## St. Joseph's Corner

This Sunday, we begin a new liturgical year and enter the holy season of reflection and preparation. Amid the busyness of decorating, shopping, and planning gatherings, let us focus on preparing our hearts and minds for the gifts of hope, peace, joy, and love that Christ brings.

"The one who has hope lives differently; the one who hopes has been granted the gift of a new life" (Spe Salvi, Benedict XVI, para. 2).

Who better to guide us on the path to prepare ourselves for Jesus than St. Joseph, who profoundly embodies hope rooted in his unwavering faith and trust in God?

### The Light of Hope in Our Homes

The first candle of the Advent Wreath symbolizes hope, the kind that, for St. Joseph, meant trusting in what he could not yet see—a Savior who would fulfill God's promise of salvation. We are called to that very same hope, not just for Christmas, to prepare our hearts for Jesus in our everyday lives. This hope not only sustained St. Joseph but also guided his actions as he awaited the fulfillment of God's promises.

### The Advent of St. Joseph: A Quiet Trust

Joseph's Advent wasn't limited to four weeks but spanned months of uncertainty and faith. Yet, trusting God's promises, he became a vital part of salvation history, guiding Mary and Jesus with quiet strength. Joseph waited patiently for God's guidance. What a profound amount of patience he must have been granted, knowing that he would be responsible for protecting the Child who would bring salvation to all mankind while still having to wait for God to reveal the fullness of His plan.

This kind of waiting is countercultural in today's world of instant feedback, same-day Amazon Prime, and answers to our most pressing questions revealed in the time it takes to press the search button. Yet Joseph reminds us that God's timing is perfect, and His promises are worth the wait.

### Our Call as Husbands and Fathers

This Advent, embrace the role of your family's spiritual leader, following St. Joseph's example. Guide your loved ones in preparing their hearts for Christ. Begin by cultivating patience through daily moments of prayer and reflection and inviting your family to join you.

Trust God by surrendering a shared worry or anxiety as a family, demonstrating your faith in His providence. Lead your family in acts of service, whether by helping a neighbor, contributing to your parish, or giving your time, talents, and treasure to those less fortunate. By embodying these virtues, you invite Christ's presence not only at Christmas but as a lasting part of your family's daily life.

**December 4—CLASS**

**December 11-Reconciliation Gr 3-8 Church**

**\*\*Students in grades 3-8 will meet in church for Advent Reconciliation. Students will sit with their class and attendance will be taken. Parents must accompany their children in church. Grades 1 and 2 are off on Dec. 11th.**

### Meaning of the Advent Wreath

Traditionally, Advent wreaths are constructed of a circle of evergreen branches into which four candles are inserted, representing the four weeks of Advent. Ideally, three candles are purple and one is rose, but white candles can also be used.

The purple candles in particular symbolize the prayer, penance, and preparatory sacrifices and good works undertaken at this time. The rose candle is lit on the third Sunday, Gaudete Sunday, when the priest may wear rose vestments at Mass; Gaudete Sunday is the Sunday of rejoicing, because the faithful have arrived at the midpoint of Advent, when their preparation is now half over and they are close to Christmas.

The progressive lighting of the candles symbolizes the expectation and hope surrounding our Lord's first coming into the world and the anticipation of his second coming to judge the living and the dead.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Recently, there have been several reports about the Feast of the Immaculate Conception and its status as a Holy day of Obligation in the media.

Consequently, and in accord with canon Canon 87. §, I therefore issue the decree establishing the following: the obligation linked to the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, which has been transferred to Monday, December 9, 2024, is hereby dispensed in the Diocese of Joliet. No member of the Catholic Faithful in the Diocese is obligated to attend Mass on December 9, 2024.

Because the Blessed Mother is the Patroness of the United States under the title of the Immaculate Conception, I still encourage your participation at Mass and your devotion to the Immaculate Conception.
