CLINICAL FELLOWSHIP PROGRAMME 2025 –27

Over a number of years, our fellows have delivered important projects around lifestyle medicine, suicide prevention, cancer, health inequalities, leadership, research and many more.

We are now inviting expressions of interest for a new cohort of Clinical Fellows to support transformational workstreams across general practice in Derbyshire. This programme is designed to foster compassionate, inclusive, and values-based leadership, while delivering meaningful projects that improve patient care, community engagement, and system efficiency.

All fellows will be supported by The Hub Plus through leadership development, mentorship, and peer learning. Each fellowship will run for 12+ months, with fellows working 1–2 sessions per week alongside their clinical roles. There may be an opportunity for a 6-month extension subject to project progress, requirements and funding.



HELP PATIENTS ACCESS FREE NHS WEIGHT MANAGEMENT SUPPORT

The NHS Digital Weight Management Programme (DWMP) is a free 12-week service designed to support adults living with obesity who also have diabetes, hypertension, or both.

Eligibility:

- Age 18+
- BMI > 30 (or > 27.5 for Black, Asian, and minority ethnic groups)
- Have diabetes, hypertension, or both
- Access to a smartphone, tablet, or computer

Referral Process:

You can only make a referral via your EMIS, SystmOne or Medicus e-referral (e-RS) system. You will need the referral templates, which are available to download from the <a href="https://www.needicus.com/needicus.c

Practices receive £11.50 per referral up to their allocation, supporting the delivery of this important service.

By helping patients access DWMP, practices play a vital role in improving health outcomes and reducing risks associated with long-term conditions. Uptake in Derby and Derbyshire is currently among the lowest in the Midlands - your support can make a real difference.
