When I began this journey, I wasn't thinking about real estate. I was just looking for a home.

I had moved through life with quiet ambition from a modest upbringing, through IIT, into the rhythm of work and building a life. When I began searching for a home of my own, I couldn't find anything that felt right. Everything looked complete, but nothing felt whole.

I wasn't looking for luxury. I was looking for silence, balance, a kind of belonging I couldn't quite name. A place where I could breathe a little deeper. Be more of myself.

That search became White Lotus.

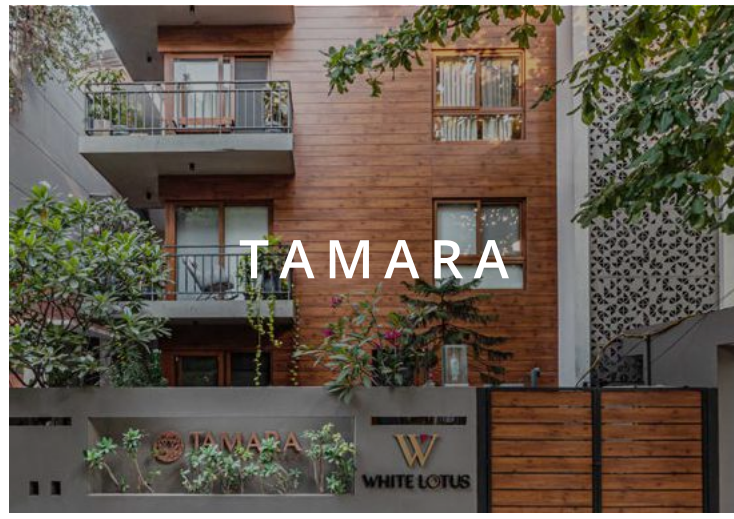


ARAVINDAKSA

Where form flows with restraint, and grace is found not in excess, but in pause.

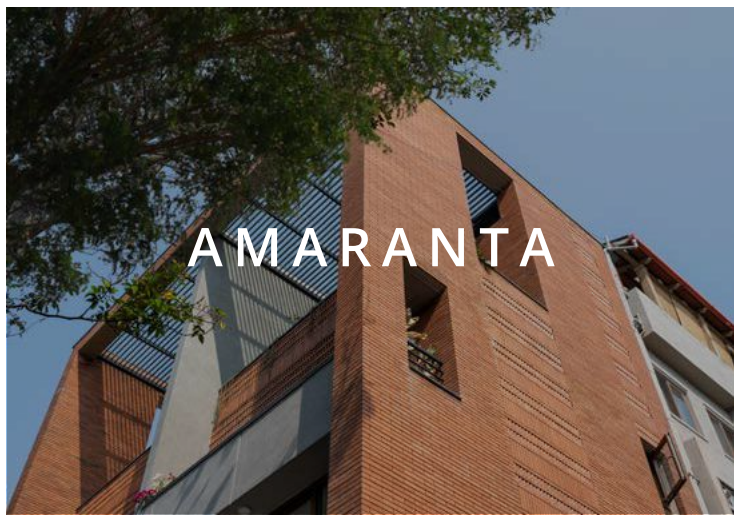


KALPAVRIKSHA

Light was invited in, and design followed life in rhythm, in breath, in stillness.

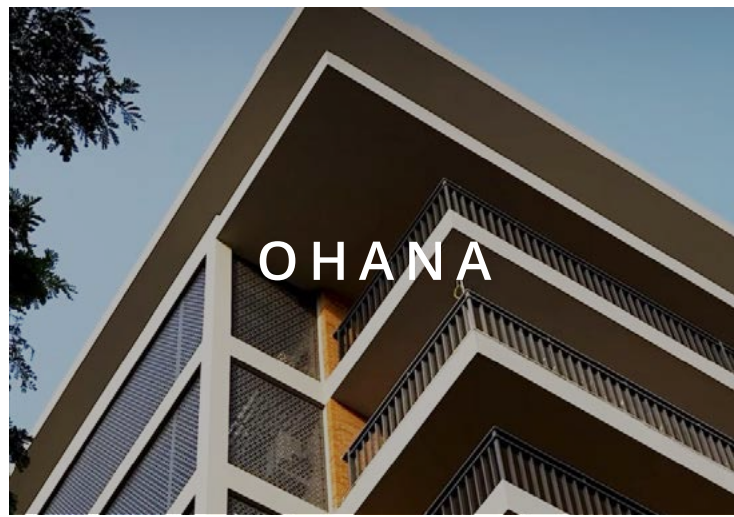


AMARANTA

Amaranta is a home where proportion shapes presence and elegance lives in the everyday.

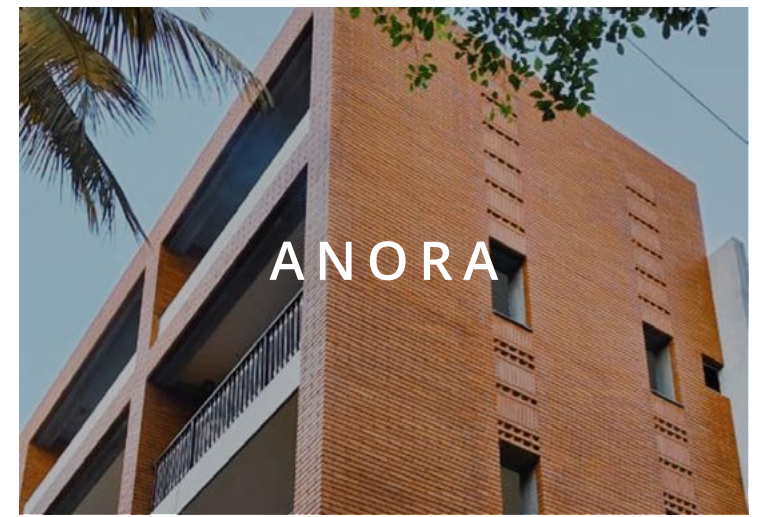

At White Lotus, we've never set out to sell homes. We invite people into a way of life; one shaped by stillness, light, proportion, and deep care. Eleven years in, I've learned that this is not just a brand philosophy. It's our purpose.

When I joined White Lotus, what struck me most was the quality of conversations, not just the quality of the spaces that we built. There was no pitch deck, no script. Just an honest attempt to understand how someone wanted to live, and whether what we were building was right for them.

Our journey began in the heart of Bangalore - in and around Indiranagar and the Central Business District. We shaped sanctuaries in places already rich in rhythm; close to trees, history, and old neighbourhoods that knew how to breathe.

And now, we carry this same purpose forward. To the northern stretches of Bangalore, not because they're next in trend, but because they offer space to deepen what we've always believed: to design with intention, to build with restraint, and to shape homes that feel like sanctuaries.

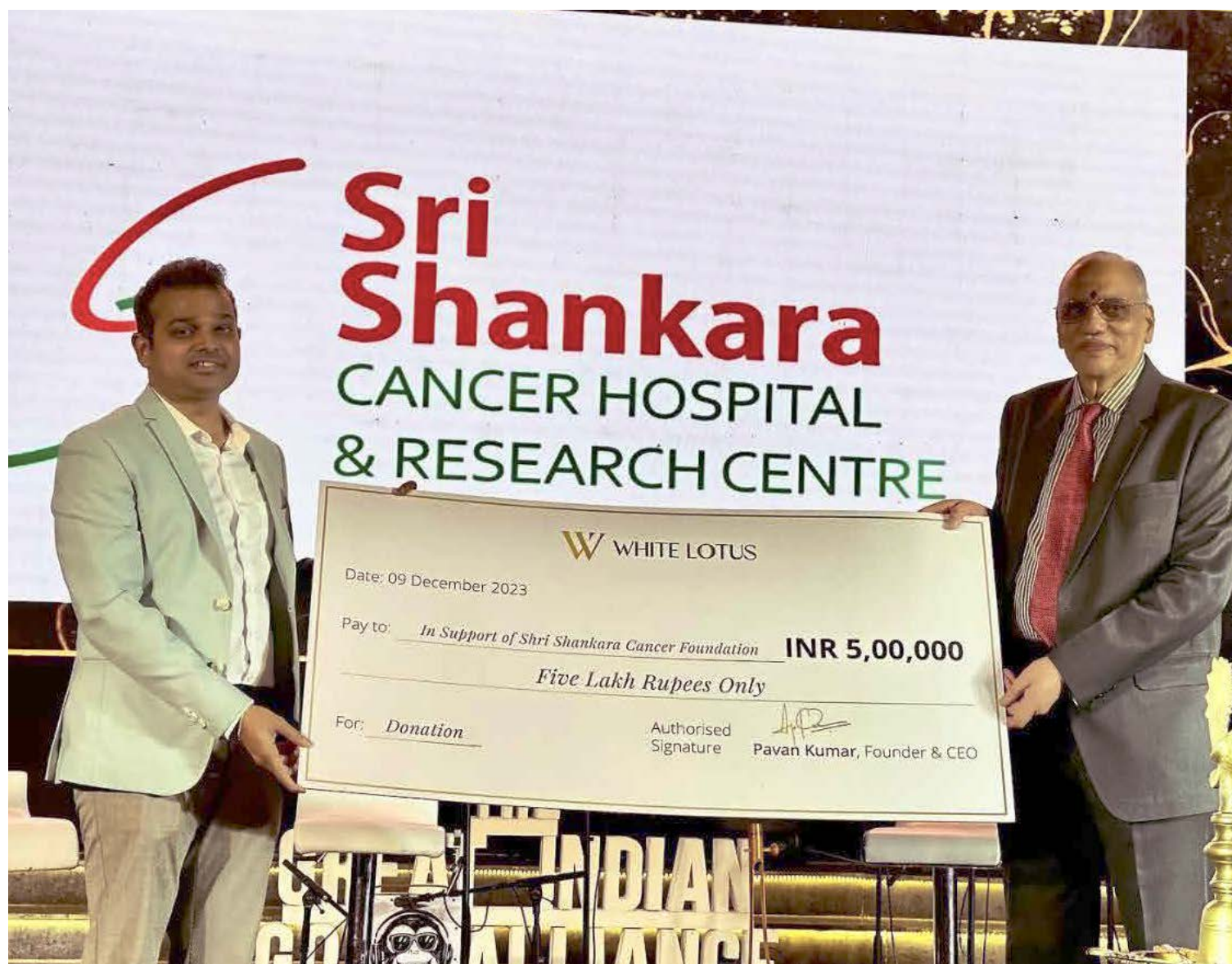
EMBASSY INTERNATIONAL RIDING SCHOOL

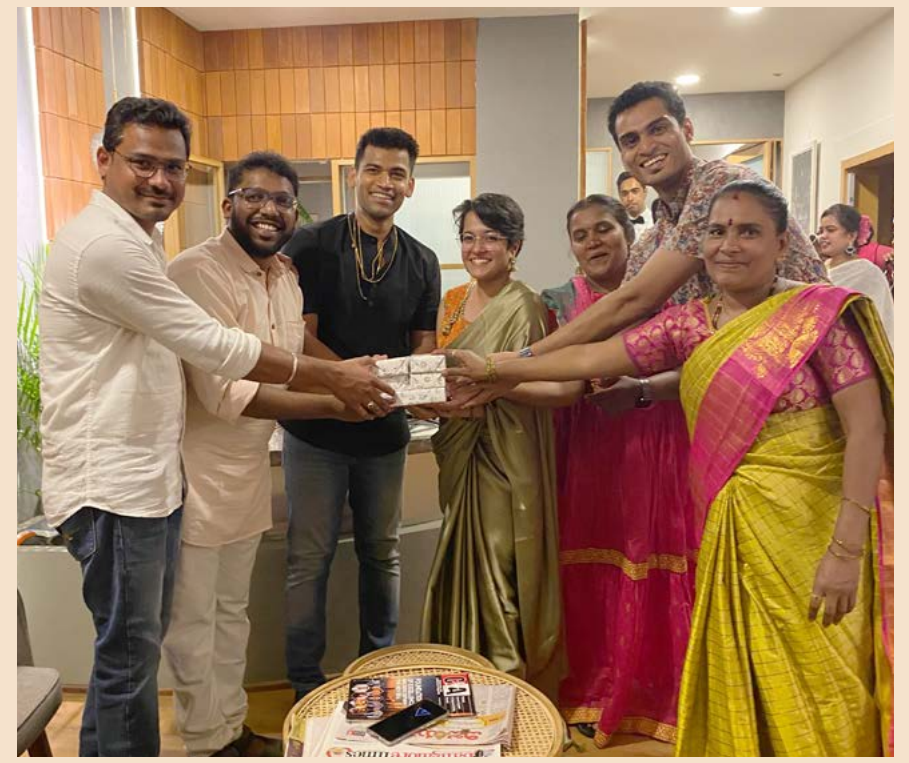
THE PEOPLE BEHIND THE SANCTUARIES
