of racing pigs at each and every 20-30 minute show throughout the day. Old favorites like the Records and Burpee Children's Zoo and Zoo Show, Rockwell Amusements carnival rides, craft, agricultural and animal exhibits, livestock and tractor pulls, camel and pony rides, a petting zoo, food for all tastes, and as always the beer garden tent of adult beverages. ABOUT THE FAIR: A Library of Congress Local Legacy staged by the non-profit, all volunteer, <u>Guilford Agricultural Society</u> since 1859, the Guilford Fair provides fun for all ages with continuous entertainment, exhibitions, demonstrations, food, and carnival rides by Rockwell Amusements. General admission covers all entertainment and exhibits. Rides and refreshments are extra. Admission for children ages 11 and under remains free during these difficult inflationary times for families.



Why Merge?

From our founding (almost 90 years ago) Crosspoint has focused on serving our community. Recently new challenges have presented themselves. These challenges have raised questions about how we proceed. Member needs have become more immediate. Regulatory expectations have become more stringent. The demand for faster turnaround is ever present. After careful consideration and discussions with our board of directors and senior leadership team, we decided to merge operations. The next logical question was with whom?

Celebrating the Hyland House Museum's Quilt Collection

On Saturday September 13th, 2025, the Hyland House Museum will host an event to celebrate their unique collection of historic quilts. The Museum, built in 1713, and located at 84 Boston Street in Guilford, has been owned and run by the Dorothy Whitfield Society for over a hundred years, and is independent from other historical organizations in Guilford. The Museum has an extensive collection of furniture, artefacts and textiles depicting life in colonial New England. The collection of six quilts, dating from 1750 through 1885 will be available for viewing, and the event will start with a lecture at 11am by Pam Weeks, a distinguished expert on quilts and their history, and the Binney Family Curator of the New England Quilt Museum in Massachusetts. Her lecture will focus on "New England Quilts and the Stories They Tell".

Pam Weeks has been making and designing quilts since the 1980's, and in 2013 published her first book on Civil War quilts made for soldiers. As curator of the New England Quilt Museum, she works with many different quilters, collectors and institutions planning exhibits for the museum. Her lectures span everything from the history of quilting from the 18th century to the present day, to Civil War quilts, and how quilts often tell a story, and raise social awareness and protest through textiles.

The event will include a light lunch at noon after the lecture at 11am, an Antique Quilt Assessment from 1pm - 3pm where attendees can bring their quilts and have them assessed and discussed by Pam Weeks, and a tour of the Hyland House Museum. Beat Inflation with Your Back-to-School Budget

Back-to-school season is always a busy time, but in 2025, it comes with a bigger-thannormal price tag. Between inflation, tariffs, and general economic uncertainty, everything from pencils to laptops may cost more this year. According to Business Insider¹, inflation is projected to rise to around 5% by mid-2025. For many families, that means tighter budgets and tougher choices.

But here's the good news. You might be able to outsmart inflation. With some extra planning and a smart spending strategy, you could send your kids back to school fully equipped. Even better, you might do this without sending your finances into a spiral. Let's walk through some potentially inflation-busting tips to help you stretch your back-to-school budget a little bit further this year.

Everything May Cost More in 2025

Some level of inflation is almost always expected, although the rate may rise and fall over time. This year, inflation is driven by a mix of supply chain disruptions, labor shortages, and rising tariffs. While the overall inflation rate hovers around 5%, some school-related items have seen even sharper increases, such as:

- Stationery and school supplies: Up 7.6% year-over-year
- Backpacks and bags: Up 6.4%
- Children's apparel: Up 5.1%
- Electronics (including laptops and calculators): Up 8.2%
- Lunchbox food staples (like juice boxes, fruit snacks, and sandwich fixings): Up 9.3%

The National Retail Federation estimates that families may spend an average of \$586 per student on back-to-school shopping in 2025². That's a significant increase from previous years. And for families with multiple kids, the total spent around back-to-school time may easily climb into the thousands.

1. Start With a Plan and an Inventory

Before you buy anything, do a deep dive into your home's hidden school supply stash. Check drawers, closets, last year's backpacks, and craft bins for leftover notebooks, unused folders, or gently used clothing. You might be surprised at what you may cross off your list this way.

Next, involve your kids in making a "Needs vs. Wants" list. This could help you prioritize purchases like required school supplies and new shoes over trendy accessories or duplicate items you don't need.

Tip: Use a simple spreadsheet or budgeting app to keep track of what you already have, what you still need, and how much you hope and plan to spend in each category.

2. Build a Realistic Budget—Then Stick to It

Budgeting is always a good idea. But during times of inflation, it's essential. Set an overall spending limit, then break it down into categories like clothing and shoes, school supplies, lunch and snack items, and extracurricular fees.

If your kids are old enough, include them in the budget discussions. It's a great way to teach them financial literacy and set their expectations about budgeting early. Let them help make decisions on trade-offs—for example, choosing between name-brand shoes or a new lunchbox. This may help give them a sense of ownership over their choices and thereby possibly make them feel less deprived.

3. Shop Smart - Time It and Use the Tools

Timing is everything. Many retailers hold sales closer to the first day of school, and some offer lowest-advertised price matching. Additionally, many states host tax-free weekends. These let you avoid paying sales tax on certain school-related purchases. Depending on where you live, this might save you up to 8% or more.

Some other tools and tricks to manage savings include using price comparison apps like Honey or Rakuten. These apps let you hunt for the cheapest price for an item among multiple retailers.

Also, be sure to check for student and educator discounts. You might be able to join store loyalty programs for exclusive discounts and early alerts on sales.

Finally, if you have more than one child, you could buy in bulk for supplies like pens, paper, and snacks. Warehouse stores often offer these items at a much cheaper price than when you buy in smaller amounts.

Tip: Thrift stores, consignment shops, and buy-nothing groups on Facebook may be opportunities to find gently used clothes, backpacks, and even calculators.

4. Use Payment Strategies That Work for You

Inflation doesn't just impact prices—it may also sneak up to show on your monthly credit card bill. If you're using credit to manage back-to-school spending, be strategic. Avoid carrying a balance on high-interest cards unless you absolutely have to.

You may also pay with cashback or rewards cards, and if you could, pay off the balance in full to get a bit of a bonus on your spending. And if you have any points or gift cards you've been saving, now might be the appropriate time to use them. By planning ahead, you may avoid interest charges and manage the financial stress that comes with overspending.

5. Plan for the Whole School Year

It's easy to focus on August and September, but don't forget about expenses that pop up later. Think ahead and budget for picture day costs, sports or club fees, school trips or fundraisers, and holiday events. By spreading out your budget over the whole school year, you may avoid scrambling to cover surprise expenses later on.

6. Involve the Kids - Teach Budgeting Skills Early

Back-to-school budgeting is a teachable moment. Involve your kids in making wiser spending choices. Show them how much things cost, how to compare prices, and how sticking to a budget might create more financial benefits later. If your kids are earning an allowance or working a summer job, encourage them to contribute toward paying for the "wants," like brand-name clothing or new accessories. This may teach them ownership and the value of money.

7. Look for Help If You Need It

If inflation has made back-to-school shopping a financial burden, you're not alone. Many communities offer resources and donation programs to help lighten the load. Check for local nonprofits offering free backpacks or school supplies. Churches or community centers may also have donation days where you may pick up items for free. Some school districts have programs that help cover technology or uniform costs. And don't be afraid to speak with a financial professional. A quick planning session might uncover ways to manage other expenses, set up automatic savings for next year, or even explore tax-advantaged education accounts.





