All credit card purchases have a 2.9% service fee that will be added to the total of your purchase. If you wish to avoid this fee you are welcome to pay by check or cash.

Cancellations

- PRCE reserves the right to cancel and/or combine any program with insufficient enrollment within 7 days prior to the class's start date. All participants will be notified of changes in schedule.
- When public schools are closed for either school/town events or due to inclement weather, programs will not be held. Classes will be rescheduled at a later date.

Discount Policy

- 20% discount on in-house programming to Veterans, Emergency Service workers, and State and Local government employees. This discount is only available for PRCE in-house programming at the discretion of the PRCE department.
- We cannot apply this to most Community Ed programs with a contracted instructor. If you have any question about what programs are eligible, just ask.

Refund Policy

Our programming is 100% funded by course fees.

Our refund policies are strictly adhered to.

- In the event a course is canceled due to low enrollment, you will receive a full refund in the manner in which you paid.
- Pro-rated refunds will only be given if a canceled class cannot be rescheduled.
- To process your refund, you must respond to the cancellation email within 30 days; otherwise, we will process the refund as a household credit.
- In the case of a medical withdrawal, a refund minus a 10% administration fee will be processed when accompanied by a doctor's note.
- Any requests for refunds fewer than five days before a program start will not be granted. All other withdrawal fees will be determined by the PRCE Director and accompanied by a 20% processing fee.
- Refunds will only be given via household credit, check, and credit card. Credit Card refunds will be processed within 5 to 7 business days. Refunds issued by check will be processed within 2 to 4 weeks.
- PRCE reserves the right to change the program location and/or programming staff if needed. Refunds will not be given if this occurs.

Transfer Policy

You may request to transfer into another class if:

- The request is made before the 2nd meeting of the class.
- There is space available on the roster for the class into which you would like to transfer.
- The minimum participation number is still met for the class in which you are currently enrolled.
- A \$15.00 transfer fee is paid in full.

Drop - In Policy

- You must register and pay for a drop-in prior to participating.
- Present your receipt, paper or email, to the instructor upon arrival to your session.
- Instructors cannot accept cash or check payment.

COVID-19 Policy

- Our department will continue to monitor and follow all federal, state, and local guidelines. We will work with and update our instructors and patrons about any necessary program adjustments as related to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- If the registered participant is ill or has a fever we could ask that you stay at home and not return to programming for 24 hours. If you test positive for COVID, we ask that you follow CDC guidelines.

Littleton Middle School

55 Russell Street; Entrance road located just south of Highland Lane on Russell Street. Parking lot entrance and exits follow one-way traffic pattern.

56 King Street; Entrance located off King Street between St. Anne's Church and Kimball Street. Caution lights mark the entrance road. All indoor programming should follow the road up to the top parking lot and enter the main school entrance. The lower parking lot can be used for access to tennis courts, baseball, and softball fields.

Camp Tahattawan is located at the Shaker Lane Elementary School in Littleton, MA. Surrounded by playing fields, the location is perfect for all outdoor activities. The use of a large gym area, as well as cafeteria and restrooms make the indoor activities just as pleasant. The campers walk to Long Lake (approximately 1/3 mile) to enjoy afternoon swimming.

The camp is conveniently located 2 miles north-west of Route 2 off exit 41, or 2.5 miles south of Route 495.

STAFF

At Camp Tahattawan, we have a low camper to counselor ratio. Our staff is screened carefully and interviewed during the hiring process. Counselors are chosen according to their level of experience, creativity, motivation and of course, their love for children. Senior lead counselors generally are in college or graduate school studying for child-related careers. All our staff must complete a rigorous training process prior to the start of the season which includes certifications in both CPR and First Aid at the Pro-Rescuer level. All staff are CORI/SORI checked.



FIELD TRIPS**

The campers can opt to (extra fee) a variety of off-campus field trips most Fridays during camp. This provides an interesting, educational, and diverse way to end the week. In the past, Camp Tahattawan has enjoyed hiking, amusement parks, water parks, zoos and much more. This year will be no different. Each week has a new and interesting theme and field trip for the campers to enjoy!

** Field Trips are optional for campers. You will be able to choose, for an additional cost, to participate in the Field Trip or spend the day at Camp in a normal Camp day.

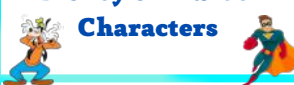

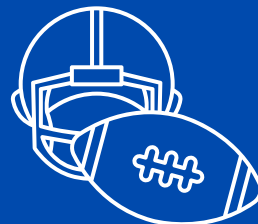

The Town of Littleton Parks and Recreation welcomes you to our beautiful beach. Long Lake Beach is a premier spot for beachgoers and summer lovers. Situated on the northeast end of Long Pond, at 20 Town Road in Littleton, MA, the sandy beach is adjacent to a state boat ramp with dock and launch site for canoes, kayaks and boats under 20 horsepower (hp). Other amenities include a bathhouse, snack shack, playground, picnic areas and boat (kayak, canoe, SUP) rentals. It's easy to spend a day swimming, fishing, paddling, and checking out the scenery.

The park is open from dawn to dusk year-round, to both residents and non-residents. From Memorial Day through Labor Day, a beach membership and parking permit are required. Beachgoers can purchase a seasonal membership or pay a daily use fee. Before visiting our beautiful beach, please familiarize yourself with our rules, regulations, and amenities. For the safety and enjoyment of others, the Town's regulations prohibit alcohol, flotation devices of any type, and dogs. Certified service dogs are welcome to accompany their owner, but may not enter the water. Please visit the Town of Littleton website for more information including, Rules and Regulations, Water Quality Reports, Hours of Operation, Equipment and Facility Rentals and Membership information.

Membership / Day Pass Information

The 2024 Long Lake Beach Season Membership includes 1 Membership card for each member of your household over 3yrs. Any person visiting Long Lake Beach between Memorial Day and Labor Day is required to have their membership card or purchase a day pass. The membership also includes one (1) 2024 parking sticker. The 2024 rates, as approved by the Littleton Park and Recreation Commission:

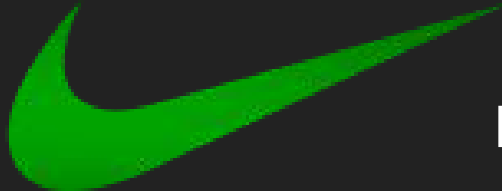
