I have this lemon tree in my front yard that belonged to my husband's 98 year old grandfather. It was in a pot for years, and before he died he gave it to my husband but not without saying, "David, you better not plant that thing in the ground. It needs to stay in a pot so you can drag it into the house during the winter." Despite this warning, one summer after PawPaw died, I convinced my husband to plant the lemon tree in the ground. For a while it grew, but one day in the early fall my husband trimmed the tree too far back and cut it below "the root stock." We thought he had ruined the plant, preventing it from producing buds and fruit. For 5 years my husband has carefully tended to this lemon tree. The leaves and branches continue to stretch to the sky, and the tree has exploded, but no lemons. Last year my husband was outside watering the tree when we saw one flower. That one flower has turned into 70. The tree has exploded in productivity, and this year after faithful pruning and tender care, we will have a basket full of yellow lemons.

The children of Mercy Christian remind me of this lemon tree. They are not meant to be planted in a tiny pot. They are meant to be planted by God in the expansive ground where their roots can grow down deep and they can be nourished by God. Each day the teachers and I skillfully plan our lessons, giving our students the best education possible. As a small school, we are able to see and care for each child individually. We are building and maintaining a beautiful school, and our students are exploding in vibrant curiosity and learning. Throughout this Year in Review you will see pictures and hear stories of students and families who are thrilled with the education they are receiving. Mercy Christian is a place of immense growth because we are all being nurtured and cared for by the great gardner, God himself. Come and see our many fruits.

FROM MERCY PARENTS:

It brings me great peace and excitement to watch my children flourish at MCA. They are becoming who God intends them to be, which is one of the greatest joys a parent could have. In that way, I see MCA and its teachers and curriculum as partners with me in my parenting. The school has also been very generous with scholarships to our family.

Mercy has been a blessing in our lives. Our daughter finished her second year at school, and each year has impacted us in different ways. I believe this year God has touched our hearts, and my daughter's desire to know more about God, how we can love Him and praise Him, has been incredible. When we joined Mercy, we did have a relationship with God, but it wasn't as deep. Seeing how God has impacted our daughter's life, her love for God, and her understanding of what the Bible says about many topics has pushed us to seek God more as a family.

My children have found a community at the school that they have been unable to find or maintain elsewhere. I'm so grateful to see my children belong somewhere and be embraced as they are. I'm grateful for the administration and teachers who act as shepherds for this community, making sure it is safe, encouraging, creative, and challenging.

Mercy has provided a community in which our daughter can grapple with the realities of life and grow in a safe, Christ-centered community that we trust.

Our child used to be a perfectionist in many things. This year, we have learned that God loves us as we are and that He is strengthened in our weaknesses. We don't need to be the best at everything for God to love us; God is glorified in our weaknesses, and our strength comes from Him. To God goes all the glory and honor for our achievements.

My daughter has always struggled with anxiety and lack of confidence. MCA and its consistent, firm love has helped her to grow in assurance and confidence so that she can use the gifts God has given her.

Our son is more confident and less anxious.


I am constantly surprised how much my children know about the Bible. Not only do they know Bible facts about people and events, they are being taught a full worldview, seeing the world through God's eyes. They have a hunger for God, constantly asking questions and making observations and connections that are rare for children their age. They understand the gospel! I know MCA has been a big part of this spiritual growth.

After a family crisis in the fall of 2024 which exposed our deep need for help, Mercy was one of the primary ways that the Lord met us and provided for us as we struggled to care for and educate our own children.

Mercy has given our child a community outside of her family, but in unity with her family, to continue growing and developing in healthy ways. Our daughter regularly speaks of spiritual lessons that she has learned from school. She reads much stronger than she did when she began; I see Mercy as a vital part of this.

MCA has fulfilled my greatest academic hopes for my children - to give them a love of learning. They are endlessly curious, observing life and nature and people and constantly asking questions to understand. Although they are challenged at the school, it is in a way that reinforces rather than stifles the love of learning.

Before MCA, my son would get bored and misbehave when he was not challenged or things were too easy. Thankfully, the school's curriculum keeps him challenged and engaged, and the teachers have a structured, disciplined environment that keeps him engaged and on task.



Our child has excelled in all subjects and has impressed us most with reading. The methods MCA uses to teach reading far surpass what was being taught to him in his last school. He caught on quickly and now is able to enjoy reading! He went from "needing intervention" in his local public school to A's and B's (on-level) in reading and math!

Our daughter has learned to read in such a short amount of time!

My child has transformed from someone who struggled to enjoy school and merely got through the day to a student who loves learning and is thriving in every aspect of life. He is calmer, kinder, more confident, growing spiritually, and excelling academically. Thanks to the love and support of the MCA staff and their exceptional teaching methods, my child is flourishing. We feel truly blessed to be part of the MCA community.

Our son has grown greatly spiritually. He has a much better understanding of the Bible and has found comfort in the power of prayer.

After teaching in public school for 11 years, I struggled with the system's focus on test scores over children. Students who were struggling were passed along, ready or not. Those facing family tragedies were still expected to take mandated tests. Teachers taught to the test, and children got a mere 10-15 minute break daily. Burn-out and anxiety were common, and my heart was broken. I knew God was leading me elsewhere, but I wasn't sure where.

Then, God showed me Mercy Christian Academy. My first visit was life-changing. I loved the restful learning environment, free from test-driven anxiety. Students are encouraged to use their imaginations, creativity, and unique gifts. Small groups allow teachers to meet students at their actual learning level, and we're supported to genuinely care about their lives. We pray together, encourage each other, and love one another. Students have time to be kids, not robots.

God's guidance to MCA was clear. The switch from public to private school was intimidating, with some benefits lost, but God provided answers for my concerns. He gave me a community of like-minded people who teach not just academics but God's truth and love. When struggles arise, my work family supports, loves, and prays with me.

MCA has taught me to slow down and appreciate God's creation. I'm rested and excited to come to school daily. Students aren't test scores but whole persons made in God's likeness. We help them grow academically and spiritually. I get to know them through card games, recess, or creating art together, witnessing their unique gifts. The Lord is doing amazing things at MCA every day!

PICTURE STUDY

At Mercy Christian Academy, our Picture Study program, inspired by Charlotte Mason, invites students to immerse themselves in the world of great art, fostering a deep appreciation for beauty and truth. Each year, students focus on a handful of artists, quietly observing masterpieces, narrating their insights, and engaging in thoughtful discussions. This gentle yet powerful approach helps them internalize art, building a mental gallery that enriches their lives. As Charlotte Mason beautifully expressed, "We cannot measure the influence that one or another artist has upon the child's sense of beauty... he is enriched more than we know in having really looked at a single picture" (Simply Charlotte Mason). Through this practice, students develop sharp observation and concentration skills, essential for academic success, particularly in disciplines like science, while cultivating a taste for what is good, true, and beautiful in a world often filled with distractions.

The spiritual dimension of Picture Study sets it apart, connecting students to the divine through art. Russ Ramsey captures this, noting, "We are the only creatures who engage in behaviors purely for encountering beauty... hungering to see the glory of God" (Rembrandt Is in the Wind). Similarly, Lilias Trotter reflects, "The true artist is the one who lets the beauty of Jesus be seen through his work" (Parables of the Cross). By exploring the works of artists like Giotto di Bondone, Diego Velázquez, or Zaha Hadid in a nurturing environment, students freely share ideas and explore divine beauty. We are grateful to our donors and volunteers who make this enriching experience possible. Through Picture Study, we nurture students' souls, equipping them to see God's world with wonder and discernment.
