CHAPTER HISTORY

The Beginning

In 2005, three visionary members of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Incorporated saw the need for and potential of a new chapter to focus exclusively on the service of those counties on the eastern perimeter of Metropolitan Atlanta. Stephanie Moore, Sarah Lundy and Jenell Clark began the journey that would eventually culminate in the chartering of the Covington Area Alumnae Chapter. These sorors with the help of several others, began and continued the discussion for several years bringing awareness to the continued demographic changes and population growth of this area.

In February of 2012, Southern Regional Director Cheryl Turner recognized the growing need for the establishment of a new chapter to focus exclusively on servicing the eastern Metropolitan Atlanta counties of Newton, Walton and Barrow. A steering committee was formed to lead the chartering efforts.

Chartering

On April 12, 2014, the Covington Area Alumnae Chapter was established as the 1034th chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. with 75 charter members.

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT



The Economic Development program initiative of the Covington Area Alumnae Chapter is designed to help citizens set and define goals, develop a plan to achieve them, and put the plan into action. The process serves as a blueprint to address all aspects of personal finances. This year, the chapter partnered with Commissioner Alana Sanders to ensure families had meals during the pandemic. The chapter also sponsored a Homebuyers Workshop to educate the community on what it takes to become a homeowner.



EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT



Although we were plagued with a pandemic, the 2020 - 2021 Delta Academy/ Delta G.E.M.S. program thrived this year. We kicked off our programming with a virtual cooking class, led by Chef Charlotte Joy. Each participant received a recipe with a basket of ingredients and made chicken bruschetta. In this session, the girls also learned proper cutting and cleaning techniques.



YEAR IN REVIEW

- **December - (Annual Kwanzaa celebration)** Participants learned about the meaning and principles of Kwanzaa.
- **January - (Goal setting)** Participants learned about the importance of setting goals. They set short-term and long-term goals, then made digital vision boards.
- **February - (Self-care)** Participants learned about the importance of self-care. Each girl received a basket full of goodies to help take care of themselves. During the session, participants made sugars scrubs, and learned how to do a facial.
- **March - (Financial literacy)** Participants learned about creating a budget and sticking to it through a virtual reality game.
- **April - (College prep)** Participants explored college life through a virtual panel discussion with current college students. They made edible pennants of the school they want to attend.
- **May - (Year-end celebration)** The Educational Development committee closed out the year with a drive through celebration for participants.



INTERNATIONAL AWARENESS & INVOLVEMENT



The Covington Area Alumnae Chapter (CAAC) harnesses its vast potential to impact strategically the plight of people living across the diaspora. The International Awareness and Involvement (IAI) committee has worked to strengthen our outreach and involvement in Africa and Haiti. On December 1, 2020, CAAC chapter members wore red and flooded their social media timelines with flyers to bring awareness to HIV/AIDS and help End the Stigma. The chapter launched a month-long awareness campaign by publishing weekly HIV/AIDS Facts.

To further increase knowledge of HIV/AIDS within the chapter, a Superhero Cartoon Series was created using images resembling CAAC Sorors.

During the month of December, the Bitmoji cartoons were included in the chapter's weekly newsletter the *Crimson Connection*.

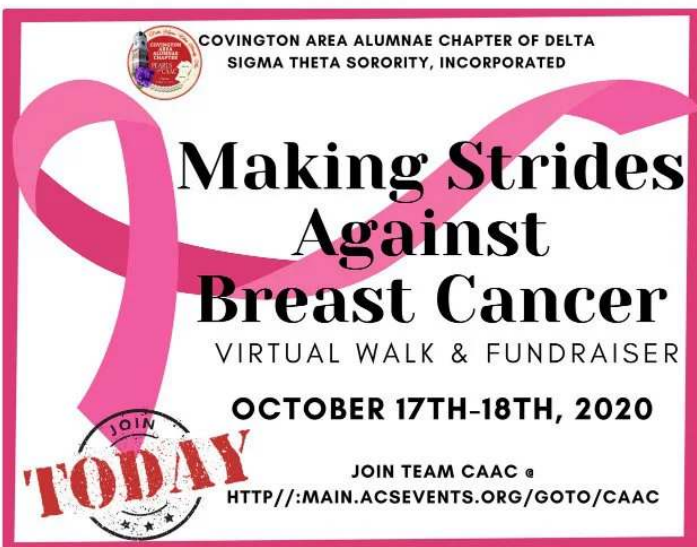


We are supporting communities globally

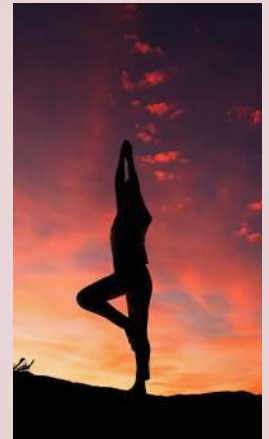
