Dear Cat Island Club Members,

Summer has arrived and we are entering into the “Dogs days” of the season. The golf course is in great condition. Be sure to take advantage of our Guest Day on July 11th, as green fees will be waived and cart fees applied where applicable. Our guest days are a wonderful opportunity to showcase Cat Island Club and all the benefits membership can offer individuals and families.



Our Wednesday Junior Clinic series is going wonderfully, and our second session of summer camp begins on July 15th–18th; it’s going to be a blast! Ladies and Gentlemen, please remember to schedule your season long match play rounds by the provided deadlines. Keep an eye out for more tournaments and programming throughout the summer months. We can’t wait to see you at the club!

THE PRO’S PUTTING TIP:

Stay Steady on Short Putts, especially in the heat: Think from the ground up, not from the top down. You’ve probably been told to keep your head still on short putts, and that’s good advice. Here’s another way to stabilize your body/head so the putter face remains square through impact: Put pressure on the instep of your front foot before you begin the stroke. This allows your shoulders, arms, and hands to work on a consistent track. If your weight moves back toward your front heel on the down stroke, your whole body is twisting open, causing the putter face to close. This common problem is often a product of turning to see where the ball is rolling to. Concentrate on keeping weight on your front instep throughout, and you’ll have a stable base to make more three and four footers.

Below are some important tips to keep you cool and comfortable in the Summer Sun!

1. STAY HYDRATED:

- Drink plenty of fluids, especially water, before, during, and after your round.
- Consider adding electrolytes to your drinks, like sports drinks or supplements.
- Avoid caffeinated or alcoholic beverages, which can dehydrate you.

2. DRESS APPROPRIATELY:

- Wear lightweight, breathable, and moisture-wicking clothing.
- Opt for light colors, which absorb less heat.
- Consider sun wear sleeves or even pants for sun protection, but choose breathable materials.
- Apply sunscreen liberally and reapply throughout your round.

3. ADJUST YOUR PACE AND SWING:

- Take frequent breaks and find shade when possible.
- Consider using a cart.
- Moderate your swing speed and focus on fluidity over power to conserve energy.

4. BE AWARE OF HEAT-RELATED ILLNESSES:

- Recognize the signs of heat exhaustion and heatstroke, such as dizziness, nausea, and rapid heartbeat.
- Seek medical attention immediately if you suspect you or someone else is experiencing a heat-related illness.

5. OTHER TIPS:

- Consider playing at an earlier time to avoid the hottest part of the day.
- Use a cooling towel to help regulate your body temperature.
- Consider bringing a personal fan or use the refreshment towels (in ice) provided by the club.

By following these tips, you can enjoy a round of golf in oppressive heat while staying safe and comfortable.

Greetings,

Summer is always such a crucial time here at Cat Island Club. We finally have caught up on rain, so in turn we are trying to catch up on mowing grass. Traffic on the course, at the pool, and around the club is always growing. Therefore, we must accelerate our pace and complete our work in a timely fashion to keep things running smoothly. One of the most crucial practices we perform over the summer is greens aerification (July 28-31). We will be pulling cores from the greens, repeating the same practice from previous years. Core aerification is an important practice that involves the removal of material from the greens surface and profile, aiding in drainage and air flow, while also relieving compaction. We will then topdress (cover greens with sand), fertilize, and water the greens. Upon completion, we begin easing the greens back into a normal maintenance pattern of mowing and rolling, while also being conscious of aiding the greens in recovering from aerification.

The course will be closed for the days of aerification to allow us to complete this process in a timely fashion.
