- What's the best way to communicate with you, and how often will we meet?

#### 4. Costs & Timeline

- ■How do you charge for your services (fixed fee, hourly rate, or percentage of build cost)?
- What's included in your fee, and are there any additional costs I should expect?
- How long do you estimate the design process will take?

#### 5. Final Steps

- Can you provide references from past clients?
- What happens if we need to make design changes after the initial concept?
