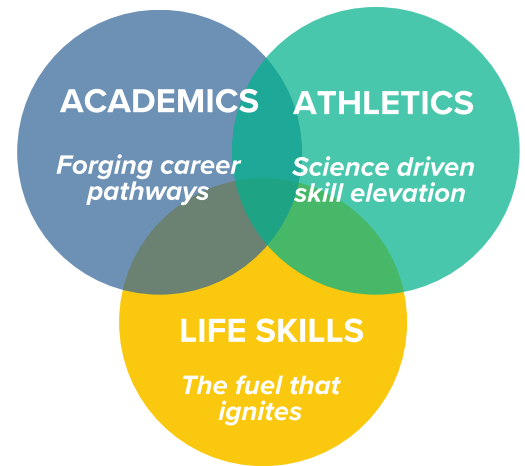

The UNISUS Soccer Academy provides a one-of-a-kind development pathway that combines a world-class education with elite soccer training — supported by our Everton International Affiliate partnership.

Program suitability:

The UNISUS Soccer Academy welcomes boys and girls from Grade 6 to Grade 12 (ages 11–18) who are ready to commit to a high-performance training environment. Because our curriculum mirrors the Everton International Academy model, prior playing experience is required—athletes must be able to demonstrate appropriate technical foundations, game understanding, and readiness for advanced training.

Players learn inside a holistic model that develops:

- Resilience and mental focus
- Technical excellence
- Tactical intelligence
- Team-based leadership
- Academic strength

Our program prepares scholar-athletes for opportunities in:

- University soccer
- College showcases
- North American leagues (CPL, USL, collegiate)
- International training experiences (Everton UK)

MEET OUR HEAD COACH AND TECHNICAL DIRECTOR

Dom Doherty is a UEFA B–licensed coach with over 12 years of coaching experience across three continents, including roles with multiple professional clubs. Drawing on his high-level university education and background competing semi-professionally in the UK, he brings a deep understanding of the scholar-athlete pathway and the role soccer plays in lifelong success.

Dom is passionate about developing young players who excel both academically and athletically, and he believes UNISUS is uniquely positioned to support this growth—especially at a time when the sport is expanding rapidly in North America ahead of the World Cup. The UNISUS coaching team is committed to guiding each player through a high-performance environment while supporting their broader development on and off the field.



TECHNICAL+TACTICAL TRAINING CURRICULUM

Our curriculum follows the Everton International Academy game model, developing players who are technically sharp, tactically intelligent, and adaptable across all phases of play.

We cover both the in and out of possession linked to the same topic:

1. Breaking Lines/Defending The Lines
2. Creating and Exploiting Overloads/Defend The Overload.
3. Final Third/Defend The Final Third,
4. Transitions,
5. Game-Based sessions.

In Possession

Objective: progress with purpose, break lines, and create high-value chances.

- **Building Through the Thirds** - Using the GK & CBs to attract pressure, create overloads, play beyond the press
- **Line-Breaking & Combination Play** - Third-man runs, rotations, and pocket play in central areas
- **Wide Play & Final Third Detail** - Timing of overlaps/underlaps, quality of crosses, finishing movements, box occupation.
- **Positional Play** - Intelligent spacing, width and depth, and securing rest defence behind the attack



Out of Possession

Objective: defend as a compact, connected, and disciplined unit.

- **Press & Counter-Press** - Recognising triggers (poor touch, back pass, sideline trap) and pressing as a coordinated unit
- **Defend the Lines** - Protecting central channels & half-spaces while controlling distance between units
- **Manage Overloads** - When to delay, when to engage, and how to funnel opponents into designated pressing zones.
- **Final Third Defending** - Box defending, set-play organisation, and winning second balls.

Transition

Where games are won.

Defence → Attack

- First thought forward
- Quick wide outlets
- Decision: fast break vs. secure possession

Attack → Defence

- Immediate 5-second counter-press
- Delay the counter, protect central lanes, regain compactness

Game Intelligence and Individual Growth:

Across all phases, players work on:

- Reading cues and anticipating play
- Understanding positional roles and profiles
- Using video analysis to connect training behaviours to match performance
- Applying Everton-style front-foot, intelligent soccer

LEVELS OF COMPETITION

Local (BC, Canada - League Play)

- ASL League (Academy Super League) – high-performance matches in Vancouver.
- COYSA / TOYSL – structured district league competition.
- Local tournaments & friendlies – skill-building, team cohesion, and competitive consistency.
- BC School Sports. Leading to Provincial Competition.

Regional (Western Canada, Pacific Northwest & California – Tournaments Only)

We aim to compete in at least 5 regional tournaments per year, providing exposure to higher-level competition across borders. Tournaments are selected based on team readiness.

Potential tournaments include:

- PacNW Winter Classic (Seattle, WA)
- Crossfire Challenge (Redmond, WA)
- Slurpee Cup (Kamloops, BC)
- California College Showcase (San Diego, CA) – high-level competition & exposure to college recruiting
- Surf Cup Select (San Diego, CA) – elite showcase tournament attracting college coaches
- Las Vegas Mayor's Cup (Las Vegas, NV) – top-level youth tournament with college exposure.
- Oregon Youth Showcase (Portland, OR)
- Starfire Xtreme Cup (Seattle/Tukwila, WA)

SOCCKER PROGRAM SCHEDULE

The UNISUS SO Academy schedule is designed to enable successful academic advancement with successful athletic progression. All Scholar-Athletes are required to maintain academic competence consistent with their grade level. Teachers monitor academic progress and reassign off-field and on-field training time accordingly to ensure academic progress is met.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Commitment Agreement

- All academy students are required to maintain strong academic standing, complete assignments on time, and demonstrate consistent effort in every subject. Academic progress is monitored weekly, and training time may be adjusted if expectations are not met.
- Students must uphold the UNISUS Code of Conduct, incl. exemplary behaviour, respect for peers and coaches, punctuality, accountability, and a positive attitude in both the classroom and on the field.
- Scholar-Athletes are expected to arrive prepared, focused, and ready to learn, demonstrating self-discipline, integrity, and commitment to personal growth.
- Parents are available for parent academy meetings as needed to support alignment between home, school, and academy expectations.

Team Travel & Tournament Logistics

- UNISUS provides transportation for all league matches and tournaments, ensuring players travel safely and efficiently as a team. Tournament and showcase travel is not included in the academy fee and will be outlined separately each season based on the number of competitions, locations, and schedule.
- A customized travel package will be shared with families, designed to keep costs as low as possible. By traveling as a group, the academy is able to negotiate team rates for accommodation, meals, and travel, and all team movements are coordinated using UNISUS transportation to maintain safety, consistency, and performance readiness.
