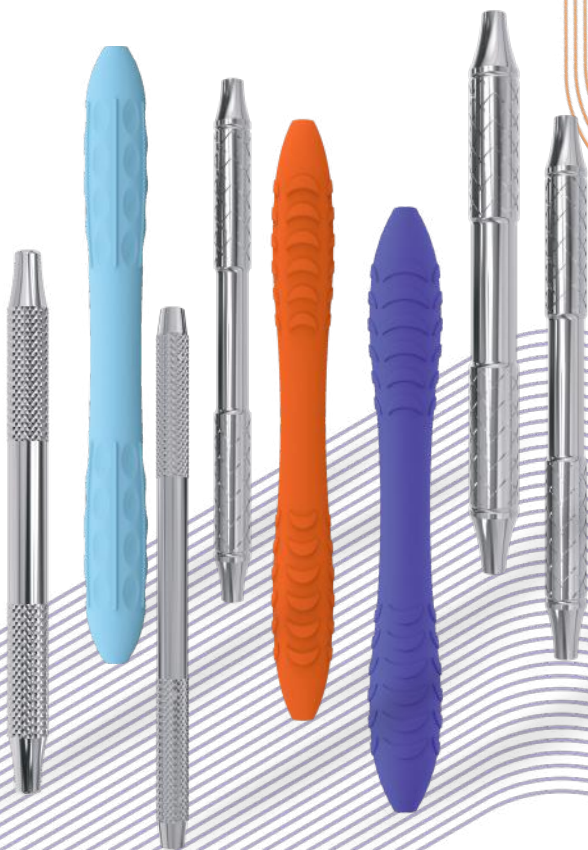

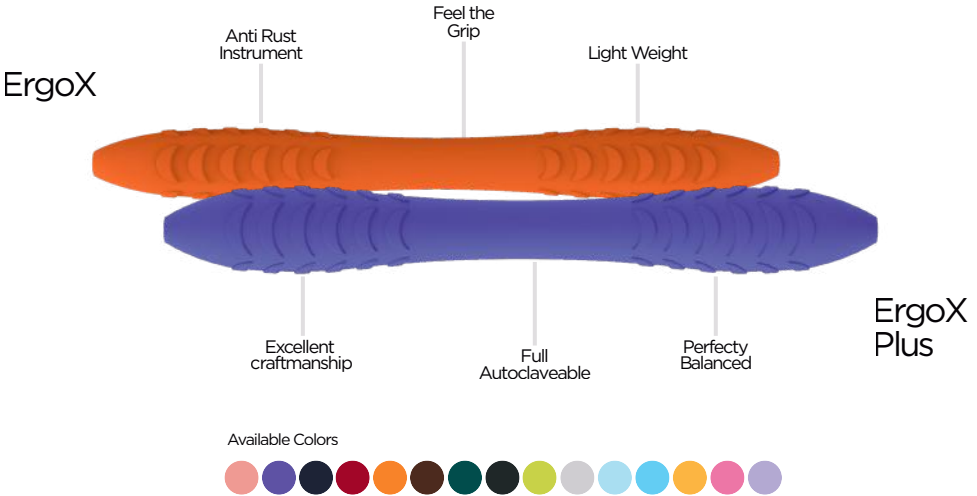

ErgoSteel S (Standard)

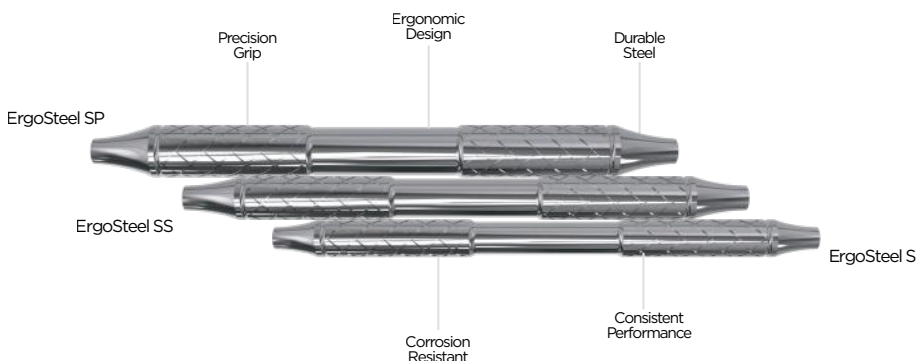

ErgoLite X

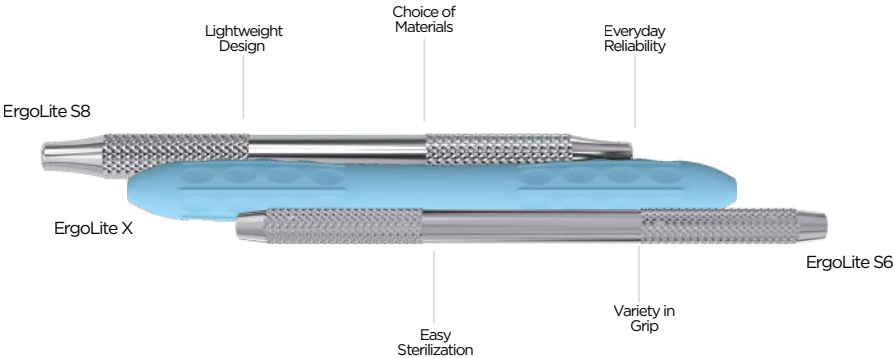
