Getting to know God and being able to call on Him is the most important step in storing up for the storms.



In the past few months BAT has been incredibly busy... I would like to share with you the stories of some of those we are working with but at BAT we do not believe in posterizing those we help. We don't share their stories to entice people to give or see what we are doing. What I can share is that each day we get to make a difference in the lives of those who need hope.

- We have utilized our newly formed private investigation agency to conduct research on traffickers.
- We have been able to provide education assistance for a young woman for the next year.
- We continue to work with close to 300 kids who have gone through being trafficked.
- We have been able to partner with two new foster homes that house children who have been trafficked.
- We have conducted outreaches in Texas, South Carolina and at the end of the month in Virginia. Raising awareness and creating powerful partnerships.
- We are preparing to be on a nationwide Podcast.
- In June we will hold an online training program. (See our website for details)
- We also continue to see those who are battling sex addiction and some who have been arrested as predators (this takes an act of grace as you can imagine).

There have been times we were able to partner with individuals to help them get out of the life, times where we have provided training throughout the United States and world via Zoom, and each day we see the miracles of God in our midst.

Henry Blackaby in his excellent workbook, "Experiencing God," says that one of the ways you can discover what God would have you do (is not looking at smoke from a chimney) rather it is looking around and seeing where God is moving and then joining Him in that movement.

At BAT we look around and continually see Him moving and we are in amazement and wonder. We are humbled to be used of God, and we are determined to give our all to be His hands and feet.

Thank you for your partnership. Your prayers, giving, support and care mean a lot to us and to those we partner with as they move forward with hope, healing and renewal.

At its inception, the bike was intended to have a limited lifespan. Instead, the Fat Boy motorcycle has spanned three powertrain generations and a complete redesign of its Softail® chassis and for 35 years has maintained its original power to impress with unmatched presence and undeniable style.









HISTORY OF AN INSTANT ICON

In 1990, a time when the motorcycle media and much of the riding public was consumed with the escalating performance of sport bikes, the Harley-Davidson® Fat Boy model landed like a thundering heavymetal power chord.

The Fat Boy model was inspired by a custom Harley® motorcycle based on the Softail® platform created in 1987 at Harley-Davidson Montréal by the dealership general manager Duc Dufour and technician Denis Lavoie, which they called a Lowboy. That bike featured slammed rear suspension, an aluminum disc wheel and fiberglass fender on the front and a wide handlebar. Spotted by Harley-Davidson Executive Jerry Wilke, an example was shipped to Milwaukee. While the Lowboy custom offered some inspiration, the motorcycle that would become the Fat Boy model was created by the H-D styling team led by Willie G. Davidson and Louie Netz. "On the 1990 Fat Boy model, the wheels are the defining characteristic," wrote Davidson in his book 100 Years of Harley-Davidson. "The idea was to create a distinctive look using solid-cast disc wheels. We pushed this distinction further with a silver monochromatic paint job and silver powder-coated frame. Since the entire bike was silver, we needed something bright to set it off. I added yellow trim to the rocker boxes, the derby cover, the timer cover, and the ignition switch. We built a Fat Boy prototype, and I took it to Daytona so we would get one-onone feedback from the riders." Only Harley-Davidson would have the chutzpah to name a motorcycle Fat Boy.

I Left New Age for/


For more than 10 years, I was entrenched in mysticism and self-discovery. I practiced witchcraft and performed spells. 

Hollywood Dave: What happens when road conditions cause a crash?

Rob the Shark: Love that question, Dave! You know, we always have to prove who's at fault for an accident. We have to show that somebody was negligent. What caused that road condition to be dangerous? Was it the rain from the night before? Was it the county workers that forgot to cover a hazard? That's our job. That's where we step in to identify and find out what was wrong with that road condition, how did it become dangerous? So, once we are able to identify the party at fault, we then put our game plan together and, rest assured, if that party was responsible for that road condition, and you go down as a result of it and get injured, we're going to be going after them.

Hollywood Dave: What happens to my bike after an accident?

Rob the Shark: As soon as you go down (God forbid you do, but it happens to all of us), the officers will call in a tow company. It's not like you can call AAA and have the bike taken to where you want it to go. The city is going to pick up the bike and take it to one of their tow yards, where it's going to incur \$70, \$80 sometimes \$90 per day, each and every day that it is sitting there. So, while you're at the hospital trying to figure out what's going on with yourself and you start thinking about your bike, a week goes by, and you still don't know what's going on. In the meantime, the bike is incurring costs the whole time it is at the tow yard. Now your somewhere around \$800 to \$900 in one week (maybe more, maybe a less) in storage fees and you have to come up with that money to get it out. Until you pay it, that bill continues to go up. Before you know it, 10 days go by, and you get a notice of lien. Before you know it, your bike is sold. With Shark Law, we step in well before that happens. So, while you're at the hospital taking care of yourself, we take the burden off of you. We contact CHP or the appropriate police department, we find out where the bike is at, and we make sure it's out of there as soon as possible so that it's put either at your home or a shop of your choice where the owners are not going to charge you for impound fees or storage costs. We understand that we've got to take care of you, but we know your bike is important to you as well, and it's also important to us.

Hollywood Dave: As Shark Law's clients, do we have to find our own doctors?

Rob the Shark: You don't have to find your own doctor. Of course, if you have a doctor you prefer to go to, go for it - but that's our job. Our job is to coordinate your medical treatment. Softail Swing Arm

Is there some lubrication or greasing needed for the Softail swing arm?

It is good to apply a light wipe of anti-seize on the pivot shaft to help prevent rust and for ease of assembly.

Wide Glide Neck Issue

I have a 2001 HD Dyna FXDWG with what they call a wide glide knock in the neck area. Have been told it's a common thing for a Dyna. Is there any cure for this?

What you describe typically occurs when the neck adjustment is extremely loose or when the fuel tank is loose.

Velocity Stack

Can I run a velocity stack on stock bike without problems? (2007 Harley FXDWGI)

Velocity stacks typically suck more dust & debris into your motor if the air is not filtered in any way. You will get less longevity out of your motor. Also, be careful where you park. It is easy for someone to flick something in the stack that will cause immediate catastrophic damage.

Transmission Oil Level

Hi. I have a 2008 Road King Police (FLHP) and after every ride, there's a quarter-size oil drop just below the primary case, near the drain plug. When I checked the transmission oil level, it was low so I changed it and filled it full. So, I'm thinking maybe a shifter or transmission case seal. Before I do any unnecessary work, can you tell me how to systematically diagnose and troubleshoot such an oil leak? Tips and tricks?

First, it is important that you check transmission oil level per your manual, some models and years are with the motorcycle upright & level and some on jiffy stand. If you overfilled the transmission case the excessive oil may be flowing out through the transmission vent. This might be the oil that you are seeing on the ground. Otherwise, start simple. Make sure that the oil is not leaking from the derby or outer primary cover gaskets. If none of these, your leak might be orientating from an inner primary seal or transfer seal.

Starting and Stalling

I have a 01 FLHTCUI with over 40,000 miles with an issue of starting and stalling. It always starts easily when cold and idles well, but after a few minutes, if I'm idling awhile to get out of my driveway, the idle will fall, and the engine will threaten to stall. If it does stall it's hard to get started again, I have to give it a little throttle to get it to start and stay running. After I've been riding for a while and the engine warms up it will idle stronger and is usually fine, but once in a while when I start from a stop sign or light it will stall, and I'll have to give it some throttle to start and idle up. Of course, it never does it when the dealer has it. I also find that in warm weather it's better to let the engine cool for 5 or 10 minutes after a stop before I start it again. All in all, it's a strong running bike and this is usually just a minor annoyance, still if there's a quick fix I'd love to hear it. Thanks -Bob

Bob, the most common reason a m/c will act this way is because of an intake leak. Start the bike cold. Mist the intake flanges with brake cleaner. If your bike's idle drops, or the engine stalls, you have an intake leak. If this is the case, replace the intake seals along with the front & rear intake flanges. If the bike passes the intake test; have the dealer or your mechanic scan the m/c for possible codes. You may need to replace your ET (engine temp sensor), TP (throttle position sensor), or your IAC (idle air control sensor). Thanks for the question and good luck. w
