Start your morning with hand-made, wood-fired bagels and coffee at B-Side. Plain, sea salt, benne, cinnamon + brown sugar + golden raisin, or onion + jalapeño + cheddar – you’ve got options! Or get the Morning B-Side Egg on a Roll. For lunch, they have soups, salads, and sandwiches. Outside seating is available. Small to-go coffees are served in the iconic NYC Greek coffee cups!

local tip: There is always something delicious in the bakery case – danishes, cinnamon rolls, fried pies and babka knots.

Calle Latina serves up amazing Latin American street food, including tasty empanadas, tortas, arepas and tacos. Expect the wonderful aromas of smoked meats and roasting vegetables. Salsa is handmade. And yes, their margaritas are a must-try! Spot this gem by the vibrant mural outside.

local tip: Look for weekly specials! Half-off margaritas on Thursdays, and all-you-can-drink sangria on Saturdays.

Ranked by *Food & Wine* among the best burgers in the U.S., these are made from cows raised on the sweet grasses of the southeast, dry-aged and ground fresh, never fed antibiotics, hormones or grain. The menu is seasonal, with beef, pork and produce sourced from nearby farms. Build your own burger or pick a blackboard burger. Try the FB fries – tossed with parmesan, garlic, and herbs.

local tip: Kid-friendly floats and adult floats, too!

Brunch? Second breakfast? Dinner? Call it what you want. This cozy gem of a diner is bursting with quirky personality and specializes in all-day, diner-style favorites such as chicken-and-waffles; eggs any style (including six types of eggs Benedict); jumbo biscuits with house-made jellies or sausage gravy; pork chili; and fried chicken sandwiches.

local tip: Don't pass on the grit fritters served with peach jam.

local tip: You can't have too much green sauce. Ask for extra.

Shepherd's Pie, classic fish n' chips, and the Guinness-braised beef brisket are stand-out standards, and the warm brussels sprout salad has a devoted fan base. Round out your meal with a properly poured Guinness on draft, local and imported beers, or seasonal cocktail.

local tip: Live Irish music Tuesday evenings from 7:30 to 9:30 pm.

Authentic Mexican dishes and drinks prepared with a twist in the heart of Oakhurst. Savor the flavor of tamales, tostadas, taquitos, and tacos. And then there's weekend brunch. Heavenly chipotle cheese grits. Huevos con chorizo, con mole, a la Mexicana or rancheros. Or try the pancake sandwich (stuffed with fried eggs and bacon, topped with goat cheese-corn sauce).

local tip: All margaritas are made-to-order with freshly squeezed lemons and limes. No mixes here!

Sit inside or out on the large patio.

local tip: The famous fried rice is a crowd-pleaser.

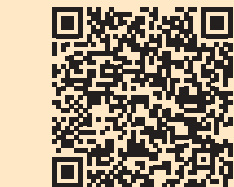
