- [2] Morgan Academy's Lauren Rutherford made her first career field goal in a game against Wilcox Academy last week, and she's handled the team's kicking duties for the last two seasons.
- [3] All three female kickers Rutherford, Lee's Kenysha Coulson, and St. Clair County freshman Kylee Harrell have made extra points this season.
- [4] Coulson, Harrell, and Rutherford continue the legacy of female kickers in Alabama. In 1939 and 1940, Luverne "Toad" Wise Albert kicked for Escambia County High in Atmore. She is believed to be the first girl to play high school football in the United States.
