## ARJUN ( 24 YEARS OLD)

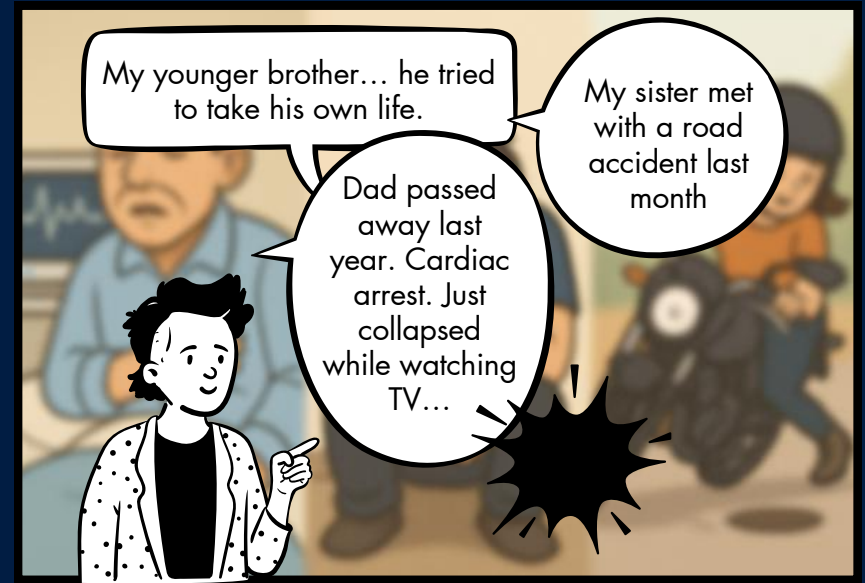
A young man facing grief and confusion after facing multiple personal tragedies. Caught between cultural beliefs and uncomfortable truths, trying to understand why everything went wrong.


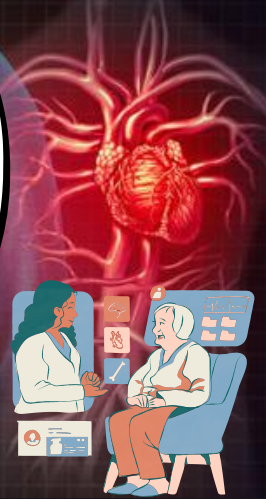
Arjun... I know losing your dad was sudden. But cardiac arrests don't come out of nowhere

India is getting sicker, younger. Heart attacks in their 30s. Diabetes in their 20s

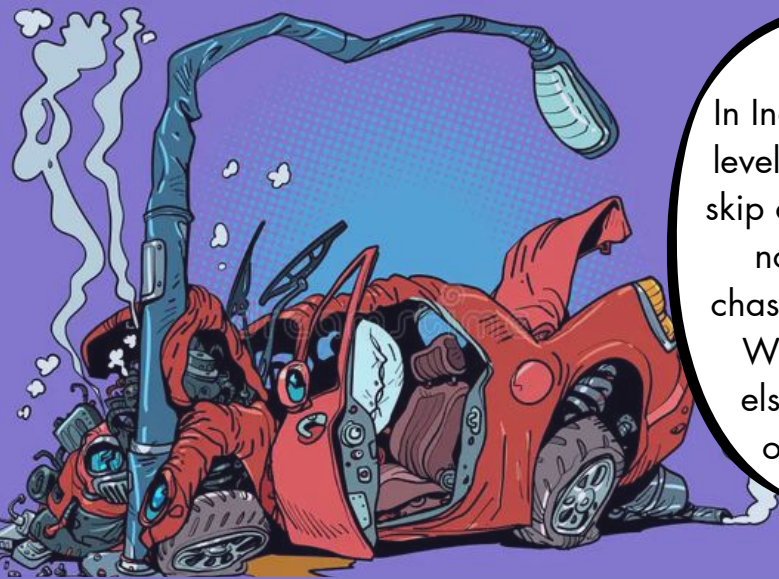


Depression isn't weakness. It's a medical condition — chemical imbalance, trauma, chronic stress. Just like fever, it needs diagnosis and care.

Arjun... what your brother went through isn't rare. Depression affects millions, but most suffer in silence

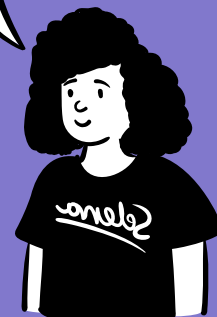




In India, most entry-level bikes and cars skip critical safety — no ABS, weak chassis, no airbags. What's standard elsewhere is still optional here

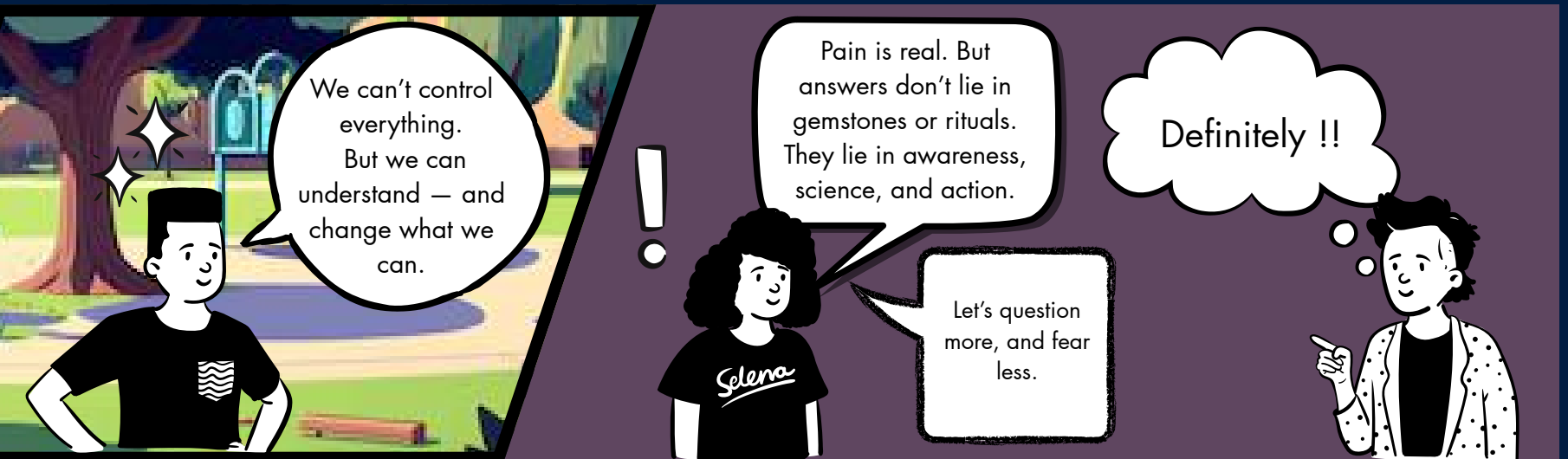
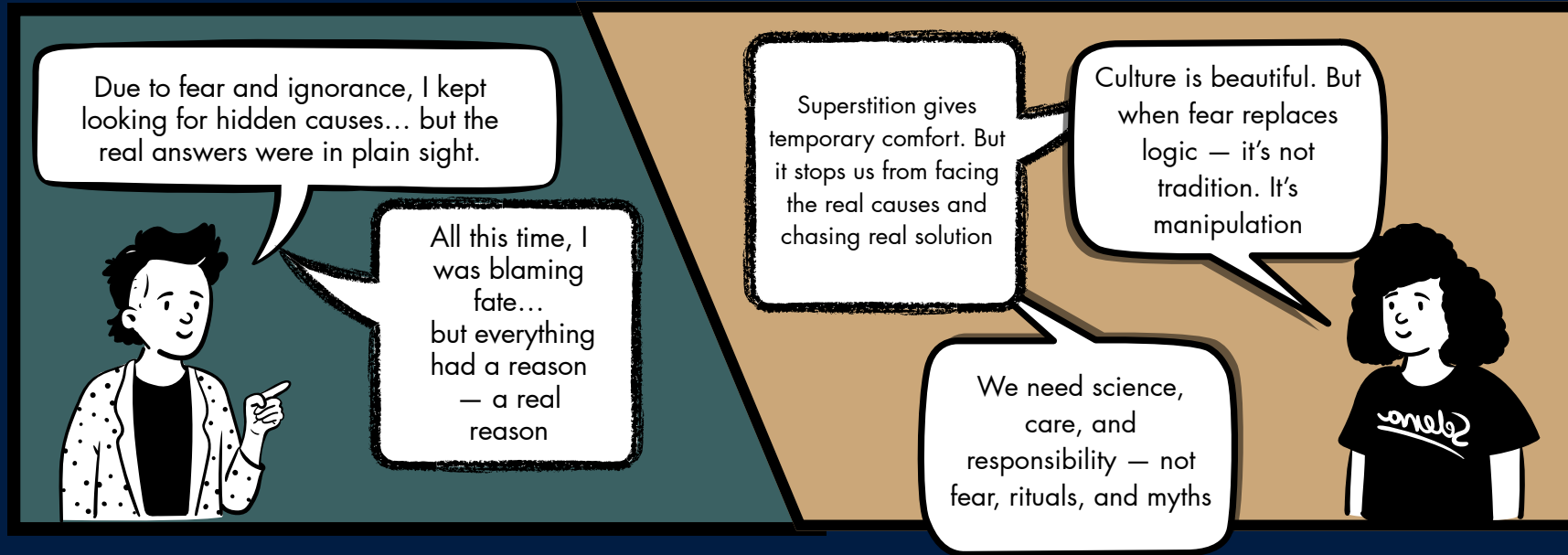
