Troop camps (Pg. 26)


These programs include meals, lodging, and fun camp programs provided by camp staff or volunteers while troop leaders are responsible for the supervision of their troop.

- **What do the listed grades for each session mean?**

- To be eligible for a session your camper should be entering one of the listed grades in fall 2026.

- For volunteer-run camps, please see the full session listing on our camp website for instructions.

- **When are camp forms and payment due?**

- Camp forms and full payment for each camp session are due four weeks prior to the start of camp. You can see the deadline date specified beside each required form listed in your CampInTouch account.

- **What is the cancellation policy?**

- If the cancellation is made with a written request four weeks before the session begins, most sessions will be refunded, minus the registration processing fee. After that, the balance is refunded only if the camper moves out of the state, has been certified to be ill by a physician, or there is a family emergency. 
