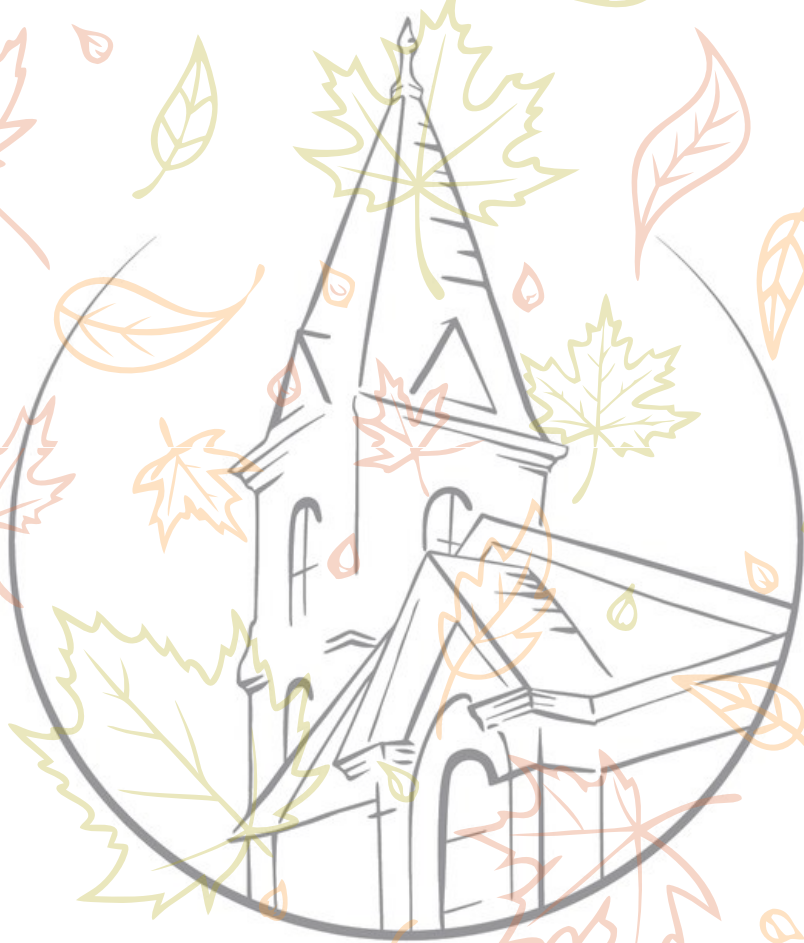

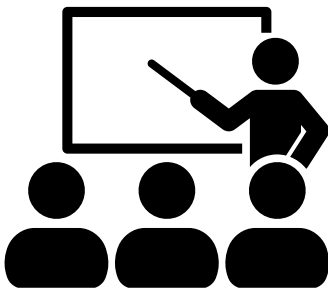


## NEW MEMBER CLASS!

# MUSIC MINISTRY

## Praise Team

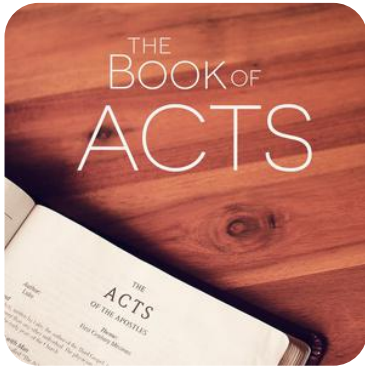

## JOY SCOUTS



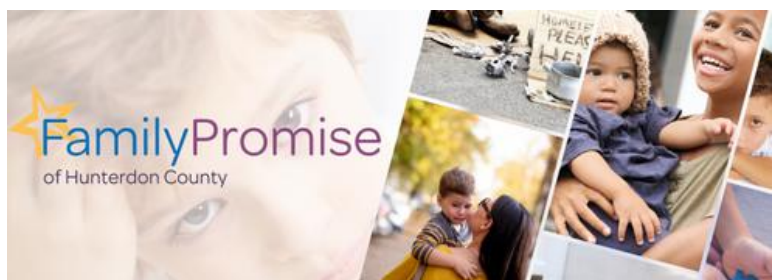

## BINGO @ COUNTRY ARCH CARE CENTER

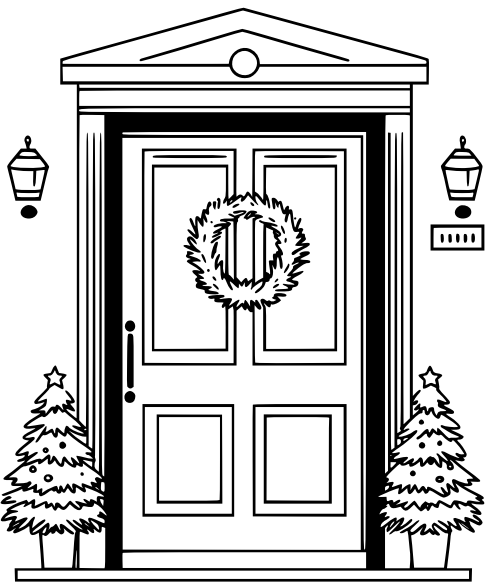
