My favorite is Apostle Paul and the Book of Philippians because it is written as an encouragement and reminder to be like Christ.

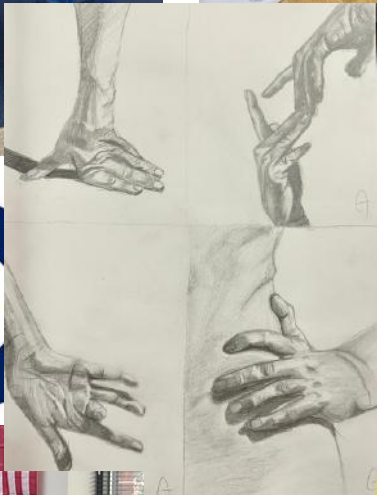
What is one message you'd like to tell our HRC students?

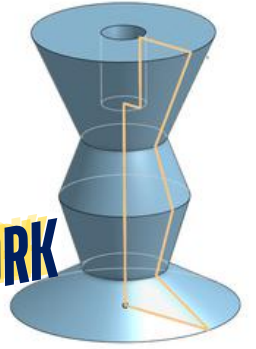
Announcement:
