99% of vapes contain nicotine, an addictive neurotoxin that is considered acute hazardous waste by the EPA. Nicotine is poisonous if ingested and fatal to humans and pets in low doses.

Worse, vapes do not biodegrade and leach toxic chemicals into our ecosystem, like nicotine, heavy metals, lead, and plastics. With millions of vapes being improperly discarded each year, they pose a significant threat to our environment.

Safe Disposal

Here's how to get rid of your own vape:



The entire vape, with the lithium-ion battery still attached, should be placed in a sealed plastic bag.



Then, take the bagged vape and e-liquids to your local household hazardous waste facility, along with pesticides, fertilizers, poisons, and anti-freeze. Liquid nicotine can't go down the drain, toilet, or sewer drains!
