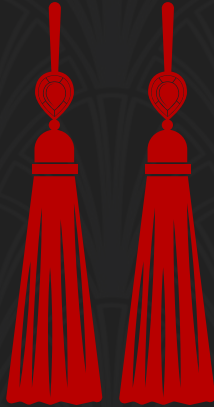

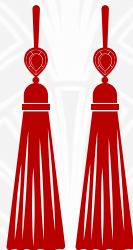

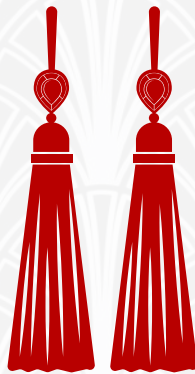

In 1968, Fran Weissler, along with her husband and partner, Barry, established National Artists Management Company, Inc. (NAMCO), an entertainment production company based in New York City. They have nearly 50 years of experience developing, financing, casting, managing, marketing, licensing, and consulting for first-class theatrical ventures on Broadway and the West End as well as touring domestically and internationally.

Fran and Barry are the winners of seven Tony Awards: *Othello*, the Weissler's Broadway debut starring James Earl Jones and Christopher Plummer; *Fiddler on the Roof* with Topol; *Gypsy* with Tyne Daly; *Annie Get Your Gun* with Bernadette Peters and Reba McEntire; the worldwide hit, *Chicago*; the 2010 revival of *La Cage Aux Folles* with Kelsey Grammer; and the 2013 revival of *Pippin* starring Patina Miller and Andrea Martin.

Chicago-- which has been running continuously on Broadway for 26 years, is the longest-running American musical in the world. The show's global success has reached over 25 countries and has been translated into a dozen languages.

Other notable Broadway credits include *Cabaret* with Joel Grey; *Cat on a Hot Tin Roof* with Kathleen Turner; *Zorba* with Anthony Quinn; *My One & Only* with Tommy Tune; *My Fair Lady* with Richard Chamberlain; *William Finn's Falsettos*; *Grease* with Megan Mullally; *Seussical* with Rosie O'Donnell; *Wonderful Town* with Brooke Shields; *Sweet Charity* with Christina Applegate; the West End premiere of Neil LaBute's *Fat Pig*; and *Kander and Ebb's The Scottsboro Boys*, directed and choreographed by Susan Stroman.

In addition to *Chicago* and *Pippin*, their newest hit, *Waitress*, a musical adaptation of Adrienne Shelly's 2007 independent film favorite, with an original score by Grammy Award-winning singer/songwriter, Sara Bareilles, is currently available for licensing. Her current producing projects include the revival of the beloved musical *Carnival*, a new show entitled, *Real Women Have Curves*, and *The Bedwetter* which has a book and lyrics by Sarah Silverman.

Growing Need

Florida's population is predicted to continue growing. Increasing population alone has caused the need for 211's services to grow rapidly.

Suicide Prevention

The percentage of Mental Health/Addictions-related requests increased from 17% of total requests to 33% of total requests. The new federally designated number to call for suicide prevention (988) is expected to further increase call volume to 211 – projected at 9 times its current volume within 5 years.

Inadequate Facility

Currently, offices meant for 1 staff member are housing 3. This situation will only become worse as demand for services continues to grow.



Hurricane Protection

The 211 offices are not adequately protected against hurricanes, which is precisely when 211's services are most in need.

Modernization Needed

A greatly expanded and modernized facility is needed to handle 211's current needs, let alone the growth it anticipates over the next 25 years.

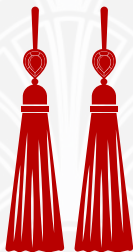
