## A Message From the Campus Pastor!

### Pressing Forward into the New Year

As we jump into a new year, it's natural to look back and reflect on the past while anticipating what lies ahead. Paul's words in Philippians 3:13-14 provide a powerful reminder of how we, as followers of Christ, should approach the past and the future as we press forward into the new year.

#### 1. Remembering the Past with Purpose

Paul urges us to "forget those things which are behind," but this doesn't mean erasing the past from our memory. Instead, we are to remember the past only in ways that help us move forward:

**Thankfulness:** Reflect on God's faithfulness and blessings. What prayers has He answered? How has He provided and sustained you? Gratitude fuels hope for the future.

**Wisdom:** Learn from the experiences of the past—both successes and failures. Wisdom gained from past lessons equips us for what lies ahead.

**Confidence:** Recall how God has brought you through challenges. Let those victories inspire trust in His continued guidance and provision.

However, we must also leave behind the things that hinder us:

**Hurts and Bitterness:** Let go of grudges and unresolved pain, knowing that forgiveness and healing are found in Christ.

**Sins:** Confess and repent of past mistakes, trusting in God's forgiveness (1 John 1:9).

**Victories:** Avoid living in past achievements;

#### 2. Looking Forward with Determination

Paul's mindset is clear: he focuses not on the past, but on what lies ahead. This forward-facing attitude is marked by:

**His Passion:** Paul is driven by his love for Christ and his desire to know Him more fully (Philippians 3:10). As we enter the new year, let a passion for Jesus fuel your goals and decisions.

**His Focus:** Paul is laser-focused on the goal—his relationship with Christ and his calling as a believer. Distractions can easily derail us, but when we fix our eyes on Jesus, we stay on course (Hebrews 12:2).

**His Prize:** The ultimate prize Paul seeks is the "upward call of God in Christ Jesus." For Paul, this isn't just a heavenly reward but the joy of fulfilling God's purpose and growing in Christlikeness each day.

As we enter this new year, let's follow Paul's example:

**Let go of the past.** Release anything that weighs you down, and thank God for the lessons learned and the victories He has given.

**Set your focus on Christ.** Make it your goal to know Him more deeply through prayer, Scripture, and worship.

**Run with purpose.** Like Paul, press forward with determination, seeking to glorify God in all you do.

#### Prayer:

*Heavenly Father, thank You for Your faithfulness in the past year. Help us to release the things that hinder us and to move forward with passion, focus, and a desire to glorify You. Guide us as we step into this new year, pressing toward the goal of knowing Christ more fully and fulfilling Your purposes for our lives. In Jesus' name, Amen.*

Let's make 2025 a year of intentional growth, unwavering focus, and deepened faith as we press on toward the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Happy New Year!

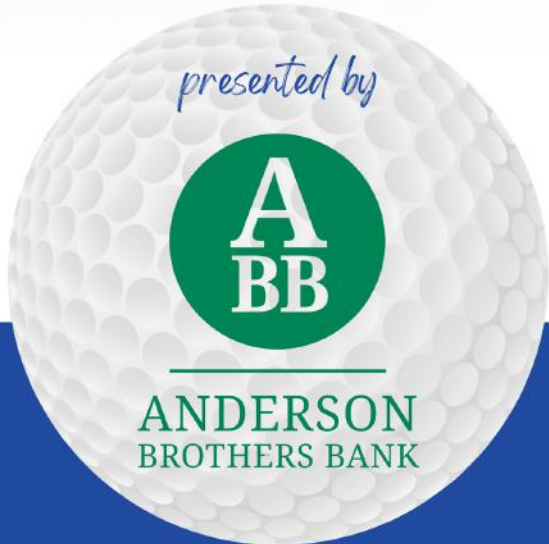

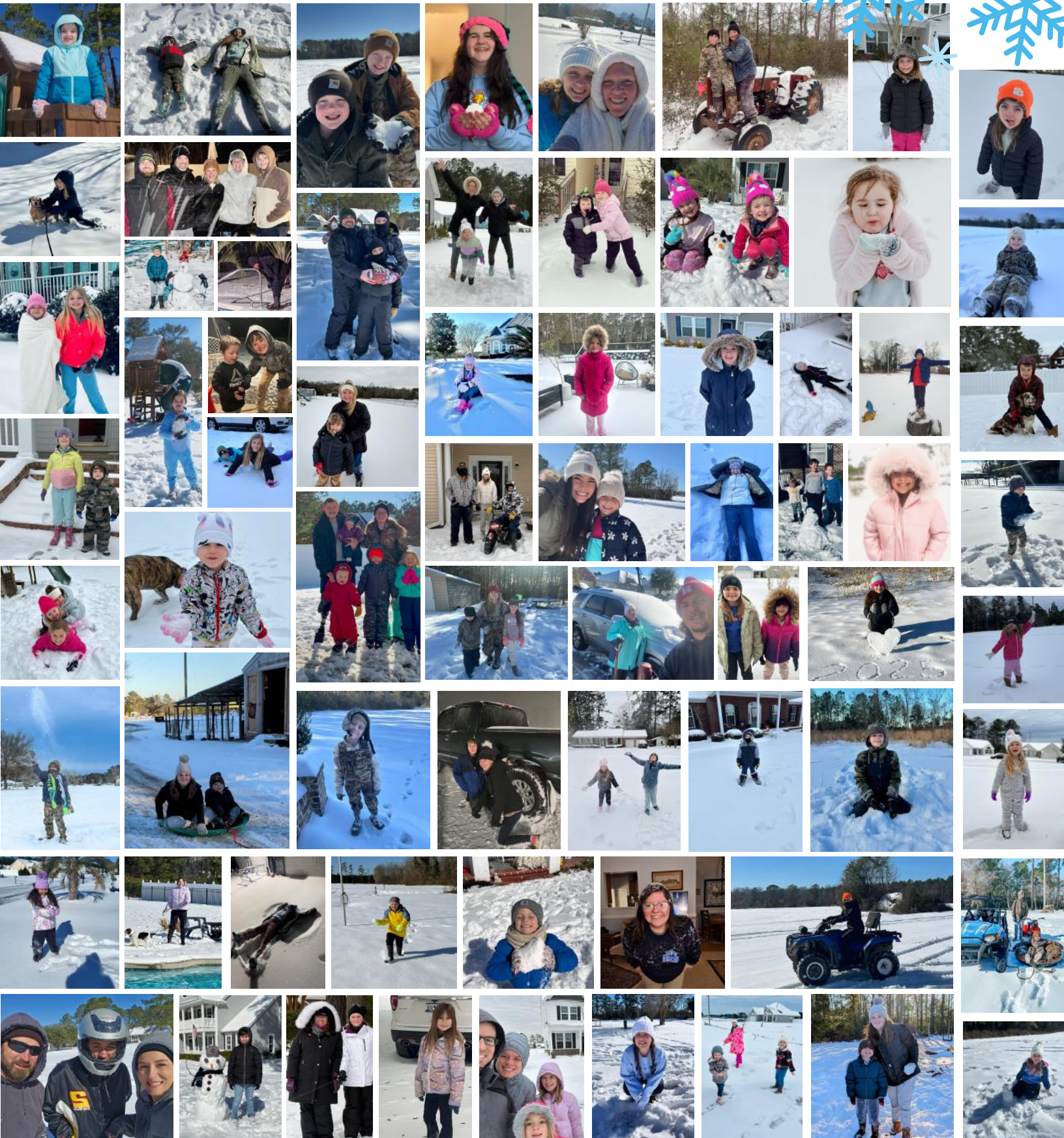
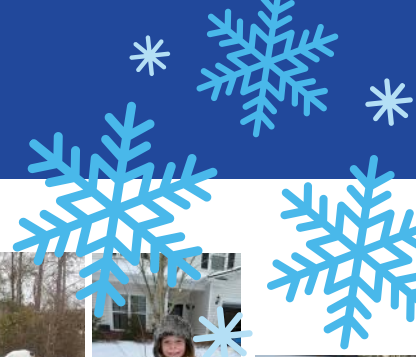
