If you have walkie-talkies, **please refrain from using channel 2.0 and channel 4.0**, as these are reserved for official camp use.

Curfew/quiet time is from 11pm to 6am every day. Please be respectful of those who need their rest. Also, **please be respectful of those that are cleaning the washrooms during the designated cleaning times.**

Every vehicle brought on-site needs to be registered and needs to display a vehicle tag.

Please note, there is no lifeguard on duty this year. Swimming is at your own risk. Make sure children are supervised at the beach.



Join Us for Prayer!

The prayer team is inviting you to join them in the prayer chapel. They will be gathering to pray **every morning from 6-7 am**. We encourage you to stop by for a quiet little chat with the Lord. His peace is waiting for you!

Policies

Parents are responsible for their children at all times. **No one under 18 should be on the campground without a parent/guardian.**

Parental supervision is required at all times when children are playing on the playground. The playground closes 15 minutes after *Afterglow* concludes.

It is preferred that pets remain at home or at a kennel. If pets are brought on the campgrounds, we have a PET POLICY that must be adhered to. **Every pet/dog owner/sitter must sign an agreement contract** and obtain pet tags during registration at the camp office. **There will be a charge of \$26 per pet.**

As a spiritual retreat for Christians, **the use of tobacco, alcohol, and harmful drugs on the campground is prohibited.**

A \$10 CASH deposit is required at check-in for barracks, youth cabins, and division building keys. It is a \$10 deposit per key. The deposit will be refunded when you return your key(s) prior to departure.

Use of air conditioners in cabins/trailers puts a strain on the electrical system. **There is a charge of \$30.00 for use during camp meeting time.** We do not supply air conditioners.

Fire and electrical safety must be FIRST and foremost in all of our minds. **Fires are not allowed in any of our cabins.** In order to avoid overloading our circuits, a maximum of 2 (two) items per outlet.

Due to the dry conditions, **open fires are not permitted on the campgrounds unless approved by Administration.**

It is recommended that every family has their own first aid kits. We provide minor first aid treatment and we will help assess the next steps in medical treatments.

There are a number of people on the campground who are sensitive to scented products or aerosols. Please be mindful of what you wear and use.



Pet Policy

1. Pets are the responsibility of their owners.
2. **Pets are to be on a leash at all times** when outside the cabin, trailer, tent etc.
3. **Pets are not to be left tied outside** if the owner is absent from the area.
4. **Pet owners are responsible for the noise of their pets** and are to bring them under control or remove them from the campgrounds.
5. **Pets are to be on a leash if taken for a walk** and it is encouraged that the walk should not be among the campers on the campground but off campus.
6. **Pet droppings are to be picked up immediately using a plastic bag**, on and especially off campus, on neighbor's property and road.
7. **Pets are not allowed to be in any washroom facility.** There will be a designated outside tap for washing, rinsing your pet off. Please bring your own biodegradable pet shampoo.
8. Pets should only be walked or exercised **by those who are able to control them.**
9. **Only service animals are allowed in public buildings** such as the main auditorium, cafeteria, division buildings, etc.

Disciplinary Action

A violation of any of the pet rules, will result with disciplinary action.

- First offense will be issued a verbal or written warning,
- **Subsequent offenses may require stricter action, up to pet removal from the campgrounds,**
- **Any pet that attacks another animal or a person will be expected to be removed immediately,**
- Any concerns may be brought to the attention of the camp personnel.

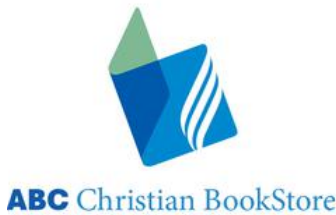
