RUBY BATEMAN

Ruby Bateman is a visual artist working from her home studio in the South West Countryside.

Ruby's practice is deeply heartfelt; creating from a place of sincerity and only selecting materials that are natural and non-toxic for her paintings and drawings.



With a richly colourful and symbolic visual language, her work tells a multitude of stories; her personal encounters with love and loss, the stories that live in the body, the medicine of plants and nature, and the stories she's loved reading from folklore, fiction and mythology.

Interweaving all this is her passion and curiosity in Jungian and psychotherapy philosophies, ancestral teachings, maternal politics, the esoteric and the expansive work of William Blake.

For Ruby, the experience of making is an alchemical act. It is an essential relationship with the self and connection to a deeper material consciousness.

STACEY GLEDHILL

Stacey Gledhill is a New Zealand-born painter based in Oxford, UK, working in oils on linen, wood, and paper. Trained in the figurative tradition at London Fine Art Studios, her practice is rooted in close observation, and in the belief that paying attention is itself a form of love.



Her latest works for Milieu began in the home garden.

Moving from direct observation to a more inventive approach - feeling, imagined colour, abstraction - the paintings use the garden's natural cycles of growth, decay, and return as a way of thinking about the larger changes pressing on all of us.

They are paintings made in uncertain times, and they propose a form of hope that doesn't look away from difficulty: not the hope of endless bloom and growth, but one that includes death and the cycle of renewal itself as a way to think about our lives and societal shifts.

FRANKIE THORP

Frankie Thorp is an East London-based artist whose paintings explore themes of memory and nostalgia.

Having studied illustration at London College of Communication her work has since evolved into a whimsical exploration of the sanctuary of being at home, entwining the familiarity found in everyday objects with idiosyncratic emblems.



Frankie's works are made up of playful compositions with references to both past and present, occasionally tapping into conversations around 'Britishness'.

Her larger works are focused around messy tablescapes dotted with food and drink and often accompanied by pensive looking figures and sleeping dogs.

SOPHIE WAKE

Sophie's fine art practice responds to the quiet rhythms of meditation and ancient tree tea ceremony which has become a fundamental companion to her creative approach.

Working from her studio in South West Devon, she creates through quiet reflection, guided by somatic experience her work tends to be instinctive and intuitive, each piece an automatic process of deep self enquiry.



Exploring the metaphorical idea of humans as fragile containers for spiritual awakening, Sophie's paintings and sacred earth forms inhabit an otherworldliness which goes beyond the constraints of concept, words and duality, to where boundaries soften and transformation occurs.

Recently, her birds stand as quiet witness inhabiting the threshold between form and void. The tension of inside and outside the vessel motif, suggesting a permeability of boundaries where neither state fully defines and both coexist in fluid exchange and ultimate unity.

JESSICA TREMAINE

Jessica Tremaine is a Cornish artist based in Penzance, U.K.

Having spent many years working as a designer for studios such as Martine Rose in London and BLESS in Paris, she turned to ceramics as a preferred medium of storytelling.



‘My work encompasses historical elements of human spirituality as well as more recent industrial influences. I’m concerned with the loss of traditions surrounding community gatherings, celebrations and ceremonies.

Aesthetically the work appears heavy and tough, borrowing and distorting symbols that are often combined with suggestions of functional metalwork.’

AMABEL BARRACLOUGH

Amabel Barraclough is a self taught ceramicist and gardener based in Stroud, where she lives with her partner and two daughters.

Her pieces aim to capture a kind of beauty that is full of energy and power and embraces imperfection. The roughness and rawness in the process of making embodies Amabel's ideas about strength and love especially in the context of motherhood.



She is drawn to imagery from mythology and folk art that transmit a feeling of magic, humour and freedom. Her work plays with symbol and association and celebrates a joyful connection with nature; the human body leaping and falling in space and animals as little Gods - as knowing and watching beings.

VICTORIA FOWLE

Victoria Fowle is a ceramic artist based in St Leonards on Sea, East Sussex, creating hand built lamps.

Her work is defined by bold structural form and considered pattern, expressed through coil constructed, architectural silhouettes and rhythmic surface detail.



Drawing on an interest in repetition and proportion, her process is intuitive and material-led, allowing subtle variations in form and finish to emerge. The resulting pieces are both sculptural and functional, with a quiet, architectural presence.
