





1. Defining the brief

The journey begins with a conversation and preferably a meeting to discuss your project in broad terms, your ideas in respect of style, timings and budgets. We would also try to establish what you expect of us, whether you are looking for full turnkey supply, or a reduced scope of works. We would also give you our initial thoughts for the next steps.




3. Personalised Presentations

Our next step is prepare computer presentations of our product design ideas, incorporating a number of options for your consideration. The presentations will include bespoke items which our team will design and show as computer renderings, alongside branded items from our large library of approved suppliers.

4. Concept, Design and Sampling


At this stage the presentations may go back and forth between the client and ourselves a number of times to ensure that the client is getting exactly the feel and design on board the yacht that they wished for. Concept and design will be refined along the way. At this point we will also begin gathering samples in support of the presentations.







We will immediately begin refining our proposals, ensuring always perfect product co-ordination. At this point, if requested, we will prepare detailed Bills of Quantity and we will also begin gathering samples in support of the presentations. As this process continues we will be in contact with our manufacturers of branded products and the factories and craftspeople who will produce any bespoke items to ensure that manufacturing and supply is possible within your timeframe. There will inevitably be discussions concerning cost at this stage which may lead to the substitution of some specific items in the proposal. We prefer that this happens now rather than on submission of our detailed final Quotation.

6. Ordering

Our procurement department works closely with your Project Manager and our design team to ensure that all product details are correct before ordering. In the case of bespoke product, the ordering process will often require a visit to the factory or craftspeople to demonstrate the specific details of the product and discuss any technical issues that may arise. This is all part of our service and is non-chargeable.

7. Quality Control, Packing and Delivery

All products pass through our warehouse on the outskirts of London, where our final quality control checks are performed. We will then pack your order in the most convenient way for you – usually grouped on a room-by-room basis for ease of unpacking. We always provide a detailed Packing List which cross-refers to the final Quotation. Our logistics people will arrange delivery in accordance with your instructions.

8. After Sales Support

We will always be available for any support you may require whether it be a query concerning product maintenance or re-ordering. We archive our files, presentations, drawings and templates so we are able to retrieve details of your previous orders if required.
