We talked to Lina Martin, the owner of Upstate Janitorial Solutions, a local cleaning and organizing business, to get her expert advice on the best practices for organizing a messy closet for summer. With years of experience helping clients achieve tidy and functional spaces, Lina shared some invaluable tips.

1. Declutter and Store Winter Items:

"Start by removing all your winter clothes and accessories," Lina advises. "Pack them away in labeled storage bins or vacuum-sealed bags to free up space. This makes it easier to see and access your summer wardrobe."



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tie Liele Black Dress



The term "little black dress" (LBD) was popularized by the iconic fashion designer Coco Chanel in the 1920s. Chanel introduced the LBD as a versatile and affordable piece, breaking away from the expensive and color-heavy fashion of the time. Her design featured a simple, elegant silhouette that could be dressed up or down, making it accessible to women from all walks of life. The LBD was first showcased in an illustration in Vogue in 1926, where it was described as "Chanel's Ford," likening its simplicity and accessibility to the Model T Ford.

One of the most notable moments that cemented the LBD's iconic status was when Princess Diana wore a stunning black off-the-shoulder dress designed by Christina Stambolian in 1994. The dress, often referred to as the "Revenge Dress," was worn by Diana on the night Prince Charles publicly admitted to infidelity. The bold and elegant choice not only captured global media attention but also symbolized empowerment and resilience. This moment in fashion history highlighted the LBD's ability to convey both sophistication and strength, further embedding it into the cultural consciousness as a symbol of timeless elegance and grace.
