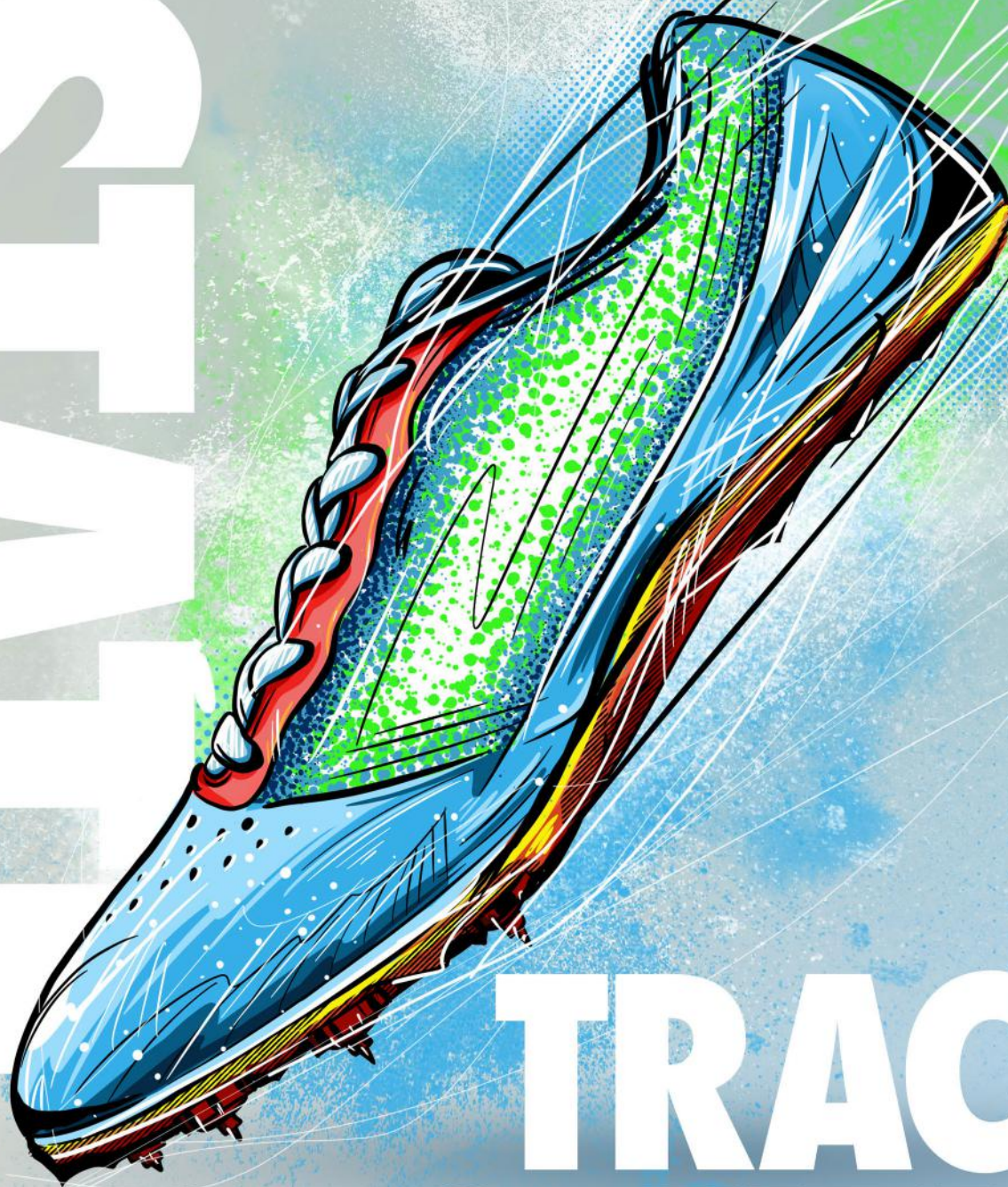

I was recently watching a news story entitled, “It is the way the game is supposed to be played so, why is it such a big deal?” The story took place in June of 2016 at the Indiana State Baseball Championships, during which a player from the winning team went onto the mound to console the losing pitcher, who was laying on the ground visibly upset, rather than embarking in a celebration with his teammates.

At the end of the story, the newscaster made a point to say, “The actions of the player reflected on the coaches and the parents of the kid. Somebody is doing something very right.” Adults in the player’s life, leading by example.

When the newscast finished, I pondered about why the story made the news. I was happy that the actions of the boys made national headlines, but saddened that acts of sportsmanship are not the norm. The realization that stories like this are highlighted because they are seen as something special and extraordinary was disheartening to me.

Throughout this year, the NMAA and our member schools are focusing on the importance of sportsmanship by coaches, players and spectators. When you attend a game as a spectator, remember that you too are setting an example for the kids on the court or field and for the individuals around you. Remember that it takes just one person to make a difference and the way you act can set an example for your community.

Be mindful of the example you set in whichever role you play in interscholastic athletics – as a coach, a parent, a player or a spectator. Be POSITIVE and support your team, without being negative towards opponents or contest officials. We need to all be a part of changing the culture of interscholastic athletics so that doing what is right is no longer newsworthy. Competing with Class should be the rule, not the exception.

Let us all band together and lead by example. Show the youth of today that sportsmanship matters. Show our student-athletes the proper way to win and lose. Show our “leaders of tomorrow” that their character far outweighs their performance. In New Mexico, our news story should always read, “It is the way the game is supposed to be played so, why is it such a big deal?” In New Mexico, let good sportsmanship and positive behavior always be the norm.

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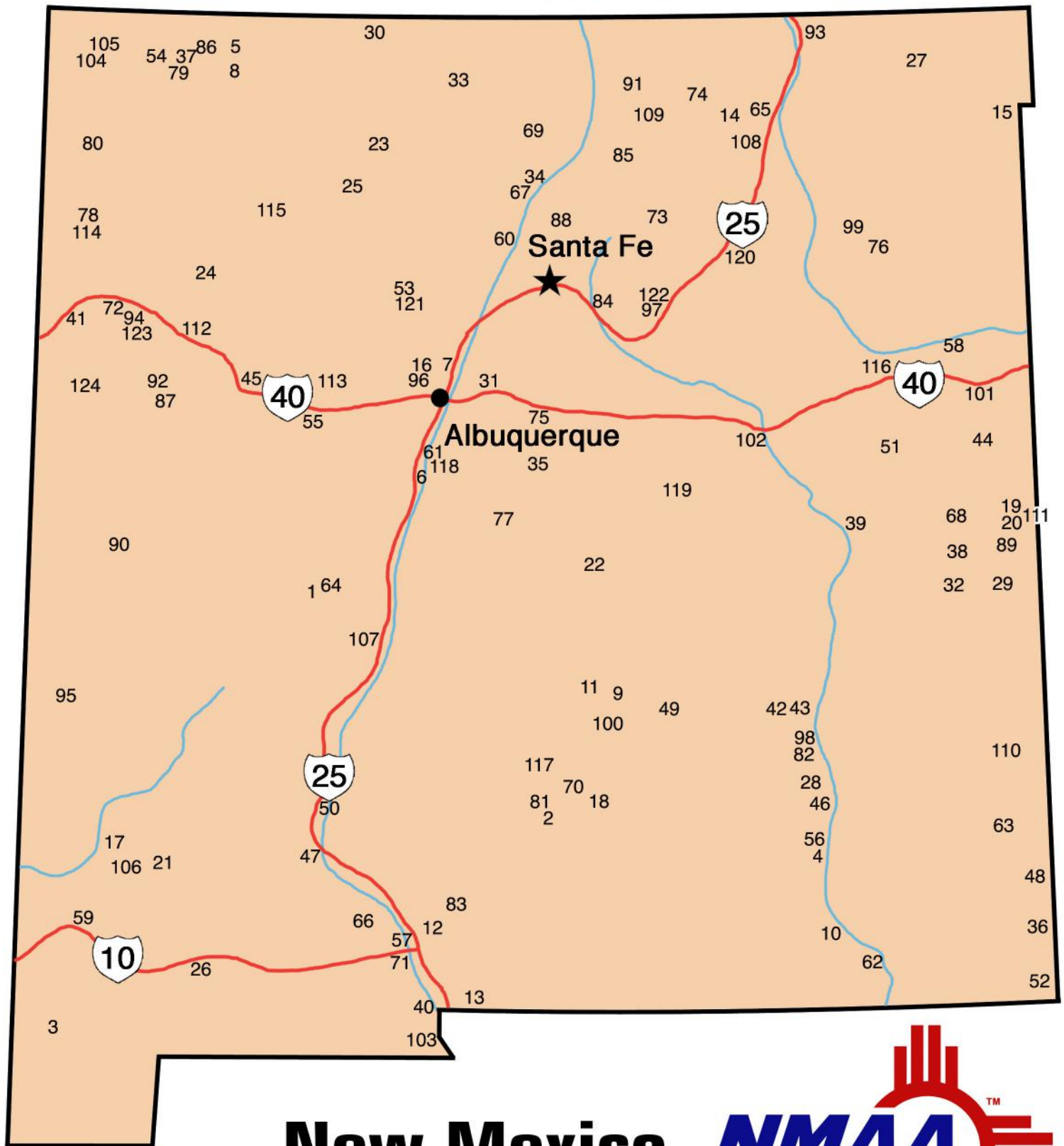
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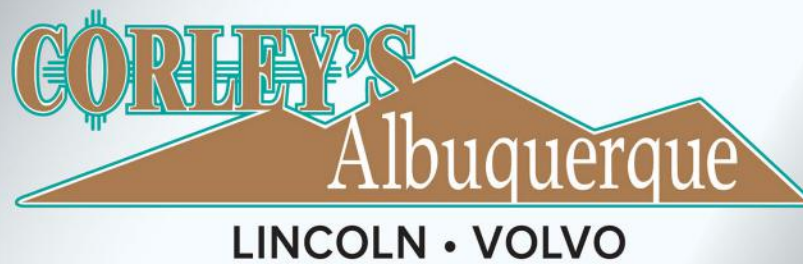
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Legend of Track & Field Carla Garrett

When it comes to track and field athletes who have come out of New Mexico, Carla Garrett is one of the more accomplished athletes the state has ever produced. Multi-sport athlete? Check! State record holder? Check, check! National champion? Check! Olympian? Check!

Garrett was a standout for Santa Fe High School who went on to become a 10-time All-American in track and field at the University of Arizona. In 1989, she was the NCAA national champion in the shot put during the indoor season and the shot put and discus champ in the outdoor season. Garrett was also a member of the 1991 and 1993 USA team that competed at the World Track and Field Championships, as well as a member of the 1992 United States Olympic team. In addition to her accolades on the track, Garrett was a USA weightlifting champion from 1991-94 and a two-time silver medalist in the World Weightlifting Championships. She has been inducted into four Halls of Fame since her athletic career ended.

Over 30 years later, Garrett still holds two New Mexico state records in track and field. Her shot put toss of 50'25" in 1984 is still tops among New Mexico high schoolers and no one has even come close to her 1983 record of 162'0" in the discus. Garrett was first introduced to track and field by accident. "I was playing basketball, my #1 sport, and the track coach at my junior high school walked through the gym and asked me if I'd ever thrown before," recalled Garrett. "I had no idea what she meant and I said 'yeah.' I thought she meant throw a ball. She meant a discus and shot. I wasn't really interested, but a couple of my friends were going to do track so I decided to go out for track. I started to win and it was like, 'Wow, ok, let me keep doing this if I keep winning.'"

She won plenty.

As a high schooler, Garrett was recruited by several top programs. Florida, Arizona State, UCLA and many others wanted Garrett to compete for them. Ultimately she decided on the University of Arizona. "The track coach who recruited me, Meg Ritchie, was a discus thrower," said Garrett. "She was the only recruiter who talked to me about winning. She said, 'Your first year, you will qualify for nationals and finish in the top 12. By your junior year, you will win a national championship and, your senior year, you will come back to defend it.' She was the one person who told me I would win a national championship."

And her coach was right.

Garrett was a three-time national champion and 10-time All American. At one time, she held the PAC-10 record in the discus. Garrett also became the first woman at the University of Arizona to ever win a PAC-10 championship. "Meg (her former coach) was the first to win the indoor and outdoor shot and the outdoor discus, I was the second one to ever do it."

After college, Garrett wanted to continue throwing. She was 5th and 7th in the 1988 Olympic Trials. From 1991-93, Garrett was one of the top athletes in the country. She was competing in both track & field and Olympic style weightlifting.



In 1991, she won the U.S. Nationals in the super heavyweight class in weightlifting. In 1992, she made the United States Olympic team and in 1993, she competed in the World Championships in both sports again. "Those years of 1991, 1992 and 1993, you would be hard pressed to find someone else with a better run," Garrett said.

She continued to compete nationally for a couple of years and then invested her efforts into becoming a strength coach. She helped her teams at Arizona (women's basketball, softball, volleyball and men's basketball) to three NCAA Division I championships. From 2015-2018, Garrett was the strength and conditioning coach at the University of New Mexico. She is currently a strength and conditioning coach at Pima Community College in Tucson, AZ.

Here is more from our conversation with Carla Garrett.

What do you remember most about competing in track in high school?

It was probably winning the state championship in a medley relay team my junior year in 1983. I won seven state titles, but the relay meant the most. I will always talk about that one. They thought nobody of my size could run and proving them wrong was spectacular! I could always run, but to showcase that in the state meet meant a lot. I also ran the 100m race



my senior year in high school. I made the finals, but I was last.

You still hold the state record in the shot put (50'1/4") and discus (162'0"). Do you think those records will be broken?

Like any record, it's meant to be broken. Like any record holder, you hope it doesn't get broken. If you look at high school throwers now, those numbers are still competitive. It will be difficult for someone from New Mexico to break those. That's why the relays were so important to me. I was so much better in those throwing events; it wasn't as competitive. To me, the relay was a challenge.

What did you enjoy most about competing in track?

I enjoy the friendships I made. I grew up with a lot of the girls I competed with and competed against. The relationships I had in high school were some of the best in my life.

What is your greatest moment as a strength coach?

I have two. First is winning the national championship with the University of Arizona softball team in 2001; it was arguably my greatest possible performance as a coach. Second is in 2013, my high school football team I worked with won the state championship and also ranked in the top 25 in the country.

If you could coach a sport you never had the opportunity to coach, what would that sport be?

That would be basketball hands down. I loved basketball! If you ask everyone I grew up with, they would tell you I was a better basketball player than a discus thrower. I played as much as I could on every court in Santa Fe. When I got older, track paid the bills, but basketball was my love.

What accomplishments are you most proud of?

Obviously, making the Olympic team - that's something I cherish because of how I made the team. I was in sixth place at

the trials, I was the final thrower. I moved from sixth to second on my last throw.

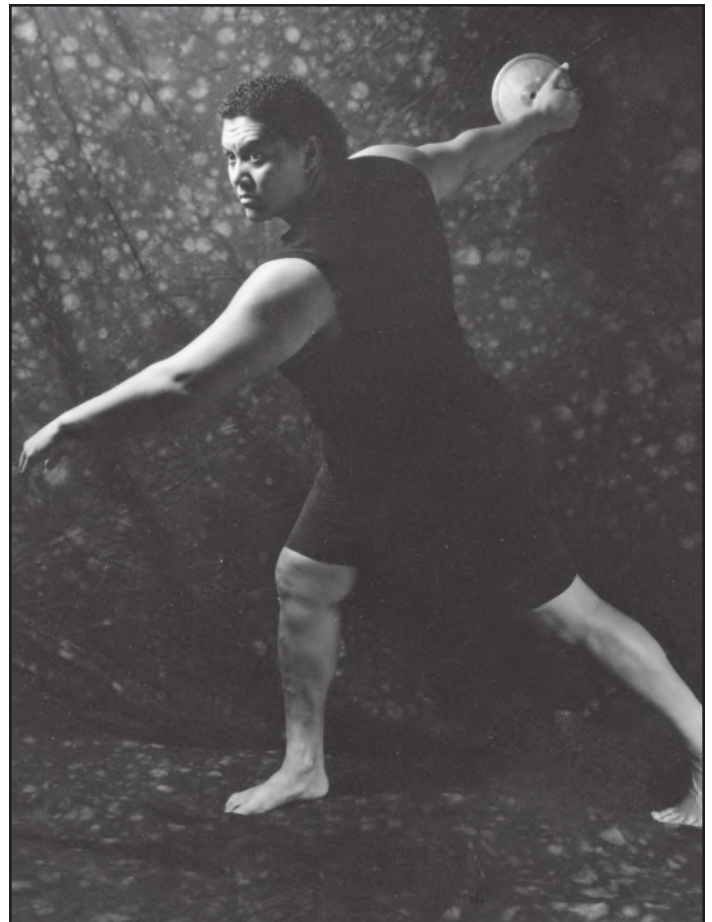
What kind of experience was the 1992 Olympics in Barcelona?

I always say when I initially made the team, it was like scratching a lottery ticket and every number kept winning and winning and that's how I felt. All the work I put in paid off. It was one of the best moments of my life! I remember looking up to the stands and seeing my mom and my coach holding hands, I cried. My performance was poor. I was just so excited to be there, I finished 22nd, that's why I was so disappointed in not making the team in '96.

What would you like to say to young coaches/young student athletes?

I think if you have a young athlete who's going to throw, you need to let them know you're not going to get any of the glamour. You throw because you love to throw, not because you're going to get accolades. You might not even be on the track sometimes when you train. You do it because you love it and want to compete; you don't do it for advertising.

We would like to congratulate Carla Garrett on a fantastic career and being selected as the 2019 Legend of the Track!

RESERVE WINS BOYS 1A STATE TRACK & FIELD TITLE



The Reserve boys won the Class 1A state championship with 78.5 points. Melrose was second (67.5) and Elida third (66). Reserve's Ben Fletcher won the high jump at 6'4", beating his teammate Brenden Goetz in a jump-off. Both set the new state mark. Reserve's Isaac Johnston took home top honors in the long jump (20'2.5"). The Reserve boys also won the 4x100m relay. Reserve senior Billy Baca won the 400m dash in record time (51.48). The Reserve boys ended the meet with a record in the final event, the 4x400m relay (3:36.58).

TAOS WINS 4A GIRLS CHAMPIONSHIP



The Taos girls won the 4A team title at the 2018 State Championships. The Tigers finished with 71 points. Hope Christian was second with 61 points. Silver and Sandia Prep tied for third with 57 points.

Faith Powell of Taos was the high point athlete, earning 28 points for her team. Powell won the long jump (18'5.5"), just shy of the state record. She also won the high jump for the fourth year in a row (5'4") and finished first in the triple jump (37'11.5"). Her teammate Cora Canedy won the 3200m race (12:18.00), ten seconds faster than anyone else, and won the 1600m event (5:32.39). Abigail Gunther of Taos won the pole vault (10'6").

Silver's Aysia Salas won the discus (128'4") and shot (39'2.5"). Sophomore Ashlyn Aguilar of Socorro was tops in the javelin (124'2").

The Silver girls won the 4x100m relay (50.19) and 4x200m relay (1:45.55). Sandia Prep sophomore Sevilla Duran won the 100m hurdles (16.35) and 300m hurdles (45.19). Her teammate Skyler Gee, also a sophomore, won the 800m race (2:20.91). Morgan Johnson of Ruidoso finished first in the 100m dash (12.90) and 200m race (26.45). Lauren Chafins of St. Michael's won a first place medal in the 400m dash (59:45).

The Sandia Prep girls finished first in the 1600m sprint medley (4:27.97) and the 4x400m (4:05.65).

CHARGERS WIN FOURTH STRAIGHT 5A BOYS TRACK TITLE



For the fourth year in a row, the Albuquerque Academy boys took home the blue trophy. The Chargers finished with 83 points with Artesia in second with 49 points and Alamogordo third totaling 48.5 points. Academy's Lucas Jepsen claimed victory in the long jump (22'10.25"), triple jump (45-1") and part of their 4x400m relay winning team (3:23.53). His teammate Teagun Glenn won the javelin as a sophomore with a throw of 190'1".

Artesia's Kale Mauritsen had a fabulous weekend on the track, claiming victories in the pole vault (13'), sweeping the 110m hurdles (15.11) and 300m (38.28) hurdles and ran a leg in his team's 4x200m relay win (1:31.44). Mauritsen was the high point athlete with 26.5 points.

Kirtland Central junior Kashon Harrison was eight seconds faster than the competition in the 1600m event (4:22.88) and ten seconds faster than everyone in the 3200m race (9:48.79). The Chaparral boys won the 4x100m relay (42.80). Deming's Caesar Chavez won his first 100m dash as a sophomore (10.76). Elijah Velasquez of Los Alamos won the 800m run (1:56.70). The 400m winner was Zakarri Fields of Gallup (49.44). The Aztec boys won the 1600m medley (3:41.80). The 200m title went to Alamogordo's Chamar Norman (22.37).

Roswell sophomore Jasia Reese won the high jump at six feet. Goddard's Jonathan Flores took home the title in the discus with a throw of 148' even and finished first in the shot put (52'3.75").

ALBUQUERQUE ACADEMY CLAIMS GIRLS' 5A BLUE TROPHY



The Albuquerque Academy girls stood on top of the podium at the end of the meet with 79 points, while Alamogordo finished second (71) and Los Alamos third (52.5). Academy's Maddie Morris added seven points to the total with a victory in the long jump (17'3.5"). Her teammate Zoe Hunter won the 3200m race (11:50.75). Academy junior Grace Alley crossed the finish line first in the 800m race (2:15.65). Academy also finished first in the medley relay (4:24.09).

Goddard's Destiny Lawrence was the high point athlete with 22 points. The junior won the 100m dash (12.46), 200m dash (25.65) as well as the 400m event (58.12).

Rebecca Green, a sophomore from Los Alamos, won the discus (130'3") and shot (41'11.5"). Ava Gervais of St. Pius X won the triple jump (36'6.5"). Arianna Martinez of St. Pius X claimed top honors in the high jump (5'4") for the fourth year in a row while her teammate Haley Rizek won the javelin with a personal best throw of 134'6" on her final toss. Rizek also won the 300m hurdles for the third straight year (45.02). Rizek set a record in the 100m hurdles in the prelims on Friday, but she finished fourth in Saturday's final of the 100m hurdles after getting tripped up on the final hurdle. The 100m hurdle title went to Sadi Butler of Artesia (15.81). Sophomore Kiara Quezada of Farmington set a new state record in the pole vault (11'7").

The Del Norte girls won the 4x100m relay (49.34). The Alamogordo girls won the 4x200m relay (1:44.62) along with the 4x400m relay (4:03.68). Miyamura's Ashley Thomas won the 1600m race (5:23.10).

CLEVELAND BOYS WIN THIRD STRAIGHT TRACK CHAMPIONSHIP



For the third straight year, the Cleveland High School boys' track team left the stadium with the blue trophy. The Storm easily captured the title with 89 points, followed by Volcano Vista with 58 and Clovis with 51.

Volcano Vista's Jericho Cleveland was the high point athlete with 21 points. Cleveland won the 800m (1:52.59), 1600m (4:12.51) and 3200m (9:45.16) events over the weekend.

One of the high points of the meet came on Saturday when Manzano senior Jordan Byrd tied the state record in the 100m dash with a blazing time of 10.5 seconds. He was also a part of Manzano's 4x100m relay team (41.47) and their winning group in the 4x200m relay (1:27.11). Byrd finished out the meet by winning the 200m event as well (22.21). Byrd's teammate Isaac Cole won the 400m dash (48.59).

The boys javelin title went to Garrett Wade of Cleveland (180'1").

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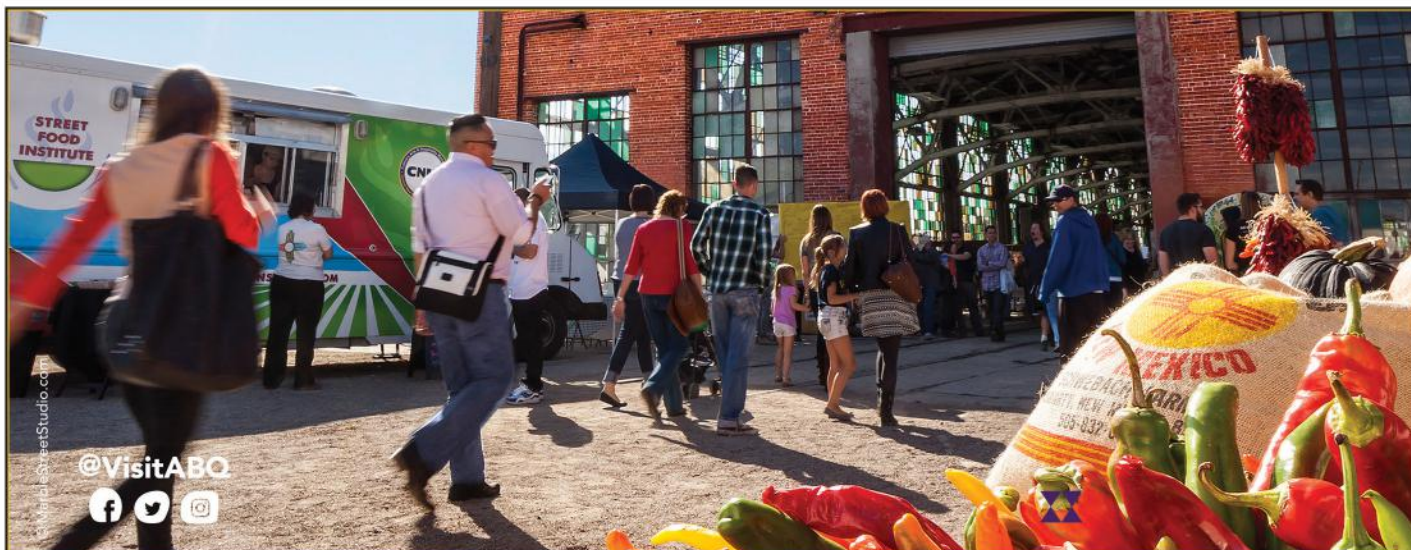

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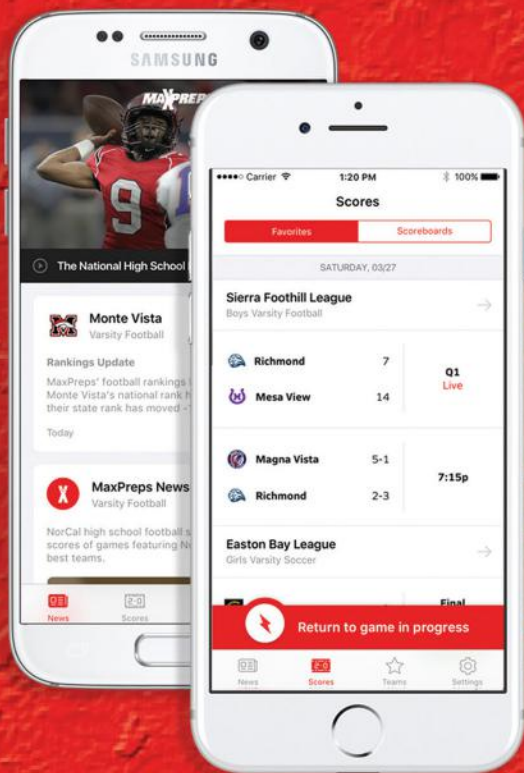
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
