### WHEN TO GO

Thailand's weather is warm year-round with two distinct seasons throughout the year: hot or rainy. The peak tourist season, and best time to visit, is November through to February when it rains the least, temperatures are slightly cooler, and the seas are generally calm, blue and more pleasant for swimming in; this is also the main season for many festivals.

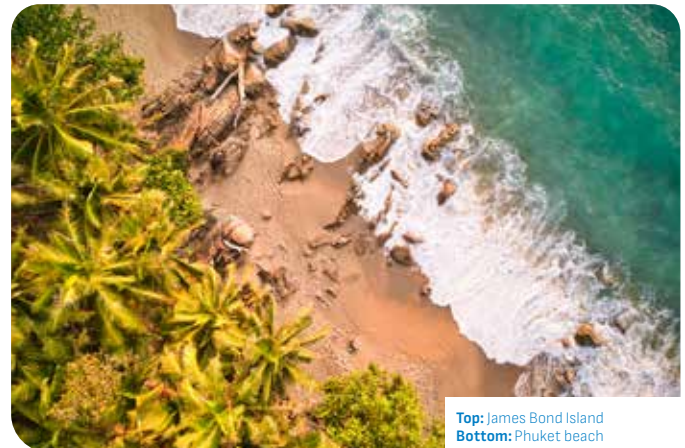

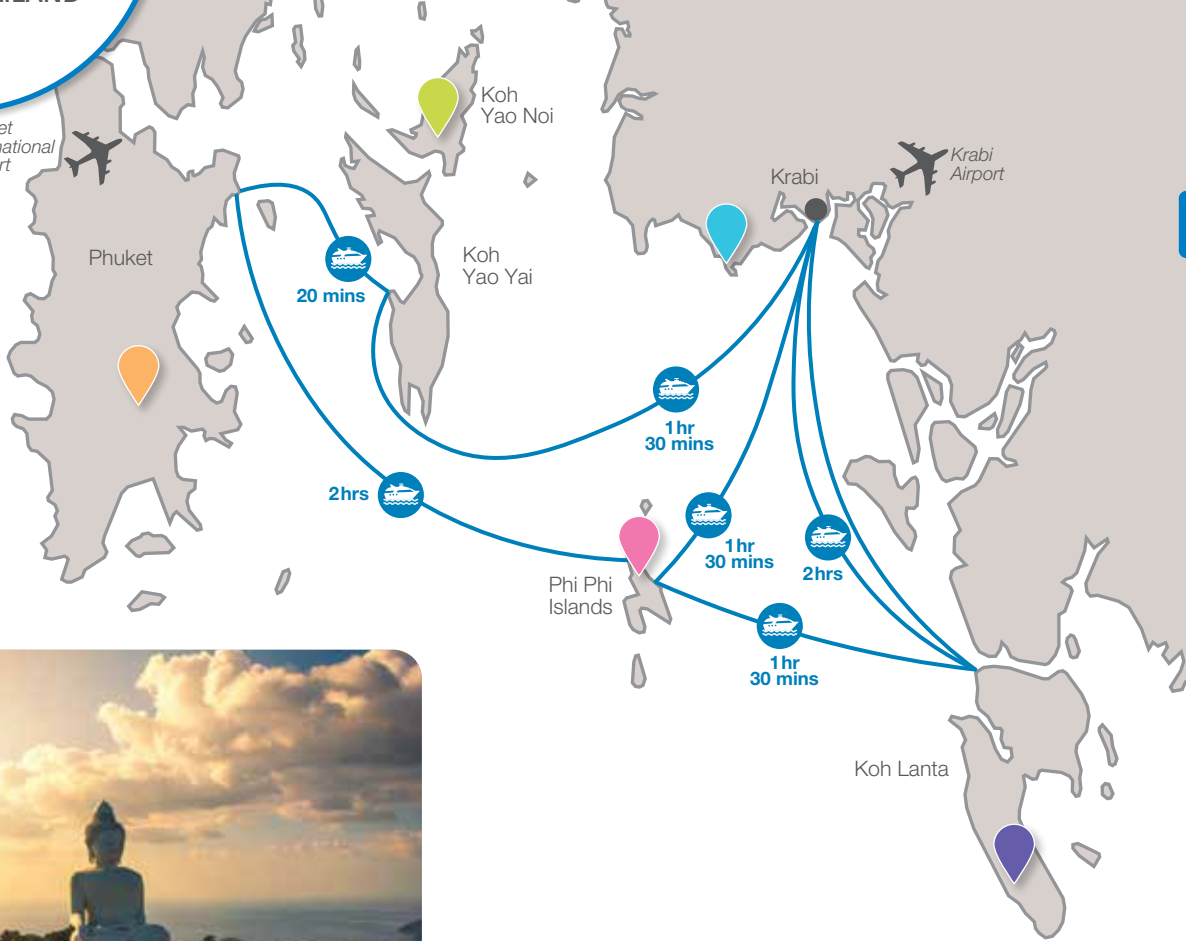

### Shopping & Markets

Bangkok is a bargain hunter's delight, don't miss the Chatuchak Weekend Market or the Patpong Night Market. The famous MBK shopping centre boasts over 2000 shops occupying several floors – you will always find what you're looking for.



### Canal & River Cruise

Bangkok is often referred to as the "Venice of the East" with its great canal waterway system and the Chao Phraya River. One of the easiest ways to see the city is by a day cruise, or even consider a relaxing dinner cruise at night.

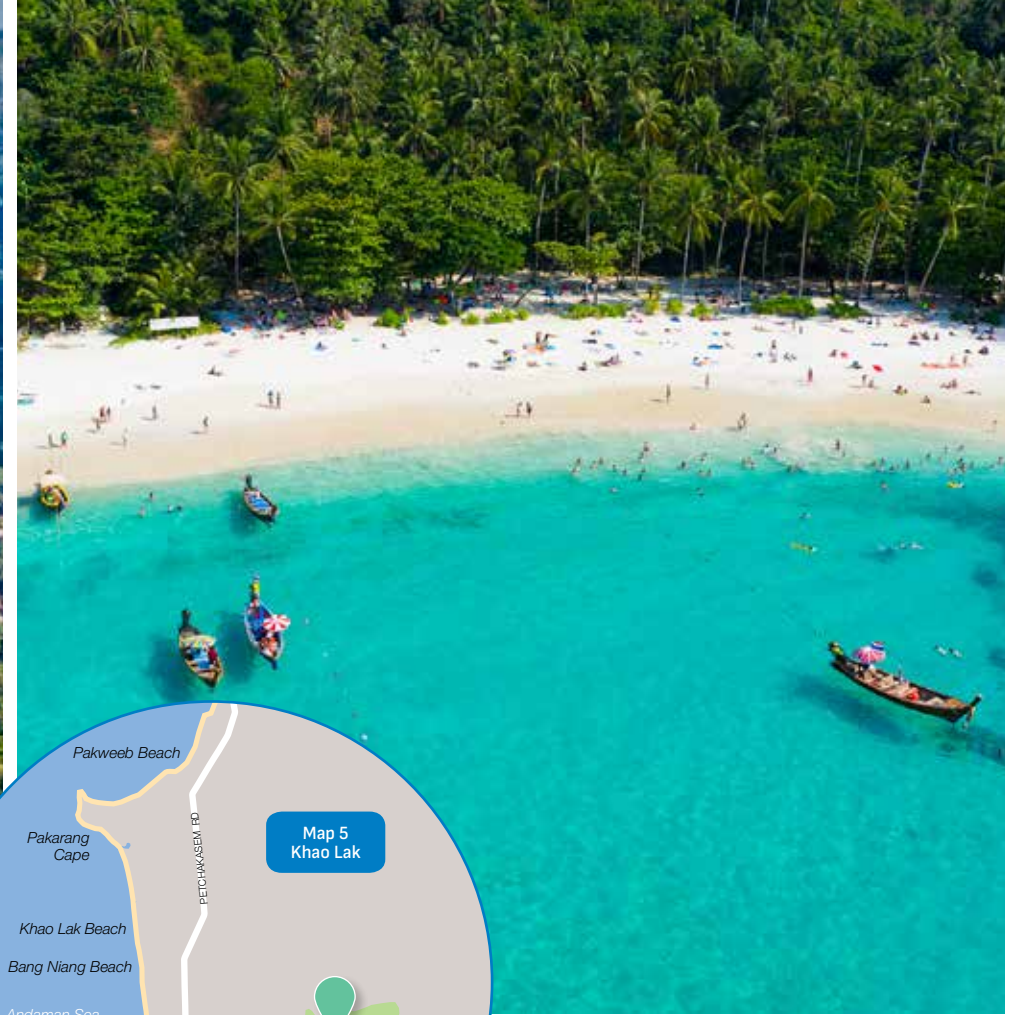

### WHEN TO GO

The climate in Vietnam varies greatly from the north to south with three distinct climatic zones; therefore, there is no one ideal time to visit the country as a whole. Due to the tropical monsoon season, the peak travel time for the north and south is between September and March, while the beaches of central Vietnam are very busy from May to August.

Cambodia can be visited at any time of year. The ideal months are December and January, when humidity levels are relatively low with little rainfall. This is also peak season when tourist numbers are at their highest.
