In a region with thousands of small producers, Gaston Chiquet has made a name for itself as an excellent grower Champagne. Based in the evocatively named Dizy, the family first planted vines in 1746 but did not produce Champagne until 1935, when brothers Ferdinand and Gaston Chiquet took the bold step of setting up their own label, rather than just selling grapes to the larger houses. Nowadays, the house is a credit to its owners Antoine and Nicolas Chiquet. Due to the large percentage of Pinot Meunier in the blend, the Brut non-vintage has a delightful vinous quality with red berry undertones and good length.

With only nine and a half hectares under their belt, Bérèche & Fils has managed to create a reputation for itself around the world, thanks to top vineyards (three Premier Crus and one Grand Cru), great attention to detail and no chemical intervention in the vineyard. The Bérèche sites are planted in roughly equal proportions of Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier, which, combined with the wide variety of terroirs, provides a great range of blending possibilities. Raphaël and Vincent's skillful barrel ageing and use of cork closures, rather than crown caps, for the secondary fermentation makes the most of this grape variety and site derived complexity. Once the preserve of a few sommeliers in the know, their wines are now acknowledged as some of the most exciting grower champagnes on the market. Supply is woefully small but we have a tiny annual allocation of these special wines.

A new estate created by brothers Raphaël & Vincent Bérêche and managed by their cousin, Juliette Alips. Born in Champagne in a grower's family, Juliette rapidly found her passion. With the mentorship of her close cousins, she discovered and learned all the ins and outs of producing Champagne.

A unique site in Champagne and an exceptional terroir, Les Monts Fournois has been combining agriculture and viticulture for almost 150 years. Biodiversity is omnipresent here, right on the edge of the chalk. Our presses, winery and cellar are located on this site, just in front of the vines. So, the estate is one. Chardonnay and Pinot Noir are sharing the old vines from 1961, 1963 and 1994.

From 2027, Champagne from the estate will be available - two 1er Cru vintage Champagnes, one a subtle blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, the other a blended rosé. Both vinified in oak barrels and then the second fermentation is made under cork before ageing for 5 years on lees. Until then, distribution of the existing range of Crus Sélectionnés - CÔTE- VALLEE-MONTAGNE will continue. This range is educative and pedagogic. The idea is to give you a vision into the great historic terroirs of the Champagne region. The vintages selected are Grands Crus and Premiers Crus only and are mainly older vintages. The 3 great terroirs of CÔTE DES BLANCS, VALLEE DE LA MARNE and MONTAGNE DE REIMS are therefore represented in our selection.

The Plou family has been making wine in the small village of Chargé in the Loire valley since 1508. The family have added to their vineyards over the centuries and now own 75 hectares of vines. The terroir is comprised of Tuffeau chalk from the Paris Basin with either clay-limestone or flint-clay subsoils. The terraces on the banks of the Loire River, however, are made up of sand and gravel.

This Tuffeau Blanc de Blancs Brut Nature is made from 100% Chardonnay from the Plou estate in the communes of Chargé and Artigny, using the champagne method. After a 6 month vinification in stainless steel vats, the wine undergoes a secondary fermentation that lasts 12 months. During this time, the bottles are left to rest in a troglodyte cave dug deep into chalk cliffs. The bottles are then racked by hand to remove the sediment. The result is an aromatic wine with a fine perlage and lots of varietal character.

Daniel Chotard is a small producer whose family has been farming the slopes of Crémancy- en-Sancerre, where flint meets clay and the famous Kimmeridgian limestone, for well over 200 years. Now lead by Simon and Juliette, they typically harvest the grapes later than their neighbours, resulting in less of the acidity that is so typical of the Sauvignon Blanc grape. These wines are complex, lush and long with a lengthy mineral component imbued by the limestone soil. Aged on lees, the wines are much rounder than most Sancerres and have excellent texture.

Château la Rabotine is the property of Alban Roblin, the youngest grandson of Sancerre vigneron Georges Roblin. The Roblins have cultivated this land in the Northern Sury-en- Vaux sub-region of Sancerre since the 1920s. In 2009, Alban & his wife Marion took over his family's estate and in 2010 they acquired a property that had belonged to Albans grandfather: Château la Rabotine. Right opposite the cellar, it has become a symbol of the estate. From 10ha of Sauvignon Blanc & 2ha of Pinot Noir, they produce incredible plot-based wines in small vessels where possible. Since 2021, they have begun conversion to organic farming methods which is fully in keeping with the estate's philosophy; Give Time Its Full Power. Meaning to be patient and making the most of the benefits that comes from ageing wines. Observing nature & biodiversity to make the vine the primary concern & priority. Never rushing so that the vine can give its best while respecting it with careful tillage.

Located in Vouvray in Indre-et-Loire, the family farm of Jean Claude and Didier Aubert was founded in 1823. For 7 generations, the estate has been established in the Vouvray appellation and has continued to develop in a cherished and respected environment.

Since 2020, the estate has been certified High Environmental Value. The vineyard is managed in a traditional way using sustainable agriculture.

In order to optimise biodiversity and quality, the rows of vines are planted with grass. The clay-limestone or clayey-siliceous soil rests on tuffeau, this elegant stone used in particular for the construction of the Loire châteaux. This diversity of soil gives the wines their originality and character.

The joint work of two generations brings together respect for tradition and modernity. In the cellars, both wood and stainless-steel vats are used. The vats are thermo-regulated and allow the control of temperatures to obtain wines with finesse and elegance. The wines are matured on lees before bottling in the spring.

Vincent Lacour is a fifth generation vigneron in Touraine, working lands that have been passed from father to son for over 200 years. The vineyard is located in the heart of the Loire Valley near the Château de Chenonceau in the village of St Georges sur Cher. The vines are planted on clay with flint soil, known locally as “perruches”, and enjoy a climate that produces a true expression of Touraine Sauvignon with pure mineral undertones.

The Grosbois family has produced wine in the Loire Valley since 1820. Today, Nicolas and Sylvain Grosbois produce eight cuvées of Chinon, vinified by geographic parcel. In the past, Nicolas has made wine in Chile, Oregon, Australia and New Zealand but nowadays he prefers to focus his energies on 9 hectares of vines, mostly Cabernet Franc (known locally as Breton), the oldest of which is around 60 years old. All of his wines showcase Cabernet Franc at its very purest.

The Boesch family have been making wine for generations – eleven to be precise – and have been amassing quality vineyards since 1640. The result is 13 hectares of remarkable terroir managed by Gérard Boesch and his son Mathieu. Both father and son have been practising organic viticulture since 2000 and only use indigenous yeasts. The wines are aged on the lees until the summer following the harvest to give plenty of texture to the wines.

After finding family politics at the famous Billaud-Simon tough going, Samuel set up his own business taking 18 years' of winemaking experience with him. Samuel farms fruit from his own family parcels.

As a member of one of the longest established families in the region, he is also able to source top quality fruit from other growers. This access to great terroir gives the wines exceptional purity and great tension. All vineyards are managed directly. The wines are fermented with native yeasts and are left on the lees. We are fortunate to have a very small allocation of Samuel's Premier Cru Montée de Tonnerre and Mont de Milieu.

Gilles Fèvre met Nathalie when they were both winemaking students in Dijon. For 12 years, Nathalie was Chef de Cave at La Chablisienne, the region's famous cooperative winery, which, coincidentally, was co-founded by Gilles' grandfather. Since 1923, the Fèvres sold their fruit, including grapes from the family's prized parcels in the Grand Cru Les Preuses, to La Chablisienne.

This all changed with the 2004 vintage when Nathalie left the co-op to launch Domaine Fèvre with her husband. Nathalie now focuses her winemaking talents solely on the family's grapes and, together with Gilles, espouses a natural approach, employing bio-friendly alternatives to chemical herbicides and pesticides. The domaine now encompasses 98 acres planted entirely with Chardonnay on Kimmeridgian soil, including 36 acres of prime parcels in Grand Cru and Premier Cru vineyards.

SUSTAINABLE VITICULTURE

Sylvie Esmonin's unique winemaking style means her Gevrey-Chambertin is much-sought after. Sylvie's estate is made up of 5 prime hectares in the heart of Gevrey-Chambertin – the Premier Cru site Clos St-Jacques is Sylvie's back garden. No herbicides have been used since 1990. Sylvie picks later than most and favours lower yields. All grapes are destemmed, crushed and fermented in open wood vats for around two weeks, before decanting the wine into barrel. The barrels are of various ages to accommodate the different cuvées, with only Clos St-Jacques using a high proportion of new wood, usually 75%, from Dominique Laurent's cooperage. Sylvie's wines are structured but silky.

The Côte-de-Nuits-Village comes from vineyards in Brochon, a small village between Gevrey and Fixin, from the lieux-dits La Croix Viollette and Les Vignois; it is smoky and peppery, with ripe tannins and sweet fruit. The Gevrey-Chambertin comes from 30-year-old vines in the lieu-dit Les Crais; it is quite rich and structured, with good ripeness and dark fruit aromas. The Vieilles Vignes, comes from various plots of 60-year-old vines; it is aged in 50% new wood and is very ripe, round and chewy, with intense berry fruit.

Aubert de Villaine, heir to Domaine de la Romanée-Conti, and co-director since the 1960s, began this project in the 1970s. Aubert and his American wife, Pamela, took over a run-down estate in Bouzeron, one of the last forgotten enclaves of Burgundy, situated between Chassagne- Montrachet, Santenay, Rully, and Mercurey.

Bouzeron boasts the best Aligoté in Burgundy: the Aligoté Doré. Unlike the lesser clone, Aligoté Vert, Aligoté Doré gives smaller yields to produce more refined wines with expressive aromatics and great balance. Nowadays, Pierre de Benoist, Aubert's nephew, runs the domaine, upholding the tradition, excellence, and standards for which it has become so well-known.

Domaine Michel Prunier was set up in 1968 when Michel and his wife Michèle, joined together the plots they had inherited from their respective families and together they built the current buildings and developed the vineyards to a stage that we know today. In Burgundy, the know- how is also passed down from father to daughter so in 2004, Estelle who is 5th generation of winegrowers in the family, joined her father's side in the vineyard. Having studied in Beaune and Mâcon she the trained in Bordeaux in Moulis-en-Médoc at Château Duplessis and in the Yarra Valley at Yerring Station when Tom Carson was winemaker.

Today the family cultivates 12 hectares of vines in 6 towns: Auxey-Duresses, Meursault, Volnay, Pommard, Beaune & Chorey-les-Beaune. Production is roughly one-third white and two-thirds red, mainly around Auxey-Duresses. The vineyards are ploughed by horse and tireless efforts have been made to minimise the use of chemical products and work in a more sustainable way. All of the wines are aged on fine lees with minimal use of new oak.

Méo-Camuzet is undoubtedly one of the finest estates in Burgundy but, surprisingly, for many years the family's vineyard holdings were leased out. It was only in the 1980s that Jean-Nicholas Méo, under the guidance of Burgundy legend Henri Jayer, started the domaine on the path of excellence it is now on. Since then, Méo-Camuzet has marked itself out as a top producer with a distinctive style, encapsulating intensity and elegance. With over 2.5 hectares of Grands Crus and 8 hectares of some of the finest Premier Cru vineyards of Nuits-St-Georges and Vosne-Romanée, Jean-Nicolas Méo and Christian Faurois now produce some of the very best wine in the Côte d'Or with most of the vineyards farmed organically.

One of the most sought after producers in Beaujolais today, the Lapierre wines are legendary. Together with Foillard, Breton and Thevenet, Marcel Lapierre was instrumental in breathing a new lease of life to the wines of the region.

Lapierre led the return to using the 'old methods' starting with old vines, never using synthetic herbicides or pesticides, harvesting late, rigorously sorting to remove all but the healthiest grapes, adding minimal doses of sulphur dioxide or none at all, and disdaining chaptalisation. Following his sudden death, the domaine was taken over by his children: Mathieu (formerly a 2 star Michelin chef) and his sister Camille, who have added their own touch to the wines. These wines are what good Beaujolais is all about: they are full of life, have great character and are incredibly easy to drink.

CHRISTOPHE PACALET



Christophe Pacalet

After some experience in biochemistry and cooking, Christophe Pacalet began making his own wines under the guidance of his uncle Marcel Lapierre in 1999. Although Christophe doesn't own his own vineyards, he works very closely with select growers and favours parcels of old vines cultivated according to his preferences, respecting the vines and the environment to obtain the best grapes. He currently produces 10 cuvees from various villages in Beaujolais.

Harvest is by hand at maximum maturity with his own team and the grapes are meticulously sorted then transported in 20kg boxes. Stored cooled overnight, awaiting vatting the next morning. The tanks, thus filled, are saturated with carbon dioxide and closed. Carbonic fermentation starts in the juice at the bottom of the vat after a few days, without adding yeast or SO₂. Fermentation lasts for 2 to 3 weeks depending on the vintage. Pressing is done on a vertical wooden press, typical of Beaujolais, and the juices obtained are decanted, cooled and placed in tuns and 228 litre Burgundy barrels. The wines are then aged on fine lees for 5 to 10 months depending on the appellations before bottling. Filtering is very light and the use of sulphites at bottling is kept to a minimum and sometimes not used at all - depending on the destination of the wines.

Château Gaillard is a family-owned estate that covers 12 hectares of prime terroir in Beaujolais. Sébastien Gutty (a neighbour of the Lapierre family) has been making lifted, graceful Gamay in this spot since 1972. The fruit for his Fleurie comes from mature vines set on a slope with a South-Eastern exposure. The soils are sandy and the average age of the vines is 70 years. Nowadays, his son Sébastien does most of the winemaking albeit in the tradition of his father. Carbonic maceration takes place over 11 days and fermentation occurs at low temperatures. The wine is allowed to rest for 7 months in foudres.

Founded in 2018 by Maylis Bernard in Rotalier, Jura, Zéroine is a natural wine project that began as a négociant venture and has since evolved into a small estate operation. The name "Zéroine" reflects the winery's commitment to producing wines without additives ("zero") and celebrates the feminine aspect of winemaking ("heroïne"). Initially sourcing organic grapes from trusted producers, Zéroine now cultivates its own vineyards in La Combe de Rotalier, focusing on minimal intervention practices such as soil ploughing and plant-based vine protection. Maylis, granddaughter of a winemaker from Château-Chalon, transitioned from a 16-year career in IT to pursue her passion for natural winemaking.

Drawing inspiration from her partner, renowned winemaker Jean-François Ganevat, she established Zéroine to produce wines that are "alive, free, and sensitive," embracing a philosophy of minimal intervention and no added sulfites.

Today, Philippe Bernède, continues the family tradition and farms sixty hectares of land along the alluvial terraces of the Lot Valley that are rich in siliceous, clay, and limestone soils. The microclimate of the vineyards is ideal, with southwest sun exposure and topographic protection against the frost. Over the years, Philippe has tinkered with the house blend to achieve a greater balance. Today, the blend consists of 80% Malbec and 20% Merlot, creating an intense wine with subtle, elegant tannins.

Built on the remains of a Gallo-Roman villa, Château Laville has produced quality wine for centuries. In fact, the château is mentioned in the very first edition of Édouard Féret's guide to Bordeaux wines published in 1865. The Faye family took possession of the estate in 1956 – the year that most of the vines were destroyed by terrible frost. Since then, the vineyard has been patiently replanted.

Ideally located on the central plateau of Saint Sulpice, the vines cover 30 hectares and benefit from excellent soils with a high density of *aliots*, resulting in rich, powerful wines. The wine is matured in the purest Bordeaux tradition, with long vatting periods and maturation in French oak barrels. The Bordeaux Supérieur is made from 30-year-old Merlot and Cabernet. It is fermented in stainless steel tanks using indigenous yeast at 28 degrees Celsius for 28 days. It is then aged in French oak barrels and bottled 18 months after harvest.

Wine has been produced at Château Lyonnat for centuries. In fact, the domaine used to supply the Vatican. Since the 2008 vintage, Hubert de Boüard, renowned consultant and owner of Château Angélus, supervises the vinification and blends of the estate. The 52 hectare vineyard is blessed with a 10 hectare limestone islet with a southern and south-easterly exposure, and is very similar to the plateau of Saint-Emilion.

The rest of the estate is made up of clay-limestone and limestone soils. The estate is planted 90% to Merlot and 10% to Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, in keeping with the cold nature of the soils. (In this area, harvesting is carried out 15 days after Pomerol). The wine is fermented in temperature-controlled concrete tanks instead of fashionable stainless steel tanks. Fermentation generally lasts 10 days. A long maceration of typically three weeks follows. The wine is then racked into new oak barrels for malolactic fermentation and aged for 18 months. The resulting wine is cherry red with an intense nose of marinated plums, black cherries and complex, tertiary aromas.

The vineyard is situated on a terrace of gravel, sand and clay, surrounded by forests in the heart of the Sauternes. Now under the new leadership of Sandrine Garbay, previously winemaker at Château d'Yquem for 28 years.

The accessibility of everyday luxury is Petit Guiraud's greatest quality. Vinified with the Grand Vin of the property, the second wine is produced on dedicated plots and is certified AB.

Matured partly in barrels, it stands out for its freshness and drinkability. Made from a blend of 65% Sémillon and 35% Sauvignon blanc, vinified with native yeasts and aged for 18 months in new French oak barrels, the Petit Guiraud is a benchmark for purity and

We are fortunate to count the wines of the Cornas pioneer Pierre-Auguste Clape among our portfolio. Sadly, Pierre-Auguste passed away in July 2018 at 93 years of age but the former mayor of Cornas and tireless vigneron accomplished much in his lifetime, upholding Northern Rhone winemaking tradition without allowing himself to be constricted by rules. For many years, most growers in Cornas sold their fruit to négociants but Pierre-Auguste was the first to bottle his own wine in the 1950's.

The fruit, which comes from the best sites in Cornas, is left to its own devices as much as possible. The Clapes farm eight hectares of steep, tightly stacked terrace vineyards. The rough terrain means using any machinery in the vineyards is impossible. The vineyards sit on granite subsoil, behind the village, with optimal sun exposure. The oldest vines are 60 years old. In order to achieve optimal phenolic ripeness, picking is delayed for as long as possible. Whole grape clusters are fermented with natural yeasts and long élevages of twelve to twenty-two months add depth to the natural complexity of the wines. Although capable of tremendous longevity, the wines are also worth trying while young and fresh. The purity and vibrancy of his wines are a testament to Pierre-Auguste Clape's passion and tireless dedication to the cause of Cornas. It now falls to his son, Pierre-Marie, who started working with Auguste in 1989, to carry on Auguste's legacy alongside his son (Auguste's grandson) Olivier.

Each site has a different aspect and soil type, giving varying nuances to the wine. This allows Jean-Louis Chave to produce a blend that reflects the separate characteristics of the site with a perfect balance of aromatic complexity, power and finesse.



Éric Texier is now the leading light of Brézème, a small enclave of the northern Rhône. While reading a book on the Grands Terroirs de France (published in 1880) during his former life as a nuclear engineer, Éric discovered that Syrah grown in Brézème used to be some of the best in the world. By 1961, however, just one hectare remained. Éric decided to try and revive the region and acquired a vineyard, experimenting with organic and biodynamic methods. His Syrah is characteristically warm and spicy but whole bunch pressing gives the wine crunchy plum skin tannins. Although known for his reds, his whites are similarly compelling.







Having spent many years as winemaker and cellarmaster for the Chapoutier estate, Domaine de Bila-Haut in Roussillion, Gilles a native of the Rhône and an expert in biodynamic farming, now focuses solely on making wines under his own name producing some of the most interesting wines in the region. Situated in the Pyrénées, Gilles works with 6 hectares of vines benefiting from the freshness provided by high altitude of between 500-600 metres and has been farming biodynamically (uncertified) since 2002. Plots of Syrah, Grenache Noir, lladoner pelut, Carignan, Macabeu grow on granite and Grenache Noir & Gris on schist. Currently he produces 8-10 wines in tiny quantities of 150-1500 bottles with only l'Ultim over 2000 bottles. All work in the vineyard is carried out by hand and vinification is with indigenous yeasts. Gilles favours light extraction which allows the wines to show their true varietal characteristics and highlight the minerality of the soil. The wines are aged in cement tanks or large old oak barrels retaining balance and freshness.

Located only two kilometres from the sea, Domaine de Montmarin is spread over more than 400 hectares. Acquired by Nicolas de Sarret in 1488, his descendants have kept the estate until today. In 1878 one of the Sarrets devoted himself to the vineyard, and built a villa there finished with a belvedere overlooking the sea.

The estate is still family owned, currently by Philippe de Bertier, and in 2001 the estate's winemaker Bertrand Waris brought his knowledge and talent to create quality wines. In 2018 they began to convert to organic farming and from the 2022 vintage the wines are now certified organic.

In total there are 85ha of vines and 11 grape varieties, which allows it to create a wide range of wines. It benefits from a privileged terroir on clay-limestone, sandy-loamy soils, and benefits from maritime entrances which, thanks to milder temperatures, favour the aromatics of its wines.

Forward-looking and creative, the co-operative cellar Alma Cersius is a group of passionate and committed winegrowers who pool their know-how and expertise.

Located in Béziers, the Languedoc region in the South of France, the vineyards benefit from the proximity of the Mediterranean Sea which tempers the heat of the summer months on the alluvial soils made up of pebbles and clay. Each stage of the vegetal cycle of the vines, from vineyard management to harvest, is scrupulously managed. Each parcel is marked upon tasting the berries, to determine the aromatic profile of the future wine in the vineyard. This makes it a natural ally who fully participates in the HEV 3 approach to farming.

Zmago Petrič's family's winery is located in Vipavska Dolina in Slovenia, and from the beginning, they have worked organically and biodynamically, devoting their energies to local grape varieties and respecting their natural environment. The soil is a mixture of sand, sandstone, marl, limestone and clay from the Eocene Epoch. The decomposition of marl results in clay particles rich in mineral substances. All of the vineyards lie on the steep southern slopes of the Vipava hills enabling good exposure to wind, high temperature fluctuations between day and night, and optimal exposure to sun. In order to promote biodiversity and a healthy ecosystem, the family uses organic matter, compost and green manure, spraying with a combination of horn manure and flint. Everything is hand-picked, naturally fermented and bottled unfiltered with minimal sulphur addition.

Frassinelli Winery is a family-owned estate established in 1966 in Mareno di Piave, Italy, within the renowned Conegliano Valdobbiadene Prosecco Superiore region. The winery is dedicated to producing high-quality wines from native grape varieties, with a strong emphasis on sustainability. They hold SQNPI certification, reflecting their commitment to environmentally responsible viticulture.

Among their notable offerings is the Prosecco DOC Treviso Frizzante "Spago", crafted from the Glera grape. This wine undergoes a secondary fermentation using the Martinotti method for at least 30 days, resulting in a fresh and fruity profile with notes of nectarine and wisteria flowers. The "Spago" style is characterized by its traditional closure with a hand tied string, a nod to historical bottling practices.

Cantine Olivella, in the Neapolitan area of Sant'Anastasia, takes its name from the nearby Olivella spring. In Roman times, this part of Italy was known for producing fine wines. In 1974, at the slope of Monte Somma close to the spring, a fragment of a Roman earthenware wine jug was discovered. The jug carries an abbreviated inscription, *Sextus Catius Festus*, along with a seal depicting a stylized leaf, similar to a heart. This seal has since become the logo for Cantine Olivella. The winery produces wine from forgotten indigenous varietals such as Catalanesca, Caprettone and Piedirocco. The grapes are grown on volcanic soil at 450 metres above sea level and produce intriguing wines full of character.

Radikon is a pioneering natural wine estate located in Oslavia, Friuli-Venezia Giulia, Italy, near the Slovenian border. Founded in the late 1970s by Stanko Radikon, the winery gained international acclaim for its innovative approach to winemaking, particularly in the production of skin-contact (orange) wines. Stanko's philosophy centred on minimal intervention, embracing traditional methods such as spontaneous fermentation, prolonged skin maceration, and extended aging without the use of sulfur dioxide.


The estate's 12 hectares of vineyards are situated on steep slopes with ponca soils—ancient marls and sandstones—ideal for cultivating indigenous grape varieties like Ribolla Gialla, Friulano, and Pinot Grigio.

Following Stanko's passing in 2016, his son Saša Radikon took over the winery, continuing his father's legacy with a steadfast commitment to natural winemaking principles.

Saša's approach maintains the use of extended skin contact, natural fermentation, and aging in large Slavonian oak vats, producing wines that are expressive and age-worthy.

The Le Coste estate is a project that started from scratch by husband-and-wife team Gianmarco Antonuzi and Clementine Bouveron in 2004. Located in Gradoli (Lazio) the estate sits close to the border of Tuscany & Umbria overlooking Lake Bolsena. The lake is formed in an old volcano crater and thus the land is mostly made up of loose, volcanic soil that is rich in minerals and provides great drainage.

A “natural” approach to agriculture is practised throughout the entire estate, certified organic & extremely sensitive to respecting the cycles of nature. Biodynamic preparations are also applied to the vines and harvest is carried out entirely by hand in small crates. Vinification is spontaneous without the addition of yeast. The wines are racked once and bottled without any filtration, clarification, or the addition of sulfur dioxide at any stage of the wine making process.

Just a few kilometres from the sea, high in the hills of south-eastern Sardinia, sits the estate of Mora e Memo. The estate is poised 240 metres above sea level and is comprised of mineral-rich limestone and sandy hillsides. These hills are home to mature vineyards planted with indigenous Sardinian varietals, including Cannonau, Vermentino and Monica di Sardegna.

Elisabetta Pala, the winemaker, is the youngest member of the Pala family, a prominent Sardinian winemaking family that has been using the island's unique conditions to create wine for four generations. Elisabetta takes an enlightened approach to viticulture and winemaking: her approach is non-interventionist but modern.

Her delicate approach produces elegant, vibrant wines with character and tension. The bottles, designed by artist Katia Marcias, are a nod to the history of the island and its 'bandidas'. In this modern interpretation of the four moors (the traditional symbol of Sardinia, which appears on its flag), it is a woman – La Mora – who takes centre stage.

Maretti Langhe Rosso is produced by Cantina Terre del Barolo, with the intention of showing that the region can turn out good wines that don't have to cost the Earth. Made from 70% Barbera and 30% Nebbiolo and fermented using only wild yeast, the wine is aged for 8 months in small French and large Slavonian oak. It is then blended and given a further 4 months in large oak casks. This is a great value example of the Piedmontese style. The nose is fruit-driven and vibrant with aromas of fresh red fruits, dried herbs and a hint of aniseed. The palate is driven by a core of supple raspberry and dark plum flavours courtesy of the Barbera while the Nebbiolo brings fine tannins, appealing aromatics and length.

Mario Rovira is based in Ponferrada in the foothills of the Montes Aquilanos in the cooler part of the Bierzo DO. With a total area of 4 hectares, Akilia vineyards are spread over 3 sites: Fontairo, Villarín and Valdesacia, clearly differentiated by their orientation and soil type. The vineyards are planted with Mencia, Palomino Fino and Doña Blanca, most of which are at least 70 years-old. His highest site, Valdesacia, is 750 metres above sea level.

Though not certified, Mario employs organic farming techniques. His minimalist approach to winemaking, using wild yeasts and concrete tanks for the most part, captures these cool-climate sites perfectly.

With a few vintages of his Palomino Fino-based blend from Bierzo under his belt, Mario teamed up with Bodegas Delgado Zuleta in Cádiz, and created an experimental project of four botas of Palomino Fino under flor.

Within the Compañía, the emphasis is on biodynamic farming, indigenous varietals and sites with exceptional terroir. Telmo and Pablo's Galician plots in Valdeorras are located in the dramatic surroundings of Santa Cruz, a village bordering Ribera Sacra.

The company carries Telmo's name as it is a name synonymous with iconic winemaking in Spain. (He was the winemaker at the famous Remelluri, his family winery in Rioja) but it is his business partner Pablo Eguzkiza who is in charge of the painstaking revival of old vineyards through laborious massal selection and co-planting. In Rioja, where the Compañía is headquartered, the Las Beatas vineyard in Labastida deserves particular attention. This small plot (less than 2 hectares) was recovered by the partners in the 1990s and has taken the best part of 20 years to restore. Ancient wine growing techniques are used and grape varieties are co-planted, just as they were in the old days. The wine is made in one of the oldest bodegas in the village of Ollauri which has remained virtually unchanged. Sadly, we only have a tiny amount to sell.

In 2006, Ramón Jané broke 500 years of family tradition by vinifying a portion of his grapes with his wife Mercé Cuscó and his best friend, Catalan wine legend Toni Carbó, under the Mas Candí label. Previously, they had always sold their crop to large cava producers.

With a focus mainly on indigenous Catalan varieties, Mas Candí is now one of the most exciting and avant-garde producers in the Penedès. The wines are produced in a very natural way with meticulous attention to detail in the vineyard. In 2012, Toni founded the Celler La Salada label with a similar philosophy. Always ahead of the curve, Mas Candí left the Cava DO, along with ten other producers, to bottle under a new, quality-focused label called Corpinnat.

Adolfo De Las Heras Marín acquired the El Renegado (the renegade) estate in Valencia in 1985. In the beginning, the estate was made up of 540 hectares of forest and vines, of which 80% were 40 years old and produced native Bobal grapes. In keeping with the times, Adolfo also introduced other grapes such as Merlot and Cabernet. During those early years, Don Adolfo began marketing young wines as well as discovering new methods of winemaking. His son, Adolfo De Las Heras Polo, has continued this legacy. Since taking over the winery in the late nineties, he has meticulously shaped the Bodegas Nodus estate using modern techniques. Certified organic, these wines are fresh, fun and enjoyable.

Bodegas Monteabellón is based in the heart of Ribera del Duero in the small town of Nava de Roa. The García family has been involved in viticulture for many generations and founded Monteabellón in 2000. The winemaker and creative driving force behind this venture is Isaac Fernandez, nephew of the great Mariano García (legendary ex-Vega Sicilia winemaker from 1966 to 1996). Isaac worked for many years alongside Mariano and his sons at Bodegas Mauro, and the Mauro style is clearly evident in the wines of Monteabellón: exuberant fruit, rich chocolatey weight in the mouth, seamless oak integration, sophisticated tannins, and good balance and lift on the finish. The grapes are meticulously selected in the vineyard. The wines are aged in oak barrels, with 70% made from French oak and 30% made from American oak.


Florian Lauer is the third generation to head up Weingut Peter Lauer, founded in 1913. A relatively recent addition to the notoriously discriminating VDP Mosel-Saar-Ruwer or Grosser Ring, the winery is currently one of the top estates in the Saar. Unlike other well-known producers that favour styles with plenty of residual sugar, Florian is focused on making dry to slightly off-dry Riesling with great tension and precision. Florian has more of a non-interventionist approach in the cellar than his predecessors. Wines undergo a long, cool fermentation with ambient yeasts and are filtered but not fined.

Weingut Josef Ehmoser is run by third generation winemaker Josef Ehmoser and his wife Martina in the village of Grossweikersdorf, between Krems and Vienna. Josef believes in minimal intervention in the vineyard and achieves phenolic ripeness through a deep understanding of the vine and its environment. This philosophy is also applied in the wine cellar where Josef aims to support the potential of the vines and highlight their innate character, without forcing them on a prescribed path. The result of these efforts is a classic Wagram Grüner Veltliner and a Weisser Burgunder of great purity.
