
We wish to advise you of the establishment of the Scheme to be operated as a limited network payment arrangement to be operated between the Letsbuyhealthcare Co-operative Society (the "Society") for the benefit of its members and Letsbuyhealthcare Limited (the "Issuer"), whereby it is envisaged that members of the Society may purchase payment vouchers from Letsbuyhealthcare Limited (the "Company") in denominations of €50 each to be used by members in purchasing healthcare benefits from a limited network of healthcare providers, as agreed from time to time.

It is intended that the Scheme will operate exclusively in the State within the parameters of Regulation 4(1)(k) of the EU (Payment Services) Regulations 2018, (as amended, the "Regulations"). As and when the annual turnover of the Scheme exceeds €1,000,000, we propose to register with the CBI in compliance with Regulation 45.

By virtue of the Company's engagement in issuing and administering other means of payment within the provisions of Schedule 2 of the Criminal Justice (Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing) Act, 2020 as amended (the "Act") we wish to register the Company with the CBI and for this purpose we wish to advise that Mr David Allen, CEO of the Company has registered with the CBI online portal.
