




Arnhem: Where History and Nature Meet

Visit the War Museum to gain insight into the famed Battle of Arnhem, depicted in the film "A Bridge Too Far", and understand the resilience that helped rebuild this artistic hub.

In the afternoon, choose between two immersive experiences. Journey through time at the Dutch Open Air Museum, where windmills, vintage trams, and age-old crafts offer a glimpse into Dutch life of the past. Or visit the Kröller-Müller Museum, home to the second-largest Van Gogh collection in the world, set against the backdrop of the scenic Hoge Veluwe National Park.







DAY 3 Middelburg & Coastal Charms

East India Company Echoes & Dutch Delicacies

Your watch shows relaxation—and late morning. It's time for the charming capital of Zeeland province. Nearly 400 years ago, it was also a seat of the Dutch East India Company. 1,200 listed buildings tell the story of this and other fascinating histories. A journey through time is well worth it. Join us on an exciting city tour. In the afternoon, take a bike ride to Vlissingen, where you'll explore the picturesque Zeeland coastline on two wheels, enjoying the fresh sea breeze, or embark on a culinary tour through the historic trading town of Veere.

A TALE OF TWO CITIES

In the early morning, your ship docks in Ghent—a jewel of Flanders and a medieval city steeped in grandeur. Explore its well-preserved architecture, winding alleys, and impressive 13th-century Gravensteen Castle, once home to the Counts of Flanders. The stories etched in its walls are as captivating as the city's artistic soul.

Later, venture to Bruges, often called the "Venice of the North." This fairytale city enchants with its cobbled streets, stone bridges, and serene canals. Visit the stunning Basilica of the Holy Blood, sip beer by the canal, and lose yourself in charming boutiques and artisanal chocolate shops. This day offers the perfect blend of historical immersion and sweet indulgence.



DAY 5 Belgian Icons: Antwerp & Brussels

Diamonds, Art, and Atomic Ambitions

This morning begins with a trip to Brussels, Belgium's stylish capital. Admire the iconic Atomium, a mid-century marvel built for the 1958 World's Fair, and stroll through the Cinquantenaire Park with its sweeping arches and manicured grounds—a symbol of national pride.

Return to Antwerp in the afternoon, a city celebrated for its diamonds, culture, and artistic heritage. Marvel at the Cathedral of Our Lady and see works by the legendary Rubens. Discover narrow alleys filled with boutiques, cozy cafés, and lively squares. As your vessel departs in the evening, enjoy dinner on board while reflecting on the cultural riches of Belgium.

Rise early to find yourself in Rotterdam, a city reborn with bold architecture and urban innovation. After breakfast, visit Kinderdijk—home to a remarkable collection of 18th-century windmills, still standing as guardians of Dutch ingenuity. Learn how these structures helped the Netherlands reclaim its land from the sea.

In the afternoon, prepare for one of the journey's most dazzling highlights: Keukenhof Gardens. Open only in spring, this 79-acre floral wonderland features over seven million tulips, daffodils, and hyacinths in full bloom. It's a photographer's paradise and a sensory delight. Return to the ship in the evening for a final cruise back to Amsterdam.

Wake up in Amsterdam and experience the city from its most scenic angle—on the water. A relaxing morning canal cruise weaves you through a maze of waterways lined with 17th-century houses, colorful houseboats, and quaint bridges.


Final Reflections
