Climate Careers 2022 Statistics

- 94% of the 38 youth Energy Assistants employed in 2022, Climate Careers was their first green job
- 100% youth came from low-income households
- 92% of youth reported an increase in professional skill development
- 43% of youth plan on ontinuing to work in the clean economy

Opportunity Build 2022 Statistics

- 57 participants enrolled in OB
- 86% of participants graduated
- 71% of graduates have begun jobs or further training
- 100% came from low-income households
- 84% self-identified as people of color
- 63% self-identified as women or nonbinary
- 39%were justice system impacted individuals

Why We Do This/ Why Consider

- Opportunity; second chances
- The perspective, experience that both groups bring is enriching
- It's diversifying to the workforce
- Both groups are a pipeline to untapped talent, that aren't always exposed to this type of work or given the opportunity
