A: "I started playing Duckpin Bowling at the age of 7 at the Double "E" Bowling Center in my hometown, in Cagayan de Oro, Philippines. There were no Tenpin Bowling Centers in the Philippines back then except for the Greater Manila area and Cebu City. Duckpin Bowling had more following back in the days in the Philippines. I only started playing Tenpin Bowling at Bellerose Lanes in New York in the late 90's."

Q: Who taught you to Bowl?

A: "My parents, Judge Daniel R. Sindo and Yolanda G. Sindo taught me and my siblings how to bowl because they were Bowling enthusiasts themselves. Out of 7 children, my sister Aleli, my late brother Lyndon and I, continued with the sport. Our Dad became our main coach, but I had several other coaches since I was 9 years old and onwards when I started joining local, national, and international bowling tournaments. My mother headed the Cagayan de Oro Misamis Oriental Duckpin Bowling Association (CMDBA) and my father headed the Philippine Duckpin Bowling Council (PHIDBC) and was once the President of the International (Duckpin) Bowling Association (IBA)."

Q: Did you Bowl for school?

A: "In the Philippines, there were no Inter-School tournaments back then. Students bowled and competed with adults most of the time except for tournaments that had the "Youth" events which is mostly in the Annual PHIDBC National Tournaments and Duckpin World Cup events. In effect, my siblings and I, along with other youth bowlers, would represent our hometown."



Q: What are some of your honor scores/achievements/wins?

A: "As a youth Bowler, I had several Top and Runner-Up finishes in the Singles tournaments in my age bracket. I won first place in the Adult Class "B" category once, at 14 years old. In the 1983 2nd World Cup in Canada I finished 4th in the Girls division. I was a member of the RP Youth Team together with 2 of my siblings. I was also a member of my mother's (Ladies) Team representing Cagayan de oro which garnered several Top and Runner-up finishes in PHIDBC Tournaments.

When I joined PBC 22 years ago, I was the Most Improved Bowler (Female) during my first year as a Tenpin Bowler. Over the years, I have had several awards for High Average, High Series, Love Doubles, and Elite Club. I have participated in Strike for Sight, BVL, other Fundraising Tournaments, PBC, Local USBC Queens Tournaments.

In the 4th World Overseas Filipino Bowling Tour (WOFBT) in 2017, I was one of the 5 members who won the bronze medal in the team event in Athens, Greece. In 2019, during the 6th WOFBT in Vienna, Austria, my teammate Evelyn Lindo and I won the Gold Medal in the Women's Doubles Event. I finished 4th in the Ladies Singles and in the Masters' Division that year and also won the Silver Medal in the Women's Division in the 2019 MBA Sarimanok international Tournament that was also held in Vienna, Austria."

Q: What are your current Bowling goals?

A: "I believe in the principle of a bowler always having room for improvement. I want to keep improving in the technical aspects of my game. I want to continue Bowling for PBC and support its initiatives and growth. I would like to see the sport of bowling continue to evolve not only as a recreational activity but mainly, a competitive one. I would like to continue to participate in local tournaments whenever I can and also compete in the WOFBT and MBA Sarimanok Tournaments."




