



Caine, Rachel Ink and Bone


Cameron, Sharon **The Forgetting**

Carson, Rae Any Sign of Life




Charbonneau, Joelle Verify



Lee, Yoon Ha Moonstorm




Lu, Marie **Legend**



Meyer, Marissa **Renegades**



Ness, Patrick **The Knife of Never Letting Go**




Patterson, James Hawk
