From challenge to opportunity

Presidential message - August 2024

If we are to truly change the world with The Magic of Rotary, it's up to all of us to foster a sense of belonging in our clubs. But every club should take its own path to get there, and the Action Plan can help you find your way. What does that look like?

Take for instance the Rotary Club of Beveren-Waas in Belgium. It was chartered in 1974 but has evolved with the times, developing both a strategic plan and a membership plan. To find new members, the club analyzes the city's professions to help focus its search, and all new members are quickly assigned tasks and roles.

The club also mixes up meeting times, alternating between evening and afternoon sessions, making them accessible for all members.

Sometimes, circumstances force clubs to make changes. But as people of action, we know that behind every obstacle is an opportunity.

The Rotary Club of Holyoke in Massachusetts was forced from its meeting place because of rising costs after the COVID-19 pandemic, but members took this setback and turned it into a strength. The club started meeting in a library community room that was available for no charge and catering lunch from a nearby deli. Lunch costs \$10 per person but it's optional, so no one has to spend money to attend a meeting. What a great way to work toward being "fair to all concerned."

Since making this change, the Holyoke club has gained 13 members. I suspect part of its membership growth is due to the club's sense of inclusivity — the first step toward belonging.

If you ask members what they expect from the club experience, you might find that your club doesn't meet expectations. Think of this as an opportunity to reshape your club in exciting ways, as alternative club models are making a positive impact.

For example, a Rotary Fellowship called Beers Rotarians Enjoy

Worldwide, or BREW, has worked closely with the Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene Rotary Action Group for the past eight years to assist with clean water projects. In that time, BREW has funneled 25 percent of its dues to those initiatives.

BREW is one of many examples of members pursuing belonging to improve the world.

I can't stress enough the importance of belonging. Clubs become simply irresistible when all members feel that they are exactly where they need to be. To me, belonging is the spark that ignites The Magic of Rotary.

As you receive feedback from club members and the community you serve, I urge you to pursue that spark. The Action Plan can help you find the path to success, and if you light your way with the spirit of belonging, that path will lead to a bright future for your club, your community, and the world.

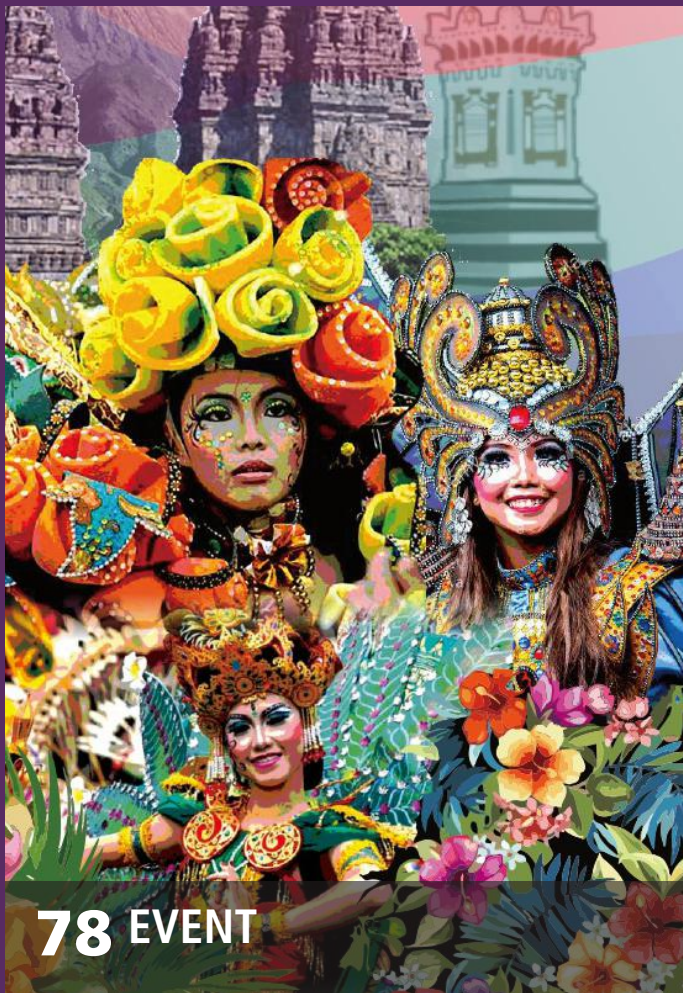
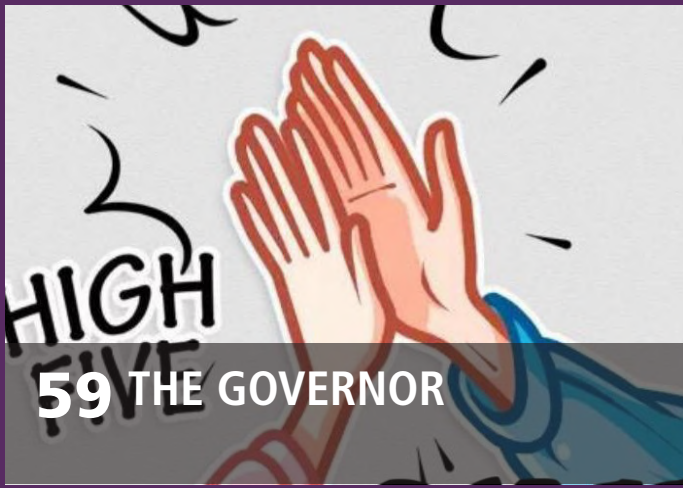

5 steps to club growth: why membership matters

My club, the Rotary Club of St. Andrew, Jamaica, has a storied history. We were chartered in 1966, four years after Jamaica's independence from the United Kingdom, as the third Rotary club in Jamaica. We have a pioneering spirit as demonstrated by being the first Rotary club in Jamaica to allow women to join.

Rotary is a wonderful global movement that allows individuals to come together and take actions that are an expression of our collective will to make this world a better place. Our members are our greatest strength, and membership matters. But our greatest strength is also our greatest challenge. Like a lot of clubs, we struggle with membership. How do we recruit new members, retain existing members, transition members of Rotaract into Rotary, and re-engage current or former members?

I won't be so bold as to suggest we have found the solution to membership growth. But I do believe we have found a solution.

And the funny thing is it was staring us in the face the whole time: The Four Way Test. The best way to grow membership, in my opinion, is by "building goodwill and better friendships."

The club carried out five initiatives in August 2019, spearheaded by our director of club administration and the membership chair, that we hope will re-engage, retain, and recruit past, present, and future members:

- 1. Member call** – Calling members to ask how they are doing and encouraging them to attend. While this is certainly not a new idea, it goes a long way in saying to members you are appreciated and it is proven to get people out to meetings and events.
- 2. A games night** – a fun-filled night of fellowship, relaxation, and networking.
- 3. A membership mixer** – Yet another fun-filled night of fellowship, relaxation, and networking, this one with an eye toward corporate relationships. The club has engaged a major financial institution in Jamaica to sponsor the mixer geared

toward allowing prospective members to interact with existing Rotarians outside of our mid-day meeting time on Tuesdays.

4. The Membership Challenge

– Attracting members is a challenge, why not make the effort into a contest. Each club member is challenged to invite a guest to a club meeting or service project. Members earn additional points if the guest joins, represents a vocation not presently in the club, or is a young professional between the ages of 25-45.

5. Tell your story, Why am I a Rotarian?

– We know stories not stats attract people to Rotary. This initiative creates an avenue for members to tell their Rotary story. By sharing our journeys, members better understand, appreciate, and learn from each other's experiences.

Through these and other efforts we will build goodwill and better friendships proving that membership matters.

Branding apa yang sekarang perlu kita tampilkan kepada generasi muda tentang Rotary? Untuk menarik generasi muda, branding Rotary perlu mencerminkan nilai-nilai, minat, dan kebutuhan mereka.

Berikut adalah elemen-elemen branding yang relevan untuk generasi muda:

1. Impactful Service

2. Professional and Personal Growth

Pengembangan Kepemimpinan: Komunikasikan peluang untuk mengembangkan keterampilan kepemimpinan melalui program pelatihan, mentoring, dan posisi kepemimpinan dalam club.

Jaringan Profesional: Highlight kesempatan untuk berjejaring dengan profesional berpengalaman dari berbagai industri, yang dapat membantu dalam pengembangan karier.

3. Inclusivity and Diversity

Keberagaman Anggota:

Tampilkan komitmen Rotary terhadap inklusivitas dan keberagaman dalam usia, gender, etnis, dan latar belakang profesional.

Komunitas yang Ramah:

Kehadiran Digital: Aktif di platform media sosial dengan konten yang menarik dan relevan. Gunakan video, cerita, dan gambar untuk menceritakan aktivitas dan dampak Rotary.

5. Flexibility and Innovation

Fleksibilitas Keterlibatan: Tawarkan berbagai tingkat keterlibatan yang memungkinkan anggota untuk berkontribusi sesuai dengan waktu dan minat mereka.

Inovasi Program: Soroti inisiatif-inisiatif inovatif yang dijalankan oleh Rotary, termasuk program berbasis teknologi dan solusi kreatif untuk masalah sosial.

6. Fun and Engaging Activities

Kegiatan yang Menarik: Tampilkan berbagai kegiatan yang menyenangkan dan menarik, seperti acara sosial, lokakarya, seminar, dan kegiatan outdoor.

Komunitas yang Aktif: Soroti aspek komunitas dan persahabatan dalam Rotary, menunjukkan bahwa menjadi anggota Rotary juga berarti menjadi bagian dari komunitas

7. Global Network

Highlight komitmen Rotary terhadap keberlanjutan dan inisiatif lingkungan. Generasi muda sering kali tertarik pada organisasi yang peduli dengan masa depan planet ini.

Proyek Hijau: Tampilkan proyek-proyek hijau yang diinisiasi oleh Rotary, seperti program reboisasi, pengelolaan sampah, dan konservasi air.

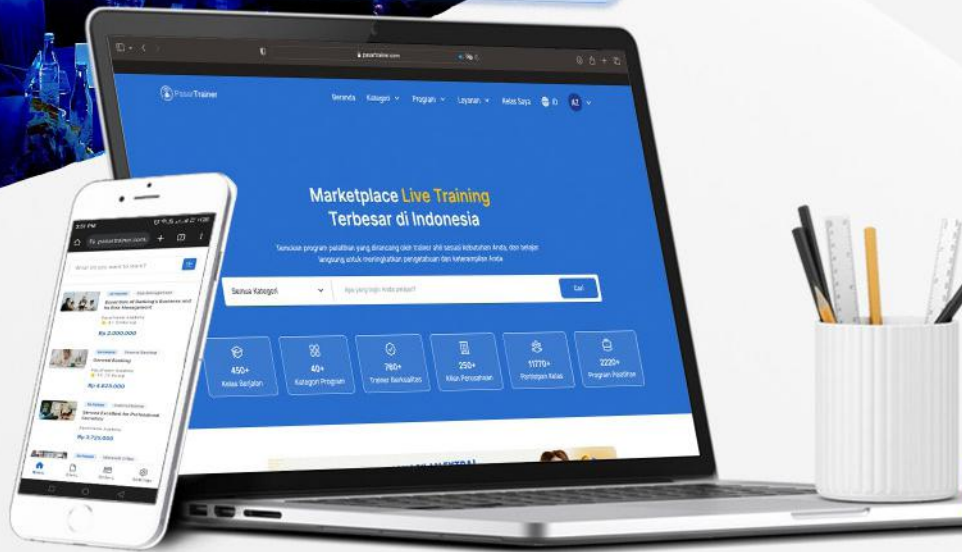

Menjelajahi Potensi Dampak dari Rotary Club Baru: Pendekatan Baru terhadap Pengembangan Keanggotaan

Dalam bidang pelayanan masyarakat dan perubahan yang berdampak, Rotary Club berdiri sebagai mercusuar harapan dan transformasi positif. Melibatkan individu-individu dari berbagai latar belakang, Rotary Club bekerja tanpa kenal lelah untuk membuat dunia menjadi tempat yang lebih baik melalui proyek layanan, peluang jaringan, dan pembangunan komunitas. Hari ini, kita mempelajari dunia perkembangan club baru yang menarik dalam organisasi Rotary dan potensi dampaknya terhadap pertumbuhan keanggotaan dan pengayaan komunitas.

Inti dari Rotary

Rotary lebih dari sekedar sebuah club; ini adalah jaringan global yang terdiri dari individu-individu penuh semangat yang berdedikasi untuk membuat perbedaan. Dengan sejarah yang kaya sejak tahun 1905, Rotary telah berkembang menjadi pusat layanan, memperluas jangkauannya ke lebih dari 35.000 club di seluruh dunia. Nilai-nilai inti Rotary – pelayanan, persahabatan, keberagaman, integritas, dan kepemimpinan – berfungsi sebagai landasan di mana perubahan yang berdampak dapat dibangun.

Merangkul Keberagaman dan Inklusivitas

Salah satu pendorong utama keberhasilan Rotary Club terletak pada komitmen mereka terhadap keberagaman dan inklusivitas. Dengan merangkul individu-individu dari berbagai profesi, usia, dan latar belakang budaya, Rotary memastikan kekayaan perspektif dan ide-ide bersatu dalam harmoni. Perpaduan keberagaman ini tidak hanya memperkaya interaksi klub namun juga mengarah pada proyek komunitas yang lebih inovatif dan inklusif.

Kelahiran Rotary Club Baru

Dimulainya Rotary Club yang baru menandai awal dari sebuah perjalanan menarik menuju keterlibatan dan pelayanan masyarakat. Klub-klub baru mempunyai peluang unik untuk menyesuaikan area fokus mereka agar sesuai dengan kebutuhan komunitas lokal, sehingga memupuk dampak mendalam pada isu-isu yang paling penting. Pendirian klub-klub baru membawa gelombang antusiasme dan inovasi ke permukaan, membuka jalan bagi proyek-proyek transformatif dan kemitraan yang langgeng. Dengan berinvestasi dalam pengembangan keanggotaan dan merangkul kekuatan keberagaman, Rotary Club siap menciptakan masa depan yang penuh dengan perubahan positif dan dampak kolektif.

Rotary Club Meeting

Kesimpulannya, dampak potensial dari Rotary Club yang baru tidak hanya sekedar angka; ini mewujudkan harapan, pelayanan,

dan komitmen teguh untuk membuat perbedaan. Saat kita memulai perjalanan eksplorasi dan pertumbuhan ini, marilah kita merangkul kemungkinan-kemungkinan tak terbatas yang muncul ketika individu-individu yang penuh semangat bersatu di bawah bendera Rotary. Masa depan cerah, dan jalan ke depan dipenuhi dengan janji dan peluang.

Mari kita semua bergandengan tangan dan melangkah ke babak baru warisan Rotary, di mana setiap klub baru merupakan bukti semangat pelayanan dan persekutuan abadi yang mendefinisikan kita semua. Bersama-sama, kita dapat membentuk dunia yang mengutamakan kebaikan, kasih sayang, dan kemurahan hati.

When you get involved in Rotary, whether as a Rotarian, Rotaractor, or program participant, you expand your perspective by honing your skills, learning from professionals, making new connections, and making a difference in your community and around the world.

We know that each member has a unique combination of interests, skills, and talents, and so each member will be attracted to different activities. This guide describes the options you can choose from to personalize your Rotary experience and get involved in ways that matter to you.



MAKE CONNECTIONS

Rotary is a global community with 1.4 million Rotarians and Rotaractors from clubs in nearly every country. This means you can connect with others near home or across the globe. Here are some ways you can make connections through Rotary.



- + ATTEND CLUB MEETINGS AND EVENTS.**
Introduce yourself to members in your club to get to know them better. Being genuinely interested in others shows people you value them, and these small interactions can lead to lasting friendships.
- + CREATE A MY ROTARY ACCOUNT.**
When you register for a [My Rotary account](#) and create a profile, you can access Rotary's online tools and locate and connect with members near and far using the [Find a Member](#) tool.
- + ATTEND DISTRICT MEETINGS AND EVENTS.**
Clubs are grouped into more than 500 districts worldwide. By connecting with other clubs and leaders in your district, you can learn how to get involved in Rotary beyond your club and make a greater impact.
- + GET INVOLVED WITH CLUB INITIATIVES.**
Volunteering to take part in a project, attend a meeting, or serve in a club role, such as being on a [committee](#), will let you work with others in meaningful ways and contribute to your club's impact. You can also suggest speakers from [service and project partners](#) or from other organizations that share Rotary's values. Ask your club how you can help.
- + VISIT ANOTHER CLUB.**
You can locate Rotary and Rotaract club meetings to attend using the [Find a Club](#) tool. You might think of ways to collaborate on club activities or hear of an idea you want to try with your club. Visiting other clubs fosters new connections and inspiration.

- + PARTICIPATE IN A ROTARY FRIENDSHIP EXCHANGE.**
Experience different cultures and build international understanding and friendships. This program for Rotary members and friends prioritizes cultural immersion, international service, or vocational exchanges. [Friendship Exchange](#) participants take turns hosting one another in their homes and clubs.
- + ATTEND A PROJECT FAIR.**

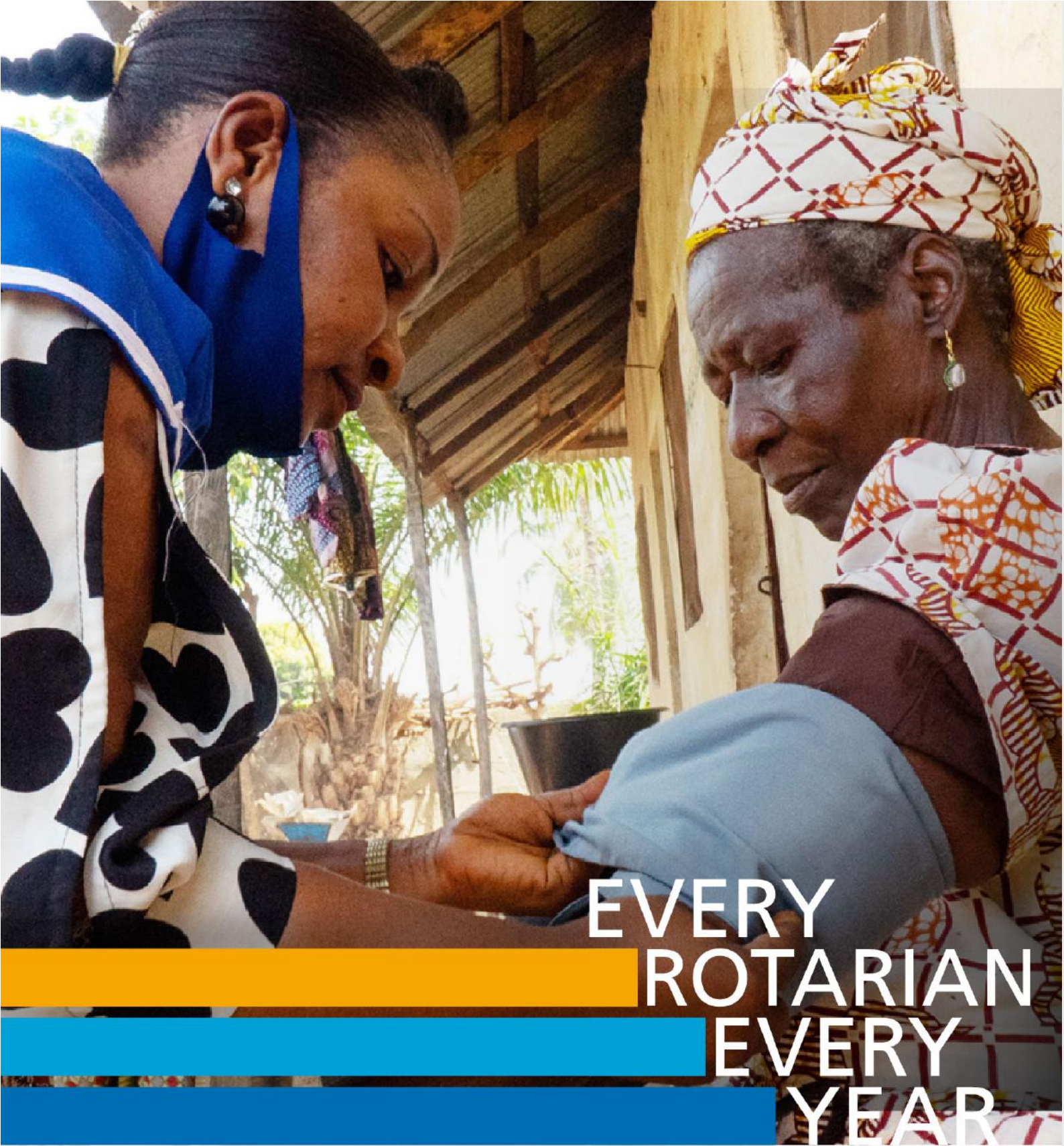

Rotary: a gateway to living long and well

Blue Zones are thriving communities with a high concentration of people between the ages of 90 and 100. The concept of Blue Zones has been popularized recently in Dan Buettner's series of books and a Netflix special based on his research into the secrets of living longer.

When I became aware of Buettner's

research and began studying it, I was struck by how several of the commonalities of these Blue Zones overlapped with Rotary's core values. It got me thinking that perhaps Rotary membership is a gateway to living a long and fulfilling life. Let me share a few of the similarities I see.

Strong Social Network: The foundation of living long

One of the main characteristics of Blue Zones is the emphasis on strong

social connections. These people have a strong feeling of community, with friends and extended family playing an important role in their daily lives. Rotary clubs cultivate a similar environment. Rotary members gather frequently, forming close bonds of fellowship and friendship and a robust support system. This sense of belonging goes beyond mere fellowship and camaraderie; it provides a feeling of purpose and security, lowering stress and nurturing emotional well-being—strongly correlated to long life.

Beyond Friends: Finding meaning by serving others

Having a purpose in life is another fundamental idea of Blue Zones. Many people in these zones have a compelling “why” that motivates them daily. Individuals in these societies frequently play an impactful role in their families, friends, and communities, making a significant difference. Rotary’s commitment to service represents this idea. Rotary members collaborate on many projects and needs, addressing local and global issues like poverty, literacy, health, and environmental sustainability. We get a sense of purpose, satisfaction, and genuine fulfillment when we partake in this impact and engagement, leading to a long and happy life. So many studies confirm volunteering improves perceptions of self-worth, fosters social connection, and lowers stress – all of which are linked to improved health outcomes.

Keep Moving: A key to living longer

The inhabitants of Blue Zones are renowned for leading active lives – walking, gardening, or just going about their daily lives in walkable places. Though they don’t solely focus on physical activity, Rotary clubs frequently plan activities that encourage movement. Through events like park clean-ups, charity walks, and runs, Rotary promotes a lifestyle that incorporates being active.

Less Stress: Another ingredient of long life

Prolonged stress is a significant

cause of health issues. Blue Zones residents have developed various strategies to manage stress. Some communities prioritize daily naps, while others rely on strong social bonds and religious practices for stress relief. Rotary clubs provide a stress-relieving environment because they emphasize service and their supportive environment. Rotary’s sense of purpose and companionship can buffer against everyday stresses.

Living in the Present: The power of mindfulness

The people in the Blue Zones often show a strong sense of mindfulness and awareness. Some of the communities practice regular meditation, while others focus on activities that promote being present in the moment. Rotary meetings and service projects are great opportunities to practice mindfulness. Many of the activities lend themselves to being present, in the moment, and focused.

Being a part of something greater

Many Blue Zones have a solid spiritual, religious, or community connection. While Rotary clubs are non-sectarian, they promote a sense of belonging to a greater cause, fostering social connections, purpose, and meaning in life.

Rotary membership offers an impactful, unique blend of social connection, purpose-driven service, and a naturally active lifestyle. These core values create an atmosphere of longevity and provide a powerful recipe for living a fulfilling life. Rotary

creates a transformative experience, not just for the community but also for members’ health and well-being.

Rotary Club Palembang dikukuhkan sebagai orang tua asuh stunting oleh Kepala BKKBN Pusat, dr Hasto Wardoyo. Penerimaan penghargaan orang tua asuh stunting ini diwakili salah satu anggotanya MF Ririen Kusumawardhani pada saat Puncak peringatan Harganas ke XXXI tingkat provinsi Sumatera Selatan (Sumsel) di Kota Lubuklinggau.

Presiden Rotary Club Palembang Farida Tambunan mengucapkan

terimakasih kepada BKKBN karena telah mengangkat Rotari Club sebagai orang tua asuh. "Kami menyampaikan ucapan terimakasih karena telah diangkat menjadi orang tua asuh stunting di Sumsel," ungkap Farida pada wartawan, Kamis (18/7/2024).

Farida mengungkapkan bila Rotary Club sudah sejak lama konsisten memberikan bantuan pada anak-anak dan ibu hamil kurang mampu mengalami kendala kekurangan gizi.

"Sejak tahun 2020 sudah 50 anak lebih kami berikan bantuan makanan tambahan pada balita dan ibu hamil yang terindikasi kekurangan asupan gizi, targetnya dari awal anak dibawah dua tahun dan ibu hamil," ujarnya.

Selain memberikan bantuan langsung selama ini Rotary juga konsisten melakukan edukasi dan sosialisasi penting menjaga kesehatan ibu hamil dan anak-anak pada masa tumbuh kembang.

“Kami memberikan edukasi ini bekerjasama dengan Puskesmas dengan cara melakukan penyuluhan langsung kepada masyarakat kurang mampu,” bebernya.

Selain kegiatan pemberian makanan tambahan Rotary Club juga aktif dalam kegiatan kemanusiaan lainnya, salah satunya memberikan bantuan pada saat bencana banjir di beberapa wilayah.

“Kegiatan kami (Rotary) bukan hanya di Palembang tapi ada beberapa juga di Sumsel, seperti di wilayah Batu Raja kami berikan bantuan pipa dan perlengkapan lainnya,” ujarnya.

Rotary Club Yogyakarta Tamansari dan Gerakan Pita Merah Putar Film Stigma, Edukasi tentang HIV/AIDS

Rotary Club Yogyakarta Tamansari dan Gerakan Pita Merah menggelar pemutaran film Stigma di Auditorium Lantai 4, Gedung St. Theresa. Universitas Atma Jaya Yogyakarta, Jumat (14/6/2024).

Albertus Hardiawan, Presiden Rotary Club of Yogyakarta Tamansari mengatakan, pemutaran film Stigma itu dilakukan dalam dua sesi, yakni pukul 13:30-17:00 WIB dan 17:30-21:00 WIB.

“Kita kerja sama dengan Gerakan Pita Merah Bandung, UAJY, Sahabat ODHA dan Victory Plus Yogyakarta, menggelar pemutaran film Stigma ini di kampus sebagai upaya untuk edukasi tentang HIV/AIDS. Pemutaran film ini juga disertai dengan diskusi bersama ODHA,” kata Wawan kepada Tribun Jogja di sela-sela pemutaran film.

Film Stigma bercerita tentang seorang anak yatim bernama Wawan.

Saat itu, Wawan dinyatakan tertular virus HIV sehingga mendapat perlakuan diskriminatif dari sejumlah orang di sekitarnya.

Namun dibalik itu, rupanya masih ada orang-orang yang peduli dan tidak mempermasalahkan hal tersebut sehingga memotivasi Wawan untuk terus menjalani hidup seperti orang-orang pada umumnya.

“Dari dua sesi itu, total ada 300 orang yang menonton, masing-masing sesi ada 150 orang,” ujar Wawan lagi.

Dia menjelaskan, alasan pemutaran film Stigma ini juga untuk mencegah penyebaran virus HIV kepada remaja di Yogyakarta.

“Menurut berita, HIV ini kan banyak menjangkiti orang muda. Sedangkan, di Yogyakarta, daerah ini kan disebut kota pelajar. Maka, kita berharap, dengan edukasi dari film ini, kita bisa meredam kasus HIV ini. Tampaknya sedikit, tapi seperti gunung es, yang tak



terlihat banyak,” papar dia.

Ke depan, Rotary Club Yogyakarta Tamansari dan Gerakan Pita Merah juga akan memutar film Stigma ke kampus-kampus di Yogyakarta agar mengedukasi lebih banyak pemuda.

Sementara, Laelawati dari perwakilan Gerakan Pita Merah Bandung menambahkan pihaknya memiliki tanggung jawab bagaimana caranya mengedukasi masyarakat terkait HIV/AIDS dan ODHA secara lebih luas dan efektif.

“Harapannya, orang-orang bisa meminimalisasi stigma terhadap

teman-teman ODHA dan pastinya pencegahan penularan atau penyebaran virus HIV juga,” terang dia.

Perempuan yang akrab disapa Lea itu mengatakan, edukasi tentang HIV/AIDS perlu digencarkan bahkan sejak SMP agar tidak terlambat ketika mereka sudah memasuki masa remaja.

Dengan edukasi dini, mereka bisa menjauhi cara penularan HIV, termasuk seks bebas dan penggunaan narkoba.

Rotary Club Batam ikut berperan dalam pencegahan stunting Batuampar, Batam, di Provinsi Kepulauan Riau.

Rotary Batam menjadi kakak asuh terbanyak program Semesta Mencegah Stunting yang digagas BKKN dan Tribun Batam.

Club Secretary Rotary Batam Haryanto Wijaya sebut senang membantu dan mendukung penuh program stunting di Provinsi Kepulauan Riau.

Kegiatan semacam ini menurutnya, sangat menarik, dan ke depan Rotary siap untuk memberikan sumbangsuhnya.

“Membantu orang lain yang sedang membutuhkan itu merupakan pekerjaan yang mulia,” kata Haryanto, Rabu (31/5/2023).

Haryanto mengaku membantu anak untuk terhindar dari stunting termasuk memajukan negara beberapa tahun kemudian.

“Stunting merusak Sumber Daya Manusia (SDM) dan gizi. Saya tidak ingin anak Indonesia mengalami

stunting lagi,” ungkapnya.

Begitu dikukuhkan menjadi kakak asuh dalam program semesta mencegah stunting Tribun Network (Tribun Batam) dan BKKBN Provinsi Kepri.

“Dengan semangat tersebut, hari ini kami merupakan kakak asuh yang paling banyak membantu stunting di Batuampar Batam,” jelasnya.

Kerja sosial semacam ini membuat dirinya senang dan hal itu sejalan dengan tujuan Rotary.

“Kami dari Rotary selalu bermitra

dengan pemerintah Kota Batam maupun Kepulauan Riau untuk membuat kegiatan sosial, termasuk stunting ini," jelas Haryanto.

Dikatakannya, begitu mendengar stunting ini, pihaknya sangat tertarik dengan tujuan stunting di Kepri bisa jadi zero.

Workshop screening katarak bagi dokter dan nakes di fasilitas kesehatan tingkat pertama



Gangguan indera (terutama gangguan penglihatan) masih menjadi masalah kesehatan yang dihadapi oleh masyarakat baik global maupun nasional. Gangguan indera dapat terjadi pada seluruh kelompok umur, karena luasnya penyebab dan faktor risiko terjadinya gangguan. Stigma bahwa gangguan indera bukan merupakan masalah kesehatan, menyebabkan gangguan indera diabaikan dan baru dianggap sebagai masalah serius bila menimbulkan kecacatan seperti kebutaan dan ketulian. Keinginan pemerintah untuk, "Meningkatkan Kualitas Hidup Manusia Indonesia" dan "Meningkatkan Produktivitas Rakyat dan Daya Saing di Pasar Internasional", maka Pemerintah berupaya menangani permasalahan gangguan mata dan kebutaan, sebab kesakitan dan kecacatan

yang disandang masyarakat akibat gangguan penglihatan berdampak pada penurunan produktivitas dan kualitas hidup manusia.

Survei Kebutaan Cepat Berbasis Populasi atau Rapid Assessment of Avoidable Blindness (RAAB) tahun 2014-2016 yang dilakukan di 15 Provinsi di Indonesia, cukup memberikan gambaran bahwa Indonesia memiliki masalah kebutaan yang cukup serius. Angka Kebutaan Indonesia mencapai 3 % merupakan negara dengan angka kebutaan tertinggi di Asia Tenggara. Hasil RAAB di Provinsi NTB sendiri menunjukkan angka kebutaan sekitar 4%, nomor dua setelah Jawa Timur yang mencapai angka kebutaan sekitar 4,4 %. Dalam rangka mengatasi permasalahan gangguan penglihatan dan kebutaan di Indonesia, Pemerintah mengutamakan upaya promotif-

preventif melalui pendekatan: (1) pengendalian faktor risiko, (2) kegiatan skrining atau deteksi dini gangguan penglihatan dan kebutaan pada kelompok berisiko, serta (3) penguatan akses masyarakat pada layanan kesehatan yang komprehensif dan bermutu. Hal ini juga tidak lepas dari upaya kuratif rehabilitatif yang menunjang keberhasilan program.

Untuk menanggulangi masalah gangguan penglihatan dan kebutaan tersebut tentu diperlukan program pencegahan yang baik dan mampu memberikan tata laksana serta dapat membantu agar capaian Pencegahan dan pengendalian tepat waktu dan tepat sasaran. Pengembangan sumber daya manusia dan fasilitas pelayanan kesehatan, pemberian pelayanan yang bermutu, sistem rujukan, pembiayaan dan sistem



informasi kesehatan yang baik akan sangat mendukung upaya Pencegahan dan pengendalian gangguan penglihatan dan kebutaan khususnya di tingkat FKTP.

Sejalan dengan “Peta Jalan Pencegahan dan pengendalian Gangguan Penglihatan di Indonesia Tahun 2017 – 2030” dan Permenkes no 82 tahun 2020, maka kepedulian dan pengetahuan masyarakat perlu ditingkatkan agar program Pencegahan dan pengendalian gangguan penglihatan dan kebutaan salah satunya melalui screening katarak, dapat terlaksana dan dapat diimplementasikan dengan baik, diperlukan Sumber Daya Manusia (SDM) yang terlatih untuk screening katarak. keberhasilan program. Untuk menanggulangi masalah gangguan penglihatan dan kebutaan

tersebut tentu diperlukan program pencegahan yang baik dan mampu memberikan tata laksana serta dapat membantu agar capaian Pencegahan dan pengendalian tepat waktu dan tepat sasaran. Pengembangan sumber daya manusia dan fasilitas pelayanan kesehatan, pemberian pelayanan yang bermutu, sistem rujukan, pembiayaan dan sistem informasi kesehatan yang baik akan sangat mendukung upaya Pencegahan dan pengendalian gangguan penglihatan dan kebutaan khususnya di tingkat FKTP. Sejalan dengan “Peta Jalan Pencegahan dan pengendalian Gangguan Penglihatan di Indonesia Tahun 2017 – 2030” dan Permenkes no 82 tahun 2020, maka kepedulian dan pengetahuan masyarakat perlu ditingkatkan agar program Pencegahan dan pengendalian gangguan penglihatan dan

kebutaan salah satunya melalui screening katarak, dapat terlaksana dan dapat diimplementasikan dengan baik, diperlukan Sumber Daya Manusia (SDM) yang terlatih untuk screening katarak.

Pengobatan gratis, edukasi seksual dan penyuluhan stunting

Rotary Club of Yogyakarta Malioboro mengambil inisiatif yang patut dipuji dengan menyelenggarakan program pengabdian masyarakat yang berfokus pada penyuluhan stunting dan Pendidikan seksual bagi siswa sekolah menengah pertama dan atas.

Stunting, yang diakibatkan oleh kekurangan gizi kronis, dapat berdampak jangka panjang pada perkembangan fisik dan kognitif anak. Dengan meningkatkan kesadaran dan mendidik siswa tentang nutrisi yang tepat dan praktik kesehatan, Rotary

Club of Yogyakarta Malioboro berharap dapat mengurangi dampak ini dan mempromosikan gaya hidup yang lebih sehat.

Selain itu, komponen pendidikan seksual sangat penting dalam memberdayakan siswa dengan pengetahuan tentang hak-hak mereka, bagaimana mengenali perilaku yang tidak pantas, dan pentingnya persetujuan. Pendekatan komprehensif ini tidak hanya berupaya melindungi dan mendidik generasi muda namun juga menumbuhkan komunitas yang lebih aman dan lebih terinformasi.

Kegiatan dilengkapi dengan pemeriksaan Kesehatan secara gratis untuk para lansia yang ada di lingkungan Dusun Jepitu, Gunung Kidul.

Melalui upaya ini, Rotary Club of Yogyakarta Malioboro memberikan kontribusi yang signifikan terhadap perkembangan dan kesejahteraan generasi muda Jogja.

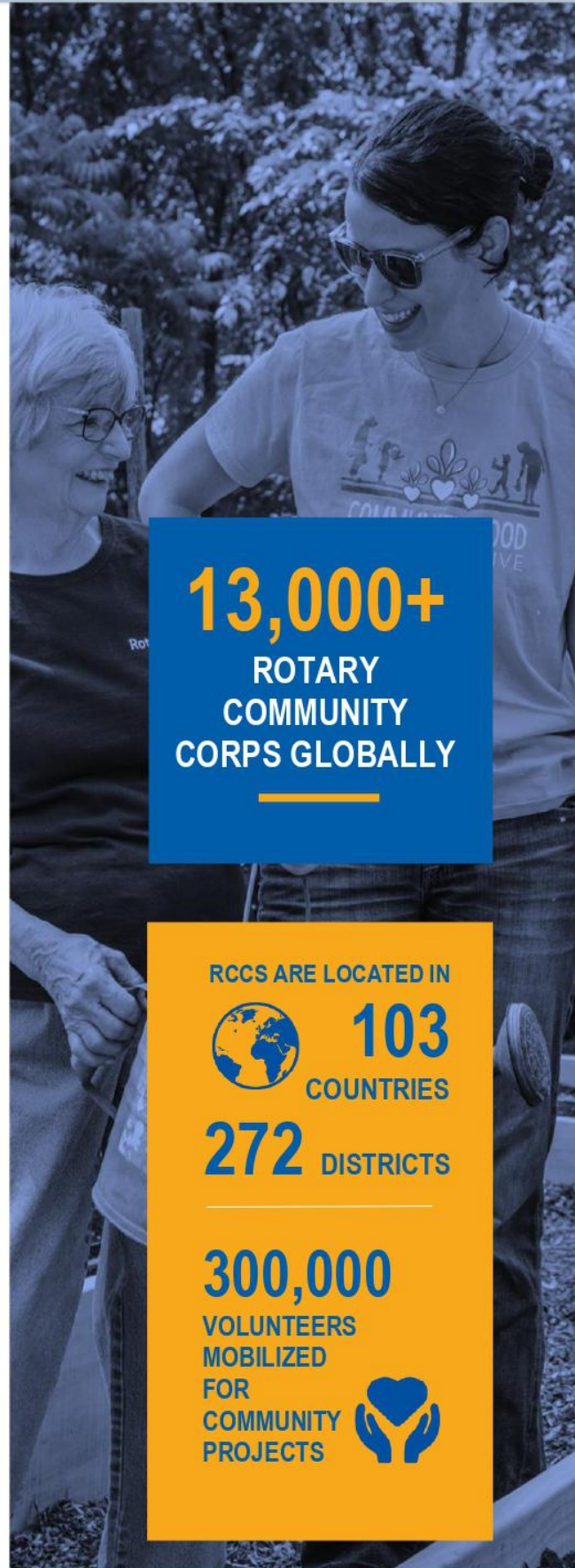

HOW TO START AN RCC

- **Assess** the need for, and feasibility of, establishing an RCC
- **Guide** the process of forming an RCC once the club has agreed to sponsor one
- **Recruit** at least 10 RCC members from the community.
- **Register** the RCC with Rotary International by completing the [organization form](#) and sending it to rotarysupportcenter@rotary.org.

You can find application materials and other resources at rotary.org/rcc.

HOW TO SUSTAIN A SUCCESSFUL RCC

Appoint an RCC committee or an RCC adviser to be the liaison between the club and the RCC.

Provide ongoing guidance and support to the RCC in developing its service projects.

Maintain consistent communication between the RCC and the club.

Introduce Rotary's policies and values to RCC members and advise them on administrative matters if needed.

Invite RCC leaders to the club meetings to let them give firsthand updates on their activities.

Publicize RCC success stories and share them with RI.

EXAMPLES OF RCCs IN ACTION

- ❖ The Rotary Community Corps of Bishnupur in West Bengal, India, worked with its sponsor Rotary club to build a new road to replace a path into their village that was inaccessible during monsoon season.
- ❖ The Rotary Club of Bursa-Uludag, Turkey, built a strong relationship with community members by sponsoring the Rotary Community Corps of Aksu Village. It mentored the members of the all-female RCC, which not only helped them grow their small businesses and raise their incomes but also increased their confidence and their involvement in the community.
- ❖ The Rotary Community Corps of Plano Douglass Community in Texas, USA, was founded to combat social injustice and promote equality, equity, and inclusion within the community. Its projects include a school supply drive and meal delivery from a food pantry to local families in need.

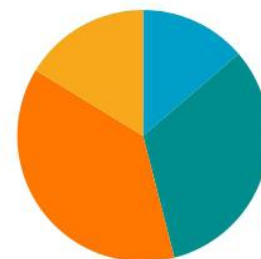

Attract, Retain, Form (ARF)



ARF adalah singkatan yang digunakan oleh Rotary International President Stephanie Urchick untuk menggambarkan tiga strategi utama dalam menumbuhkan Rotary:

- A: Attract (Menarik)
- R: Retain (Mempertahankan)
- F: Form new clubs (Membentuk club baru)

Singkatan ini dirancang untuk mudah diingat dan menekankan langkah-langkah penting dalam memperluas keanggotaan dan pengaruh Rotary.

Setiap elemen dari ARF memiliki pentingnya masing-masing dalam konteks yang berbeda:

- **A: Attract (Menarik)*:** Menarik anggota baru sangat penting untuk membawa energi baru, ide-ide segar, dan memastikan keberlanjutan klub. Tanpa menarik anggota baru,

- klub bisa mengalami stagnasi.
- **R : R e t a i n (Mempertahankan)*:** Mempertahankan anggota yang sudah ada sama pentingnya, jika tidak lebih penting. Tingkat retensi yang tinggi menunjukkan bahwa anggota merasa dihargai dan terlibat, yang sangat penting untuk kesehatan jangka panjang klub.
- **F: Form new clubs (Membentuk klub baru)*:** Membentuk klub baru memperluas jangkauan Rotary ke komunitas yang mungkin tidak terlayani oleh klub yang sudah ada. Ini membantu dalam penyebaran misi Rotary ke area yang lebih luas dan beragam.

Menentukan mana yang lebih penting antara F, A, dan R bisa tergantung pada konteks spesifik suatu daerah atau klub. Di beberapa daerah, mungkin lebih mendesak untuk menarik anggota baru (A)

atau mempertahankan anggota yang ada (R), sementara di daerah lain, ada kebutuhan yang lebih besar untuk membentuk klub baru (F) untuk menjangkau lebih banyak komunitas. Sebuah pendekatan seimbang yang mencakup semua tiga strategi biasanya paling efektif untuk pertumbuhan dan keberlanjutan jangka panjang.

Club Excellence Award

The Club Excellence awards, formerly the Rotary Citation awards recognize the hard work clubs do throughout the year. Working to achieve the Club Excellence goals helps clubs engage their members, increase their impact, stay relevant in their communities, and run more efficiently. A welcoming and engaging club not only fosters a positive experience for its members, but also reflects the values of Rotary. When clubs achieve these goals, they contribute to the overall health and culture of Rotary for generations to come.

Your Rotary, Rotaract, or Interact club can earn a Club Excellence Award for achieving goals that strengthen Rotary and your club.

Goals include increasing club membership, engaging members in sustainable service projects, giving to The Rotary Foundation, building awareness of Rotary in your community, and having an up-to-date strategic plan.

Rotary Club Excellence Award

Club excellence goals can be found in Rotary Club Central. To achieve the Club Excellence Award, review all the available goals, select at least half of them, achieve those goals, and report your achievement in Rotary Club Central.

All achievements need to be reported in Rotary Club Central by 30 June.

Rotaract Club Excellence Award

Rotaract clubs can find their goals in Rotary Club Central beginning 1 July 2024. Clubs that set, achieve, and report goal achievement of at least half of the goals by the end of the Rotary year will earn a Club Excellence award.

Only Rotaract clubs that have an active charter with Rotary International are eligible for the citation. To confirm that a club is active, Rotarians can check the Listing of Club-Sponsored Organizations in Rotary Club Central.

All achievements need to be reported by 30 June.

Interact Club Excellence Award

Interact clubs that achieve the Interact goals by the end of the Rotary year will earn a Club Excellence award.

Only Interact clubs that have an active charter with Rotary International are eligible for the award. To confirm that a club is active, Rotarians can check the Listing of Club-Sponsored Organizations in Rotary Club Central.

All achievements need to be reported by 15 August.

The sponsor Rotary club's president completes the online nomination form by 15 August. For Interact clubs with more than one sponsor club, only one nomination should be submitted for any given Interact club.

ROTARY CITATION / CLUB EXCELLENCE AWARD FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

ROTARY AND ROTARACT CLUB EXCELLENCE AWARD

What is the difference between the Rotary Citation and the Club Excellence Award?

There is no difference as they are the same award. The Club Excellence Award is the new name for the Rotary Citation effective 1 July 2024. The award recognizes Rotary, Rotaract, and Interact clubs that successfully achieve goals that are aligned with Rotary's action plan. Established in 1992, the award has undergone some changes over the years to remain relevant and to continue to align with Rotary's strategic objectives. The RI Board approved the name change to better convey its intent

as recognition of club excellence. This resource will refer to the award as the Club Excellence Award, although this name change does not become official until 1 July.

Why should clubs strive to earn the Club Excellence Award?

The Club Excellence Award is not just an honor for your club to receive, it is an important tool to help monitor the health and growth of your club. Taking action toward achieving the club excellence goals helps clubs engage their members, stay relevant in their communities, and run more efficiently. A welcoming and engaging club also reflects the values of Rotary. When clubs achieve their goals, they contribute to the overall health and culture of Rotary for generations to come.

How do I achieve the Club Excellence Award for Rotary ?

1. Go to Rotary Club Central.
2. Review the available goals.
3. Select and set at least half of the goals available.
4. Achieve your goals.
5. Report your achievement in Rotary Club Central by 30 June. (Note: some achievements are recorded automatically, such as membership growth and TRF contributions.)
6. Pay each club invoice upon receipt (no later than within 60 days).

How do Rotaract clubs achieve the Rotaract Club Excellence Award?

Through the 2023-24 Rotary year, Rotaract clubs can complete the Rotaract Citation Nomination form to nominate their club for the Rotary Citation. Beginning in the 2024-25 Rotary year, the Rotaract club officers can log in to Rotary Club Central to review and select their goals. Just like Rotary clubs, Rotaract clubs need to achieve at least half of their goals to earn the Rotaract Club Excellence Award. They can return to edit these

throughout the year and to report achievement. In addition, Rotaract clubs must pay their annual club invoices in full within 60 days to be eligible. Rotaract clubs that do not set goals and report achievement in Rotary Club Central or who do not pay their dues within 60 days beginning in the 2024-25 Rotary year will not be eligible for the Rotaract Club Excellence Award.

ACCESS

How do I access Rotary Club Central?

You can find Rotary Club Central directly on the homepage of My Rotary or by opening the "My Rotary" menu in the navigation. To learn how to use Rotary Club Central, you can take the online course in the Learning Center called Rotary Club Central Resources. Learn more about reporting goal achievements.

Who can see goals in Rotary Club Central?

All Rotarians and Rotaractors can see the goals in Rotary Club Central set by their club officers for any given year. If a member doesn't see a goal for the incoming year, it might be because one of these officers hasn't set it yet, or because the member hasn't been reported as a member of the club.

Who can set and manage goals in Rotary Club Central?

Any reported incoming or current officer at the club or district level, including assistant governors, can set goals for the upcoming year. Reported club officer positions include presidents, vice presidents, secretaries, treasurers, and club administration, membership, public image, service project, and Rotary Foundation committee chairs, learning facilitators, and the district executive secretary/director. If a club leader does not have the ability to

to set goals in Rotary Club Central, it might be that their leadership role hasn't been reported in My Rotary.

Can members who aren't club leaders enter a club's accomplishments?

By default, only club officers can set goals and mark achievement in Rotary Club Central. However, a club officer can delegate online access temporarily to a member to allow them to enter a club's accomplishment in Rotary Club Central. Note: Rotaractors are not yet able to delegate online access but will be able to in the future.

ELIGIBILITY

Do clubs have to be in good standing to earn the Club Excellence Award?

Yes. To be eligible for the Club Excellence Award, Rotary and Rotaract clubs need to begin the year as active clubs in good standing and remain so throughout the year. For the purposes of the Club Excellence Award, good standing means a club has paid each club invoice balance in full within 60 days after the club invoice is issued. If a club's payment isn't received by that date, it will receive a 60-day reminder letter from Rotary International's Accounts Receivable team, in which case the club will no longer be eligible. For Rotary clubs, dues are invoiced semiannually in July and January, while Rotaract clubs receive one invoice per year in January.

New clubs that are chartered during the current Rotary year, that are in good financial standing and have achieved at least half of the available goals before the end of the Rotary year, are also eligible.

How can I verify that a club is in good standing?

To see whether your club is in good

standing, you will need to check whether the club balance has been paid in full within the 60-day time frame.

To check your daily club balance, go to My Rotary>Click on Club Name>Finance>Club Invoice. You should have an outstanding balance of \$0.00. Invoices are due when they are posted, in mid-January for Rotary and Rotaract clubs, and in mid-July for Rotary clubs only.

To check whether your club dues were received on time, check the Club Excellence Recipients Report. This report can be found on My Rotary. Sign into My Rotary and click on the Membership and Foundation Reports. In the Awards section, you'll see the Club Excellence Award. Clubs are in good standing as long as they haven't received a 60-day reminder to pay their dues. If you have questions about the club invoice or where to send your payment, including whether your club has a zero balance or received a 60-day reminder letter, contact your financial representative.

Is our club still eligible for the Club Excellence Award if we achieve different goals than the ones we set at the beginning of the year?

Yes. If club leaders find that a goal that is set at the beginning of the year is going to be unattainable, but another will be achievable, they can edit the goals selected at any time during the year. As long as more than half of the goals are reported as achieved by the end of the Rotary year, the club is eligible for the award.

Are clubs chartered during the current Rotary year eligible for this year's Club Excellence Award?

Yes. If a newly chartered club is in good financial standing and

has achieved at least half of the available goals before the end of the Rotary year, it is eligible. If it was chartered after January, it will be considered "in good standing." If it is chartered before January, it is considered to be "in good standing" if it has satisfied the January invoice payment on time. To confirm eligibility, presidents of newly chartered clubs should write to riawards@rotary.org.

Are satellite clubs eligible for the Club Excellence Award?

No. Satellite club goals and achievements should be combined with their sponsor club's goals.

REPORTING GOAL ACHIEVEMENT

Where should I report my club's goal achievements?

Achievement of most goals are self-reported and can be reported in Rotary Club Central by marking them "Achieved." The achievements for data-driven goals like membership numbers and Rotary Foundation giving are updated from our database, so you don't need to report achievement of those.

Why is my previous year's membership growth not showing? I didn't remove members until 1 July.

Members who are added on 1 July count toward the next year's membership growth. Members who are removed on 1 July count toward the previous year's loss since they aren't members at the start of the Rotary year. For example, members who are added on 1 July 2024 count toward the next year (2024-25)'s membership growth. Members who are removed on 1 July 2024 count toward the previous year (2023-24).

The membership trends graph in

in Rotary Club Central is updated based on 1 July membership figures so it won't update throughout the year. To find your club's current membership figures, sign into My Rotary and click on Membership and Foundation Reports.

How can I report achievement of our service project?

This is a system generated goal achievement, so members cannot report the achievement in Rotary Club Central. Instead, you must add completed projects in Rotary Showcase. Once that is done, in roughly 24 hours, the achievement will update in Rotary Club Central.

How can I report an ongoing or completed service project?

If you have a multi-year project and are concerned about it impacting your achievement of the goal in Rotary Club Central, you can break your project into parts that will be achieved each year and mark each part complete when the Rotary year ends.

How can I see my club's progress?

Rotary and Rotaract members who have My Rotary accounts can see their club's accomplishments in the Club Excellence Recipients Report. You can find the report in Rotary Club Central in the reports tab. The report is also available in My Rotary. Go to My Rotary, then Membership and Foundation Reports. In the Awards section, you'll see Club Excellence. The report becomes available in October and remains active until 1 July.

I just achieved a goal for my club. Why isn't the achievement showing?

For most of the goals in Rotary Club Central, achievement is self-reported. You can enter the achievement at any time. It may take 24 hours to show as achieved on the report.

Achievement of a few goals are data-generated, such as membership numbers or Rotary Foundation giving, and the achievement may not appear in Rotary Club Central for 24 hours. Please check the Club Excellence Recipients report (see previous question) a day or two after reporting membership changes or submitting contributions.

Why isn't my Rotary club showing as having earned the Club Excellence Award on the Club Excellence Recipients report?

Sometimes clubs achieve their goals but forget to report their achievement in Rotary Club Central. Club excellence is awarded to clubs that achieve their goals and report their achievement. Clubs also must pay all club invoices within 60 days to be eligible. In addition, if your club received an exception for one of the requirements, it will not be reflected on the report.

CLUB EXCELLENCE GOALS

How do I find the Club Excellence Award goals in Rotary Club Central?

1. Go to Club Goals on the left side of the page if you are not there already.
2. Select the Rotary year (in the middle of the screen).
3. Select the All tab.

If goals have already been selected, all reported club officers can click on the edit button to change your club's selection.

Why are clubs asked to choose at least half of the goals to achieve the Club Excellence Award?

Allowing clubs to choose their goals provides flexibility and recognizes that some goals are more important or achievable than others, and this varies from club to club. Clubs must

achieve at least half of the goals available to be eligible.

Where can I find a list of the Club Excellence Award goals that I can print?

You can find the goals for Rotary, Rotaract, and Interact clubs on this web page.

Why are there new goals for Rotaract clubs?

After Rotaract was elevated to a club type, the Rotaract goals were updated to better align with Rotary's Action Plan. The new goals are designed to help Rotaract clubs to focus on increasing their impact, expanding their reach, enhancing participant engagement, and increase their ability to adapt.

How are new and existing members defined?

For the purposes of club excellence, new members are defined as those who were added on or after 1 July of the Rotary year in question. Existing members are those who were members prior to 1 July of the Rotary year in question.

Are there additional resources available to guide my club on updating our bylaws?

If it has been a few years since your club last updated your bylaws or you are unable to locate them, use the Recommended Rotary Club Bylaws as a starting point. Your club can tailor these bylaws, as long as your changes align with Rotary's constitutional documents and Rotary Code of Policies. Take the Creating an Inclusive Club Culture course in the Learning Center to see examples of how your club can ensure your bylaws reflect the needs of your members.

What does it mean to sponsor a new club member?

Sponsoring a club member means inviting someone to attend a

meeting, service project, or other event, and helping them become a member of your club. A club sponsor can be reported to Rotary when adding that member to your club in My Rotary.

What are Rotary Action Groups and Rotary Fellowships?

Rotary Action Groups are independent, international, Rotary-affiliated groups whose members have expertise and experience in a particular area of specialization. Aligned with Rotary's priority to increase humanitarian impact, they use their knowledge and passion to help clubs and districts plan and carry out impactful humanitarian service projects.

- Membership is open to any individual. Rotarians, Rotaractors, and Peace Fellows can serve in leadership roles.
- By joining a Rotary Action Group, you can use your professional skills to advise on meaningful service activities outside your own club, district, or country.
- Rotary Action Groups provide networking opportunities with like-minded individuals from around the world.

Rotary Fellowships are international groups that share a common passion, vocation, or interest. Being part of a fellowship is a fun way to make meaningful connections and friends around the world, explore a hobby or profession, and enhance your Rotary experience.

How can I find out which members of my club are also members of a Rotary Action Group or a Rotary Fellowship?

RI currently does not track the membership information of Rotary Action Groups and Rotary Fellowships. Each action group and fellowship maintain their own membership data. You can find

out about your club members' engagement with action groups/fellowships by surveying your club members.

What are examples of a leadership development program?

A leadership development program can be anything designed to give members opportunities for developing their leadership skills. Clubs can offer leadership development opportunities to their members, such as asking them to be on a committee or lead a club initiative. They can also support members interested in professional development by having a mentor program or giving them opportunities to develop new skills through new experiences, such as taking the professional development courses in Rotary's Learning Center, and creating a supportive environment for them as they practice their skills in the club.

What learning events count for the learning event participation goal?

Any club leader who has attended a learning event to help them prepare for their role, virtually or in person, can be counted toward this goal.

What social activities count for the goal in Rotary Club Central?

Any social activity held outside of the regular club meeting that is open to all club members can count for this goal, including virtual events.

Can anyone host or sponsor youth exchange students?

No. Because there are RI policies and Rotary Youth Exchange certification standards that must be adhered to, participating clubs must operate under district supervision of the district Rotary Youth Exchange program.

What counts for RYLA participation?

This goal can include sponsoring or funding RYLA participants; planning, organizing or running the event; or participating in, facilitating, or speaking at the event.

RECIPIENTS

When is the Club Excellence Award processed?

Rotary and Rotaract clubs should report achievement of goals by 30 June, the last day of the Rotary year. On 1 July, the Club Excellence Recipients Report is downloaded to determine recipients as of 1 July. Certificates will be generated and sent in the first quarter of the new Rotary year. Requests for exceptions are considered on a case-by-case basis through the end of August and should come from the club's president for the previous Rotary year.

What does my club get for earning the Club Excellence Award?

If a club successfully completes all the goals necessary, they will receive a digital Club Excellence Award certificate signed by the RI President. Links to the certificates are distributed early in the following Rotary year to immediate past Rotary and Rotaract club presidents and immediate past district governors of those clubs who achieved the award.

How will certificates be distributed to clubs?

The RI Awards Team will email immediate past district governors of clubs who have earned the award. The email will include a link to a folder where certificates can be found. This allows district leaders to award their clubs with the certificate if they choose. A few weeks afterward, the link to the

certificates will be emailed directly to immediate past club presidents. The certificates will be organized and sorted by district number and club name.

My club earned the Club Excellence Award, but we didn't get the certificate. Where can we find them?

If you believe you earned this award last Rotary year and did not receive your certificate, email Rlawards@rotary.org. A link to the certificates for the 2023-2024 Rotary year will be shared with the appropriate Rotary and Rotaract club and district leaders in the first quarter of the 2024-2025 Rotary year.

My club showed as having achieved the Club Excellence Award when I checked the report earlier in the Rotary year. Why didn't we receive the certificate?

The Club Excellence Recipients Report is dynamic and updates as membership or Foundation giving figures change. If it shows a club as having earned the award in May for example, but not in June, it may be that members were terminated at the end of the year which impacted their eligibility if that goal was selected. The report is pulled on 1 July to determine recipients as of that date. Goals achieved according to the report as of that date determine eligibility. Members terminated on 1 July will count as membership losses for the previous Rotary year. Members added on 1 July will count as membership gain for the current Rotary year. If goal achievements are updated after 30 June, they will not impact eligibility for the previous Rotary year.

INTERACT CLUB EXCELLENCE AWARD

How does the Club Excellence Award work for Interact clubs?

Interact clubs can be nominated online for the Club Excellence Award for Interact Clubs. Interact clubs can't be nominated by email, mail, or phone. The links to the nomination forms can be found on the Club Excellence web page.

When does the nomination form for Interact Clubs open?

The nomination forms for Interact clubs opens in late August or September of the current Rotary year and are open until 15 August of the following Rotary year.

How do Interact clubs achieve the Club Excellence Award for Interact Clubs?

Interact clubs need to achieve more than half of their goals to earn the Interact Club Excellence Award. The club sponsor president or Interact club adviser has to submit the online nomination form indicating which goals have been met. You can find a list of goals and a link to the nomination form on the Club Excellence web page. If at least half of the goals were met, the nominator receives a link to the certificate that can be downloaded, printed, and presented to the Interact club. Only Interact clubs that have an active charter with Rotary International are eligible.

Who can nominate an Interact club for the Club Excellence Award for Interact clubs?

Only sponsor club presidents and Interact club advisers may submit the nomination form for Interact clubs. If the Interact club is sponsored by more than one club, sponsor clubs should coordinate to submit the nomination.

Is there a list of Interact clubs who have achieved the Club Excellence Award?

Rotary International does not

maintain or distribute a list.

What do I do if the Interact Club Excellence Award certificate doesn't arrive?

Upon submitting the nomination form for an Interact club, the nominator will receive an email that links to the certificate if the club qualifies. The nominator can then download the certificate and distribute it to the club. If the nominator doesn't have that email with the certificate link, it may be in their junk mail. If it's not there, they can email Rlawards@rotary.org for help.

Setelah itu akan dilaksanakan PIN Polio tahap II (di luar Papua) 27 provinsi akan dilaksanakan:

Putaran 1: 23 -29 Juli 2024, putaran 1 sweeping: 30 Juli-3 Agustus 2024.
Putaran 2: 6-12 Agustus 2024, putaran 2 sweeping : 13-17 Agustus 2024.

Mengingat bahwa:

1. Tidak ada rencana pencanangan PIN Polio Nasional, namun pelaksanaannya di masing-masing daerah kota/kabupaten

3. Mengingat Keterbatasan Sumber Daya Manusia (SDM) dan material Komunikasi, Informasi dan Edukasi (KIE) yang dimiliki oleh Rotary International District 3410 (RID3410)
4. Target utama kita di RID3410 membantu pelaksanaan PIN Polio agar tercapai cakupan >95% bukan sekedar ikut meramaikan saat seremoni pencanangan PIN Polio.
5. Pos2 PIN dan Nakes2 sangat berharap dan senang sekali bila dimungkinkan kita ikut turun ke lapangan saat pelaksanaan PIN dan sweepingnya.

Maka dengan kondisi tersebut di atas kita di Rotary International District 3410 (RID3410) lebih fokus untuk membantu di wilayah-wilayah jangkauan Rotary Club di daerah masing-masing agar tercapai target >95%.

Strateginya kita di RID 3410 adalah membantu saat pelaksanaan sweeping putaran-1 & PIN putaran-2 tersebut, karena saat itu mereka akan sangat memerlukan bantuan KIE dan SDM, khusus nya Tenaga Relawan, untuk meningkatkan cakupannya.

Untuk kegiatan tersebut, sudah tersedia balon PIN Polio untuk masing-masing wilayah AG dan provinsi di DKI sebanyak 1.000 pcs dan Pin PIN Polio masing-masing 100 pcs.

What is RYLA?

Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) is an intensive leadership program for young people ages 14-30. Organized by clubs, districts, or multi districts, RYLA allows participants to learn new skills through civic engagement and personal and professional development opportunities.

Through RYLA events, clubs, districts, and multi districts equip young leaders with the knowledge and skills they need to make real change locally and globally. In turn, clubs and districts benefit from the fresh perspectives of RYLA participants and alumni.

Objectives

A RYLA program should aim to:

- Develop young people’s leadership skills and recognize those who are making a positive difference in their communities
- Instill a lifelong commitment to service in young people and connect them with ongoing opportunities to serve through

Rotary

- Fulfill Rotary’s commitment to youth service by empowering young people through leadership development

Participants

Although RYLA is open to young people ages 14-30, we are focusing our event by inviting participants of a similar age and maturity level (16-20) and the number of participants will be between 30 - 50 participants. By targeting a particular age group, we can design a program that meets participants’ needs.

Length and timing

We plan to host RYLA event in two days on 22 - 23 February in Purwokerto.

Why support RYLA?

There are many good reasons to get involved in RYLA. Here are just a few:

- **Prepare youth for a strong future:** As a Rotary or Rotaract club member, you know that our world needs as many young leaders as possible to address local and global challenges. 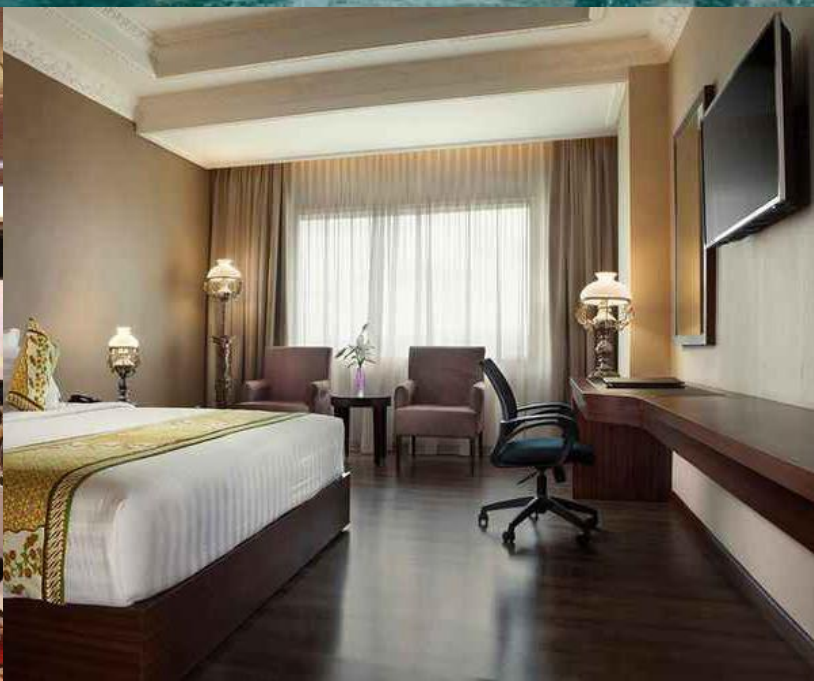


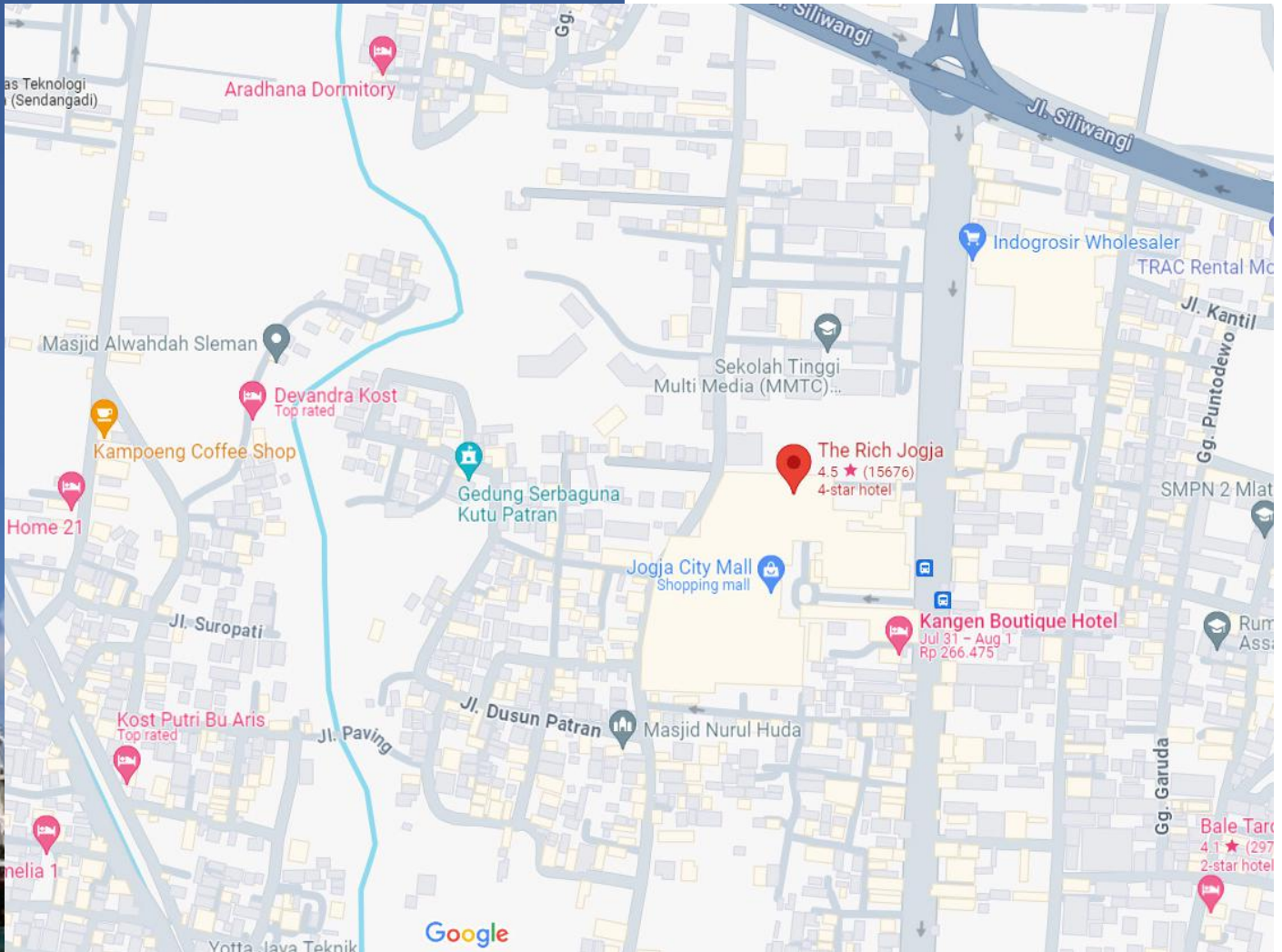
